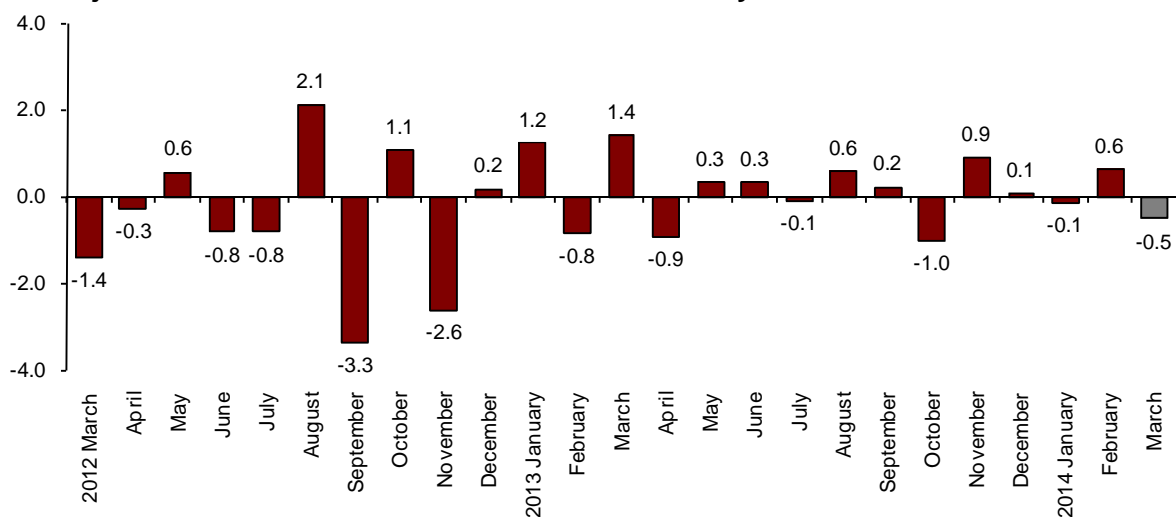
The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at – 0.5%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.6% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 8.1% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production

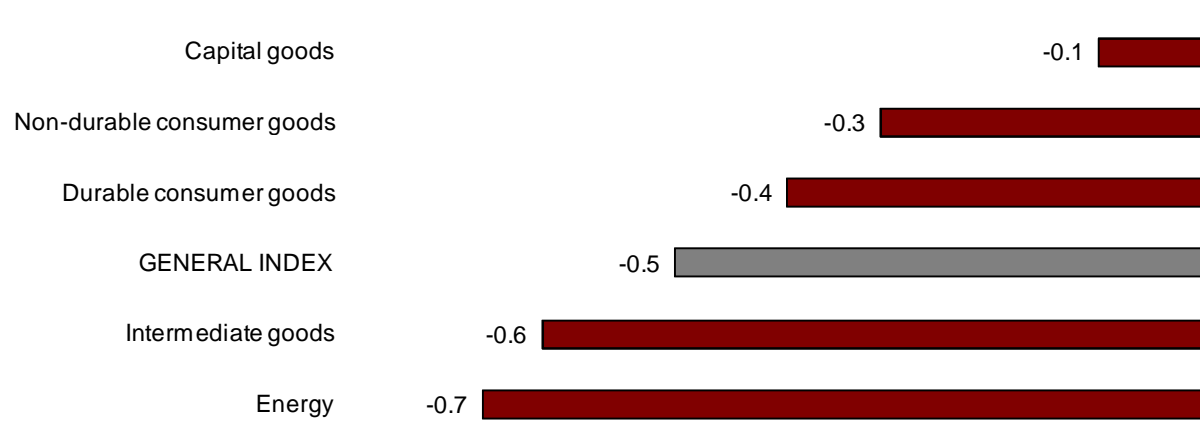
After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between March and February 2014 stood at –0.5%. This rate was 1.1 points below that registered in February.

All the industrial sectors registered negative monthly rates. Energy recorded the greatest monthly decrease (-0.7%) and Capital goods the softest (-0.1%).

