
The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.8%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 3.4% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 1.7% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between May and April 2015 stood at 0.8%. This rate was 0.7 points higher than that registered in April.


General Industrial Production Index

By industrial sectors, Energy (3.1%) and Capital goods (1.9%) registered the greatest positive monthly variation rates.

In turn, Durable consumer goods (-2.3%) is the only sector to register a negative monthly rate.



Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 3.4% in May, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.7 points higher than that registered in April.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of 1.7%. This rate was 0.8 points lower than that of April.

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, all sectors registered positive annual rates.

Capital goods (6.2%), Intermediate goods (4.9%) and Energy (3.3%) registered the greatest positive annual variation rate.



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in 12 Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were registered in Comunidad de Madrid (5.3%), Andalucía (5.2%) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (4.8%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Cantabria (-7.0%), Canarias (-3.5%) and Illes Balears (-2.8%).
