Industrial Production Indices (IPI). Base 2015 July 2019. Provisional data

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index is -0.4% after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects


The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.8% in the series adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects and at 2.9% in the original series

Monthly evolution of industrial production

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between the months of July and June, eliminating seasonal and calendar effects, is -0.4%. This rate is 0.2 points lower than that observed in June.

General Industrial Production Index


Adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects. Monthly rate (percentage)



By sectors, *Energy* (0.9%) and *Durable consumer goods* (0.1%) showed positive monthly rates. On the other hand *Capital goods* (–2.5%), *Intermediate goods* (–0.4%) and *Non-durable consumer goods* (–0.3%) showed negative monthly rates.

In a more detailed analysis, it is possible to identify the branches of activity with the lowest and highest monthly rates in the July.


Annual evolution of industrial production

The Industrial Production Index, adjusted for seasonal and calendar effects, recorded a variation rate of 0.8% in July, compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate is 0.8 points lower than that registered in June.

The original series of the IPI experienced an annual variation of 2.9%. This rate is 4.8 points higher than that of June.

By sectors, Energy (7.4%) and Non-durable consumer goods (2.7%) showed positive annual rates. On the other hand Capital goods (-2.2%), Intermediate goods (-2.0%) and Durable consumer goods (-0.6%) showed negative annual rates.



Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates of industrial production. Original series

The annual rate of industrial production increased as compared to July 2018 in ten Autonomous Communities and decreased in the other seven.

The largest increases were recorded in Región de Murcia (25.6%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (18.8%) and Castilla - La Mancha (9.1%). The largest decreases were recorded in Illes Balears (-7.2%), Castilla y León (-5.1%) and Canarias (-4.1%).

Data review and update

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data of the IPI series corresponding to the last two months. In the case of the series adjusted for calendar effects and for seasonal and calendar effects, the series is revised from the beginning, following the INE standard. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The **Industrial Production Index (IPI)** is a short-term indicator that measures the monthly evolution of the productive activity of the industrial branches, excluding construction, contained in the National Classification of Economic Activities 2009 (CNAE-2009). It therefore investigates the activities included in sections B, C, D and division 36: Water collection, treatment and supply, from section E of the CNAE-2009.

The IPI measures the joint evolution of quantity and quality, eliminating the influence of prices.

Type of survey: monthly continuous survey.

Base year: 2015.

Population scope: industrial establishments whose main activity is included in sections B, C, D and division 36 of the CNAE-2009.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Sample size: 11,500 industrial establishments and more than 1,100 products.

Collection method: completion of the questionnaire by the respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or by postal mail.