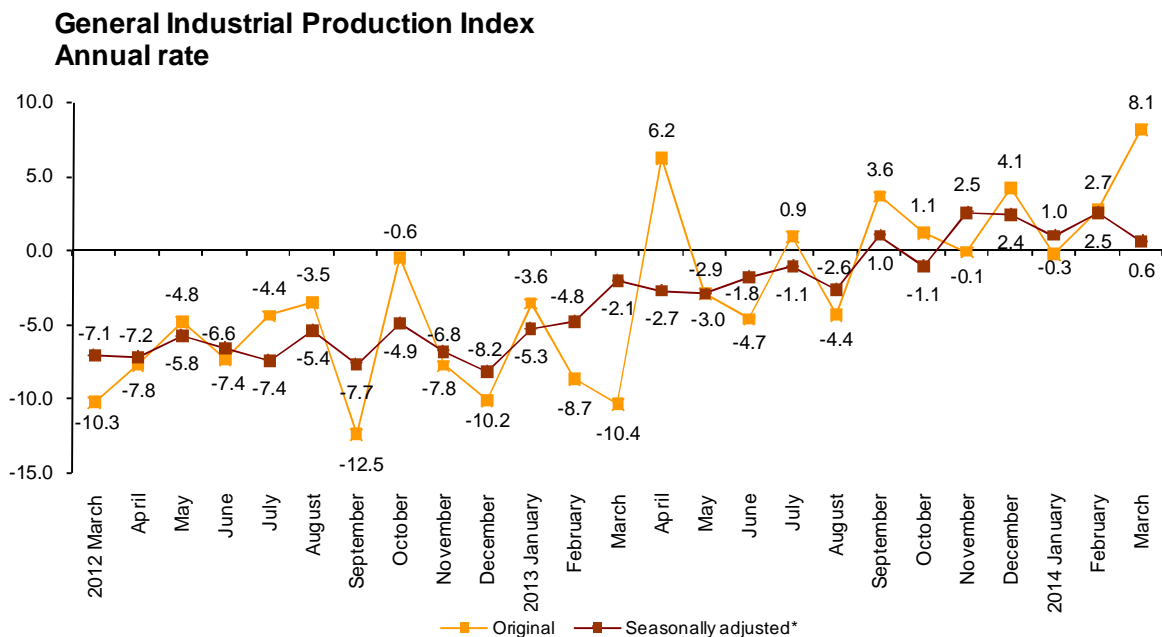

Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 0.6% in March, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.9 points below that registered in February.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of 8.1%. This rate was 5.4 points over that of February.



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, all industrial sectors registered positive annual rates, except Durable consumer goods and Energy.

Capital goods recorded the greatest positive rate (3.0%). In turn, Durable consumer goods registered the greatest decrease (-4.8%).

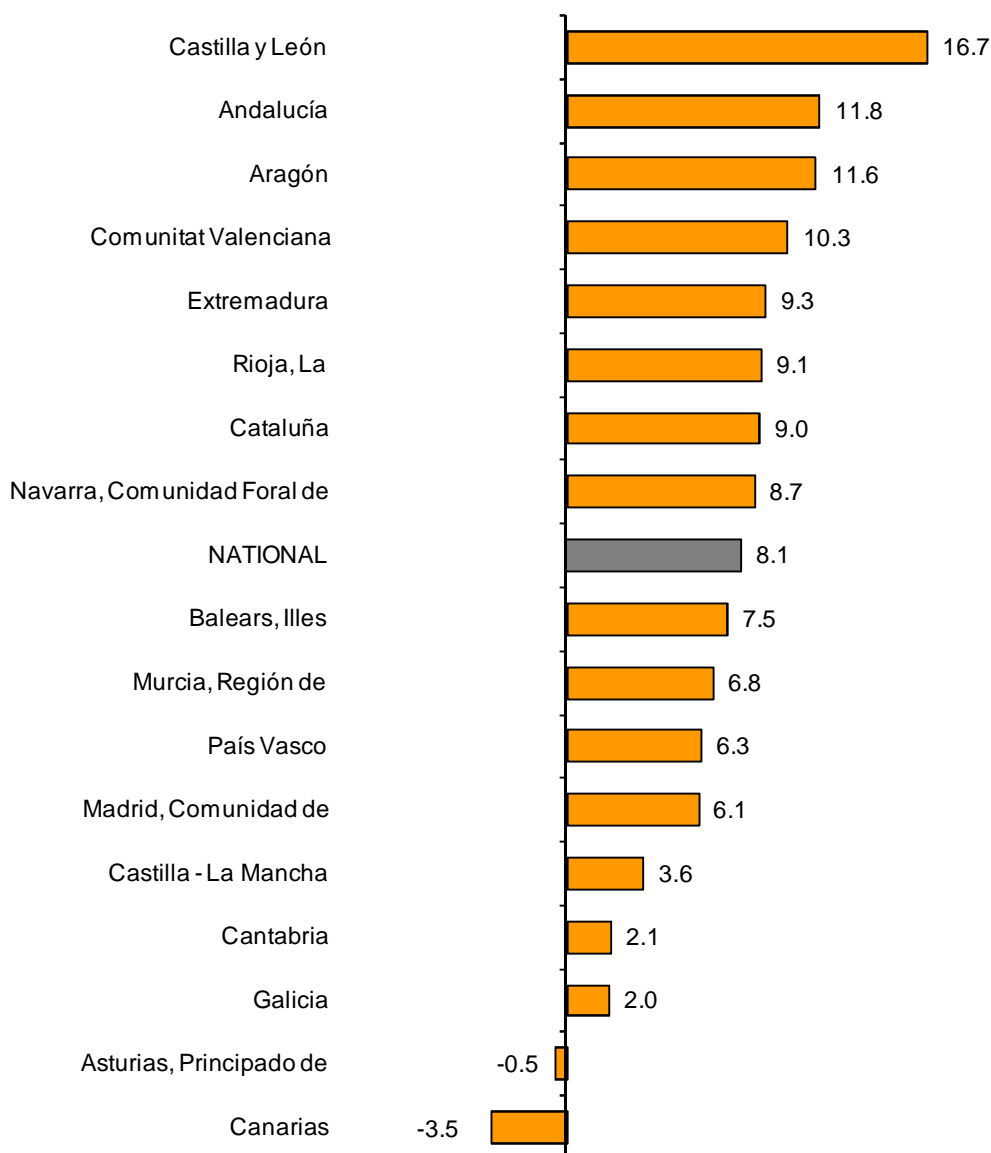

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The original series of the Industrial Production increased in all Autonomous Communities, as compared with March 2013, except for Principado de Asturias (-0.5%) and Canarias (-3.5%).

The greatest increases were registered in Castilla y León (16.7%), Andalucía (11.8%) and Aragón (11.6%).
