
Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2015 April 2018 Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at -1.8%, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 1.9% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 11.0% in the original series

Monthly evolution of industrial production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between April and March stood at -1.8%. This rate is 2.8 points lower than that observed in March.



By sector, all of them showed negative monthly rates.

Energy (-4.0%), *Durable consumer goods* (-2.1%) and *Capital goods* (-1.6%) recorded the largest decreases.


Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index registered a

variation of 1.9% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate is 2.7 points lower than that recorded in March.

Press

The original series of the IPI experienced an annual variation of 11.0%. This rate is 14.7 points higher than in March.



For the indices adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, all sectors presented positive annual rates, except for *Durable consumer goods* (-4.3%).

Capital goods (3.6%) and Energy (2.8%) recorded the largest increases.



Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production in April is positive in all Autonomous Communities, except in Extremadura (-4.8%).

The greatest increases were recorded in Galicia (21.7%), Castilla y León (20.1%) and Aragón (16.1%).
