# Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2010

February 2015. Provisional data


The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.7%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.6% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 1.1% in the original series

### **Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production**

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between February and January 2015 stood at 0.7%. This rate was 0.7 points higher than that registered in January.


### General Industrial Production Index Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate



By industrial sectors, Durable consumer goods (3.4%), Capital goods (2.3%) and Intermediate goods (0.9%) registered the greatest positive monthly variation rates.

In turn, the only sector to record a negative monthly rate was Energy (-0.9%).

### Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

**General Industrial Production Index** 

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 0.6% in February, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 0.5 points higher than that registered in January.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of 1.1%. This rate was 3.6 points higher than that of January.

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, Durable consumer goods (3.8%), Capital goods (3.0%) and Intermediate goods (1.5%) registered positive annual rates.

In turn, Non-durable consumer goods (-1.8%) was the only sector to record a decrease in this rate.



# Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in 11 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were registered in Illes Balears (10.7%), Principado de Asturias (10.6%), and La Rioja (5.7%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Extremadura (-12.8%), Cantabria (-6.0%) and Galicia and Castilla y León (both with -3.5%).
