The number of passengers using public transport remained the same in July, as compared with the same month of the previous year

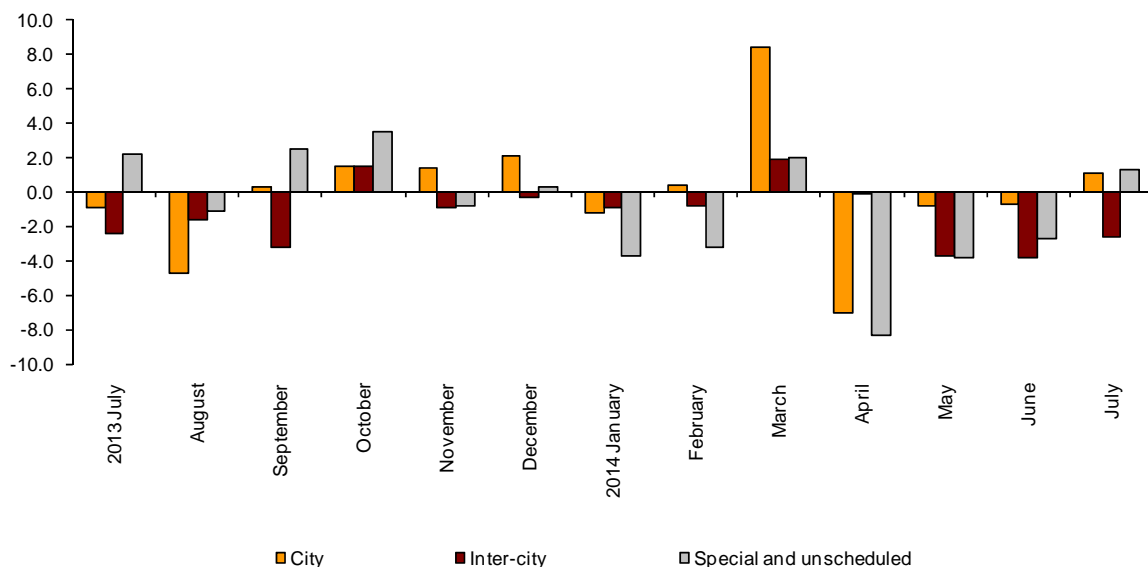
City transport increases by 1.1% in the annual rate and inter-city transport decreases by 2.6%

Passengers transport evolution

More than 347.8 million passengers used public transport in July, just the same number as in the same month of 2013.

City transport increased by 1.1% and inter-city transport decreased by 2.6%. Within the last one, air transport was the only one that increased (3.6%).

Type of transport



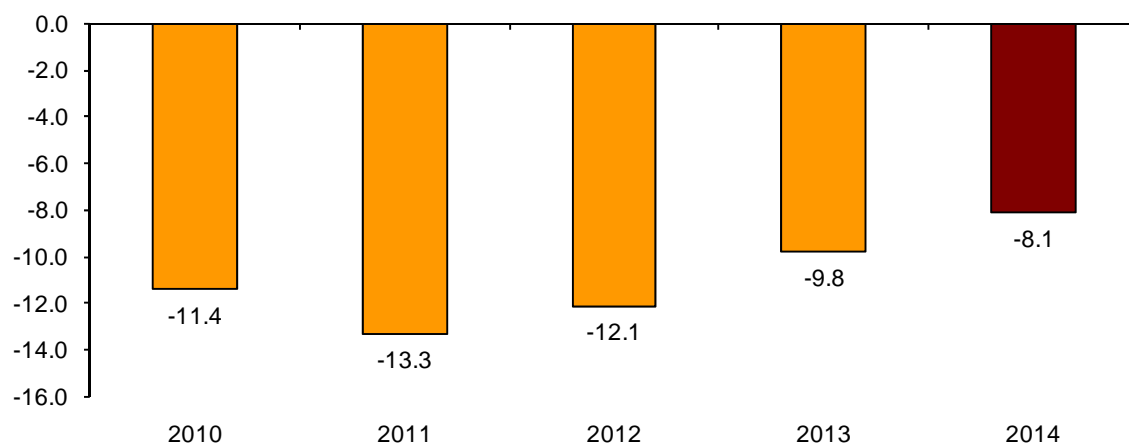

Monthly rate evolution

The variation rate for the number of passengers on public transport in July, as compared with June, was -8.1%. In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation for July as compared with June for the last five years.

