Flash estimate of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and of the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) November 2016


The annual change of the flash estimate of the CPI stands at 0.7% in October, the same as the change registered in October

The annual change of the HICP flash estimate is 0.5%

According to the flash estimate published by the INE, the annual inflation of the CPI in November 2016 is 0.7%.

This indicator provides a preview of the CPI that, if confirmed, would imply the maintenance of its annual change, given that in October this change was 0.7%.

In this behavior, it is noteworthy the drop in the prices of fuels (gasoil and gasoline).




In turn, the annual change of the HICP flash estimate in November stands at 0.5%. If confirmed, the annual change of the HICP would remain the same as in the previous month.

Evolution of the monthly change

According to the flash estimate of the CPI, consumer prices register a 0.3% variation in November, as compared to the month of October.

Evolution of the monthly change of the CPI in November



In turn, the monthly change of the HICP flash estimate in November stands at 0.2%.
