The number of passengers using public transport decreases 2.0% in May, as compared with the same month of the previous year


City transport decreases 0.8% in the annual rate and inter-city transport decreases 3.7%

Passengers transport evolution

More than 406.7 million passengers used public transport in May, 2.0% less than in the same month of 2013.

City transport decreased 0.8% and inter-city transport did so by 3.7%. Within the inter-city transport, all types of transport decreased, except for sea transport (0.0%).

Type of transport





Monthly rate evolution

The variation rate for the number of passengers on public transport in May, as compared with April, was 7.0%. In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation for May as compared with April for the last five years.

City transport


City transport was used by more than 244.7 million passengers in May, 0.8% less than in the same month of 2013.

Metropolitan transport registered a decrease of 0.5% and bus transport decreased by 0.9%.

Metropolitan transport registered a decrease in Valencia (−4.1%), Bilbao (−4.0%) and Madrid (−1.4%), and registered an increase in the rest of the cities. Worth noting was Sevilla (40.6%), due to the celebration of the *Feria de Abril* (Seville April Fair) this month.

Bus transport registered positive rates in all cities using metropolitan transport, except for Madrid (−1.8%) and Palma (−1.2%).

Annual rate of city transport passengers in cities with a Metropolitan



The number of passengers of bus transport increased in seven Autonomous Communities. Canarias (2.8%), Castilla-La Mancha (2.6%) and País Vasco (2.4%) registered the greatest increases in their annual rate.

In turn, Aragón (-4.7%), Extremadura (-4.5%) and Castilla y León (-3.3%) recorded the greatest decreases.

Inter-city transport


More than 109.7 million passengers used inter-city transport in May, indicating a 3.7% decrease, as compared with the same month of 2013.

By type of inter-city transport, all types of transport decreased this month, except for sea transport (0.0%). Bus transport decreased by 4.8% and rail transport and air transport did so by 2.6% and 0.4%, respectively.

Local distance passengers decreased 6.7% for bus transport and 3.5% for rail transport. Regional distance passengers decreased 0.1% for bus transport and 1.1% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers decreased 2.6% in bus transport and increased by 13.6% in rail transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

Over 52.3 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in May, indicating a decrease of 3.8% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased 7.4%, reaching over 35.5 million users. Within this, school transport decreased 7.5%, and work transport did so by 7.4%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 4.9%, as compared with the same month of the previous year, reaching more than 16.8 million passengers.