City transport

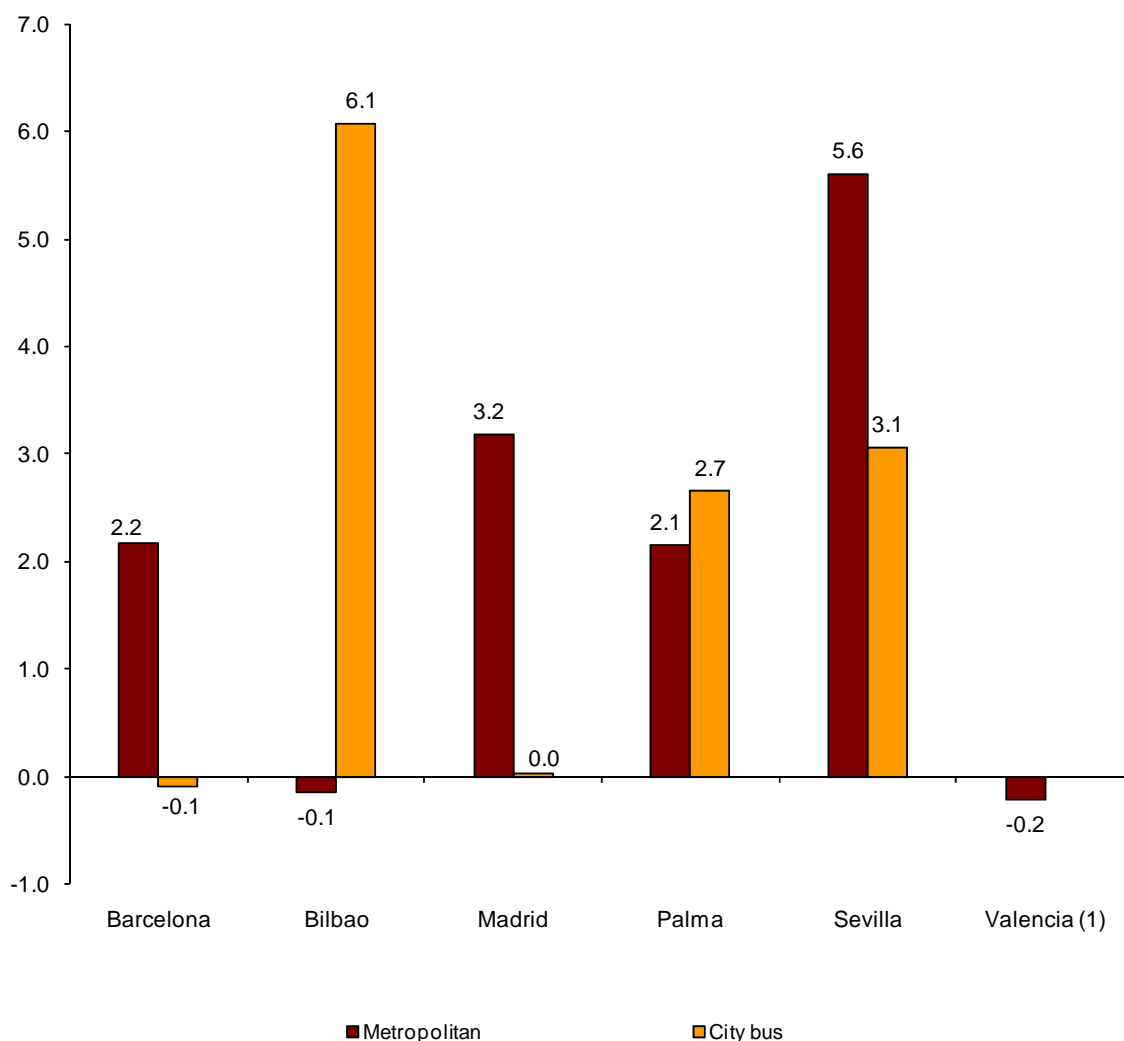
City transport was used by more than 216.9 million passengers in July, 1.1% more than in the same month of 2013.

Metropolitan transport registered an increase of 2.4% and bus transport did so by 0.3%.

Metropolitan transport decreased in Valencia (−0.2%) and Bilbao (−0.1%), and increased in the rest of the cities. Sevilla (5.6%) registered the biggest increase.

Bus transport registered positive rates in all the cities using metropolitan transport, except for Barcelona, where it decreased by 0.1%. In Madrid it remained the same (0.0%).

