**Main results**

- The **annual change** of the CPI for the month of March stands at **2.4%**, four tenths lower than that registered the previous month.
- The **annual** change of **core** inflation is maintained at **2.3%**.
- The **Monthly change** of the overall index is **0.4%**.
- The **Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) annual change** stands at **2.6%**, thus it decreases three tenths, as compared with February.

**Annual evolution of consumer prices**

The annual change for the overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) in March was **2.4%** four tenths lower than that registered in February.

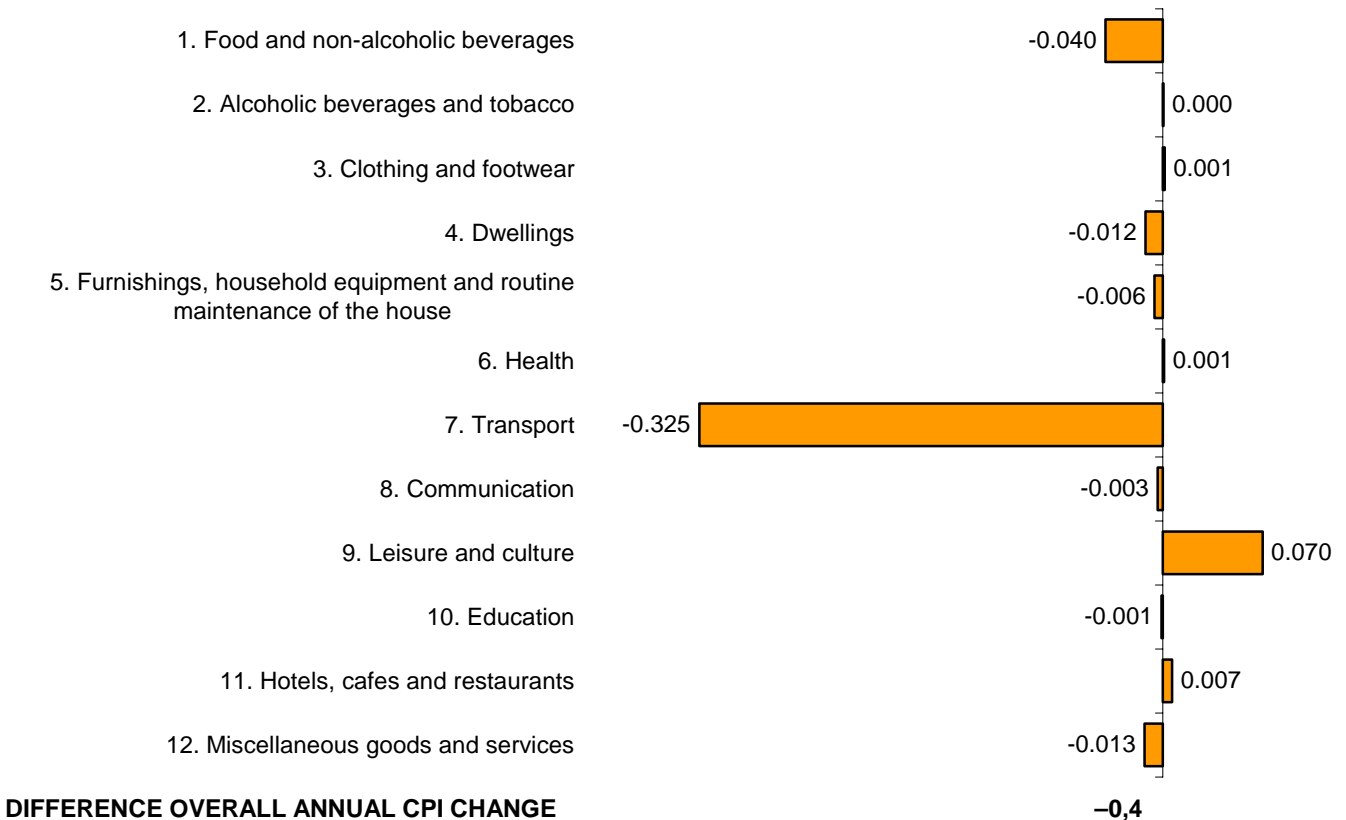
The groups that most contributed in this rate were:

- **Transport**, with an annual change of **0.7%**, more than two points lower than that registered in February, due mostly to the increase this month in *Fuels and lubricants*, as compared with the rise registered in March 2012.
- **Food and non-alcoholic beverages**, whose annual rate decreased by two tenths, standing at **2.6%**. In this behaviour, it is worth noting the drops in prices of *Fresh fish, Poultry meat* and *Eggs*.