Annual rate of city transport passengers in cities with a Metropolitan

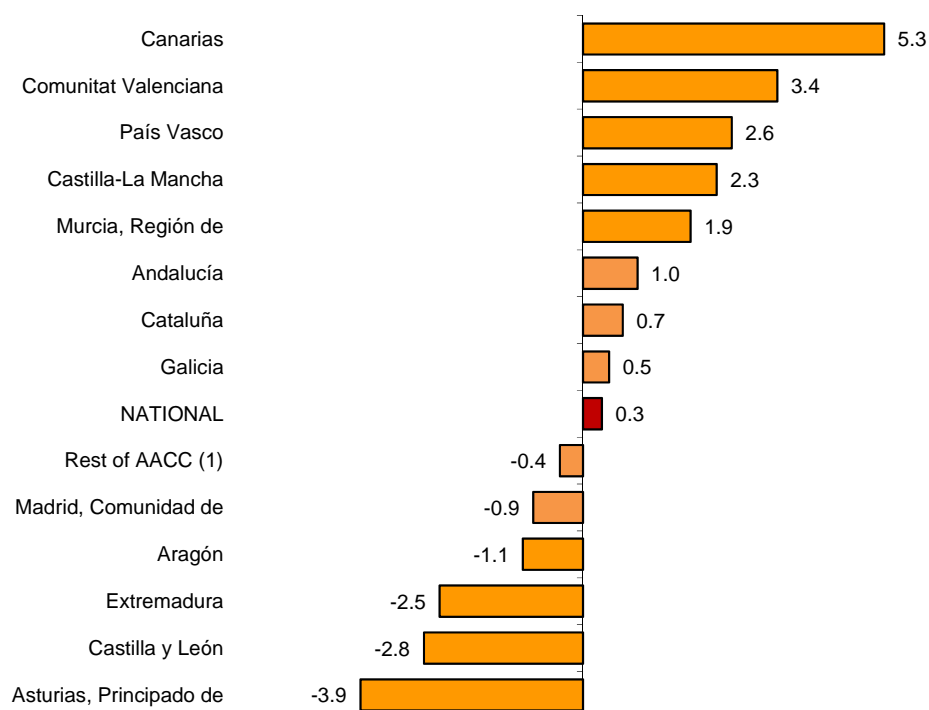

The number of passengers of bus transport increased in eight Autonomous Communities. Canarias (5.3%), Comunitat Valenciana (3.4%) and País Vasco (2.6%) registered the greatest increases in their annual rate.

In turn, Principado de Asturias (-3.9%), Castilla y León (-2.8%) and Extremadura (-2.5%) recorded the greatest decreases.

Inter-city transport

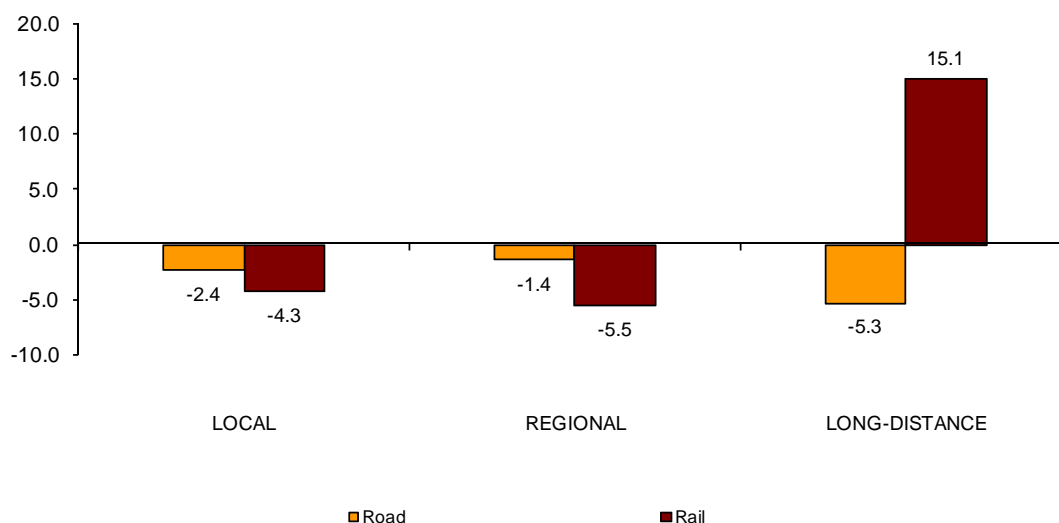
More than 105.5 million passengers used inter-city transport in July, indicating a 2.6% decrease as compared with the same month of 2013.

By type of inter-city transport, bus transport decreased by 2.2%, rail transport decreased by 3.3% and sea transport decreased by 13.2%. In turn, air transport increased by 3.6%.

Local distance passengers decreased 2.4% for bus transport and 4.3% for rail transport. Regional distance passengers decreased 1.4% for bus transport and 5.5% for rail transport.

Finally, long distance passengers decreased 5.3% in bus transport and increased by 15.1% in rail transport.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 25.3 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in July, indicating an increase of 1.3% in the annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers decreased 6.5%, reaching more than 8.6 million users. Within this, school transport decreased 6.0%, and work transport did so by 6.6%.

In turn, unscheduled transport increased 5.9%, as compared with the same month of the previous year, reaching more than 16.6 million passengers.