Despite the drop in the annual rate of the overall CPI, it is worth noting the increase in the rate of:

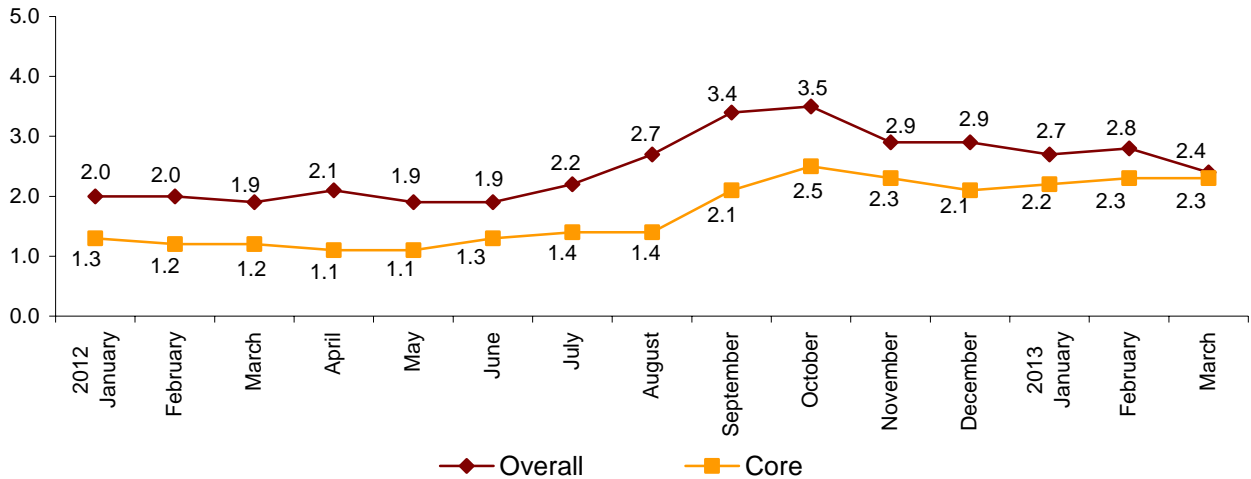
- **Leisure and culture**, whose rate increased one point reaching **2.3%**. This is due mostly to the rise in prices of *Package holiday*, and to a lesser degree to *Recreation and sporting services*.

## Influence of the groups on the annual CPI change



The annual change for **core inflation** (overall index excluding unprocessed food and energy products) was maintained at **2.3%**, reducing the difference with the overall CPI change, standing at one tenth.

**Monthly evolution of consumer prices**

In March, the monthly change of the overall CPI was **0.4%**.

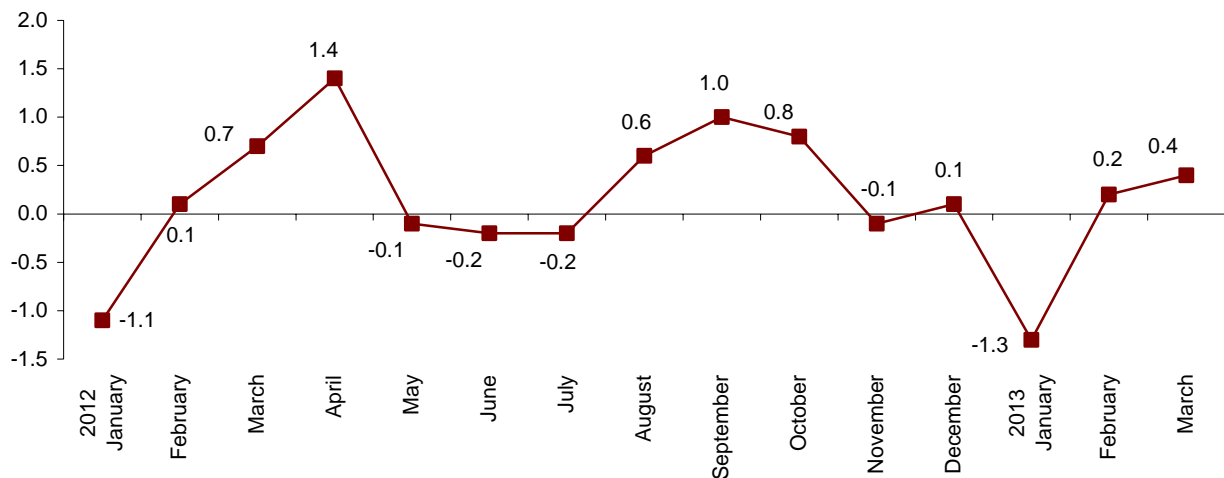
The groups with the greatest positive monthly contribution to the overall index were the following:

- **Clothing and footwear**, with a monthly rate of **-4.0%**, showing the behaviour of the beginning of the spring-summer season. Its contribution to the overall CPI was **0.274**.
- **Leisure and culture**, with a change of **1.7%**, mainly due to the increases in prices of *Package holidays* that contributed **0.125** in the overall CPI.
- **Hotels, cafes and restaurants**, showing a change rate of **0.3%** and an effect of **0.032**, due to the increase in prices of *Hotels and other accomodations*.
- **Dwellings**, with a monthly rate of **0.1%**, and an effect of **0.017**, due to the rise in prices of *Other services relating to dwelling, Gas and Supply of water*. Despite the rise in the overall annual rate in this group, it is worth noting the drop in prices of *Diesel for heating*.

In turn, the only groups showing a negative monthly change were:

- **Transport**, whose monthly change of **-0.6%**, contributing on the CPI by **-0.088**, was due to the decrease in prices of *Fuels and lubricants*, and to a lesser degree of *Automobiles*.
- **Food and non-alcoholic beverages**, that presented a monthly rate of **-0.1%** and a contribution of **-0.022**. Worth noting in this behaviour the drop in prices of *Fresh fruits* and *Poultry meat*.

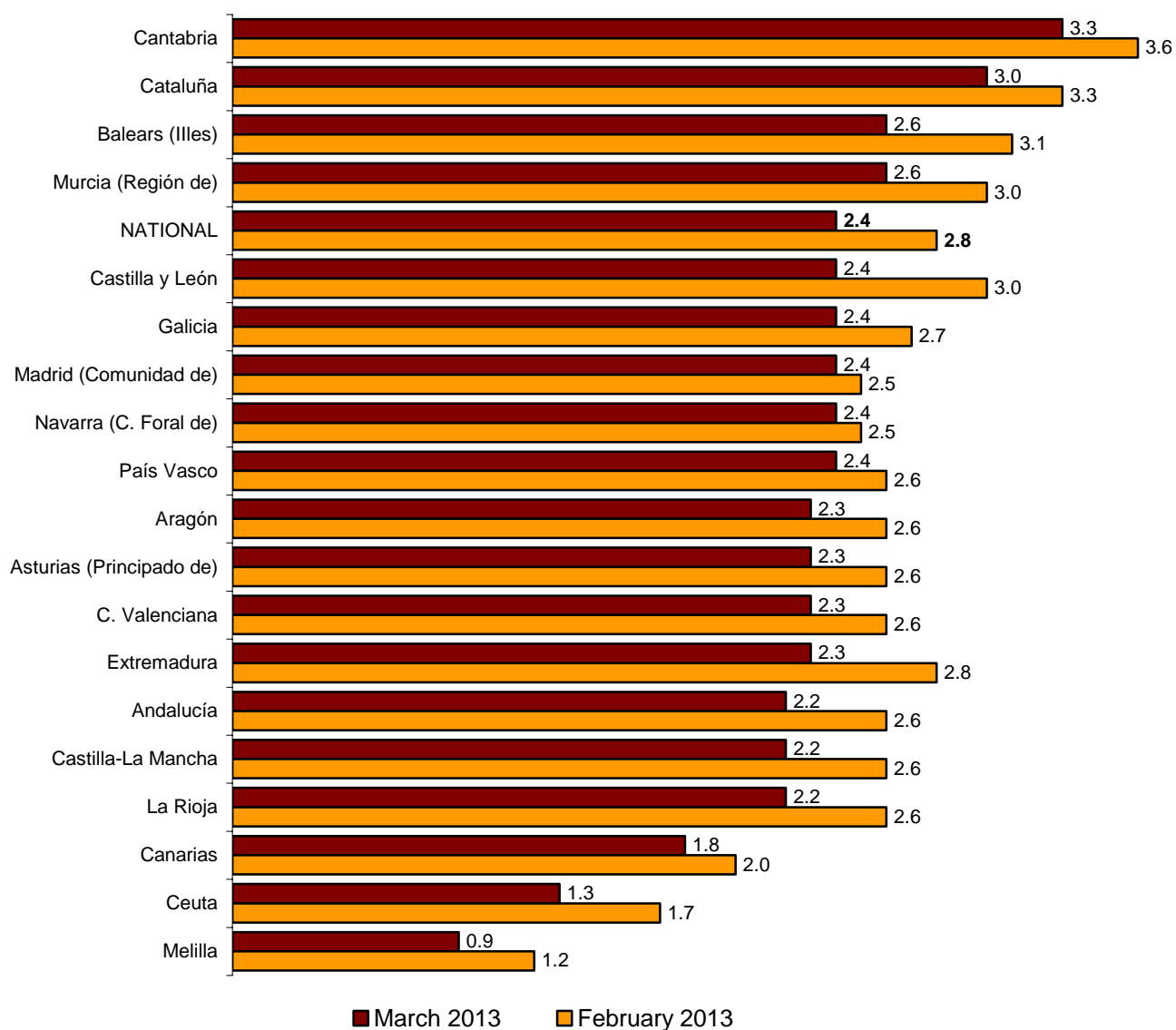

### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual changes

The annual rate of CPI decreased in every Autonomous Community. Among them, it is highlighting Castilla y León (2.4%), with a decrease of 6 tenths, followed by Illes Balears (2.6%) and Extremadura (2.3%), with drops of five tenths.

In turn, the slightest decreases were registered in Comunidad de Madrid and Comunidad Foral de Navarra, whose rates stood at 2.4%, one tenth below that registered in February.

#### Annual rates of CPI Index by Autonomous Community and Autonomous City

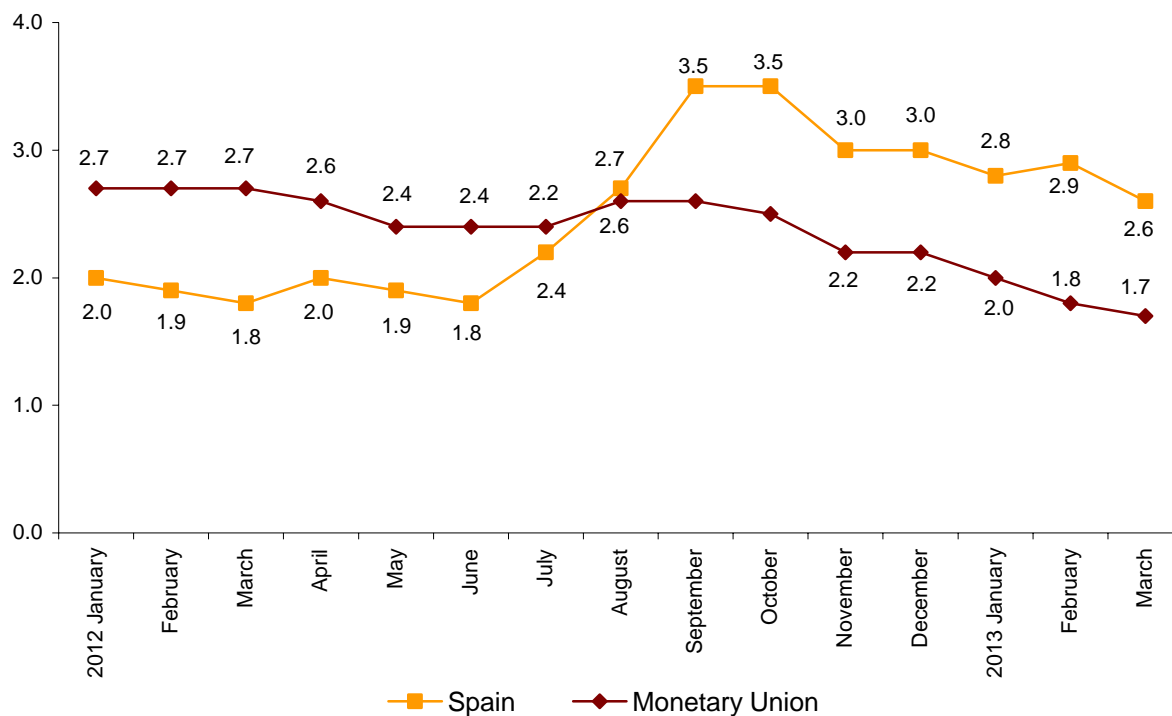


## Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)

In March, the annual change rate of the HICP stood at **2.6%**, three tenths below that registered last month.

The monthly change of the HICP was **1.9%**.

## Index of Consumer Prices at Constant Taxes

In March, the annual rate of CPI-CT stood at **0.4%**, two points lower than that of CPI.

The monthly change of the CPI-CT was **0.4%**.

In turn, the annual rate of HICP-CT presented an annual change of **0.5%**, more than two points lower than HCPI.

The monthly change of the HICP-CT was **1.9%**.
