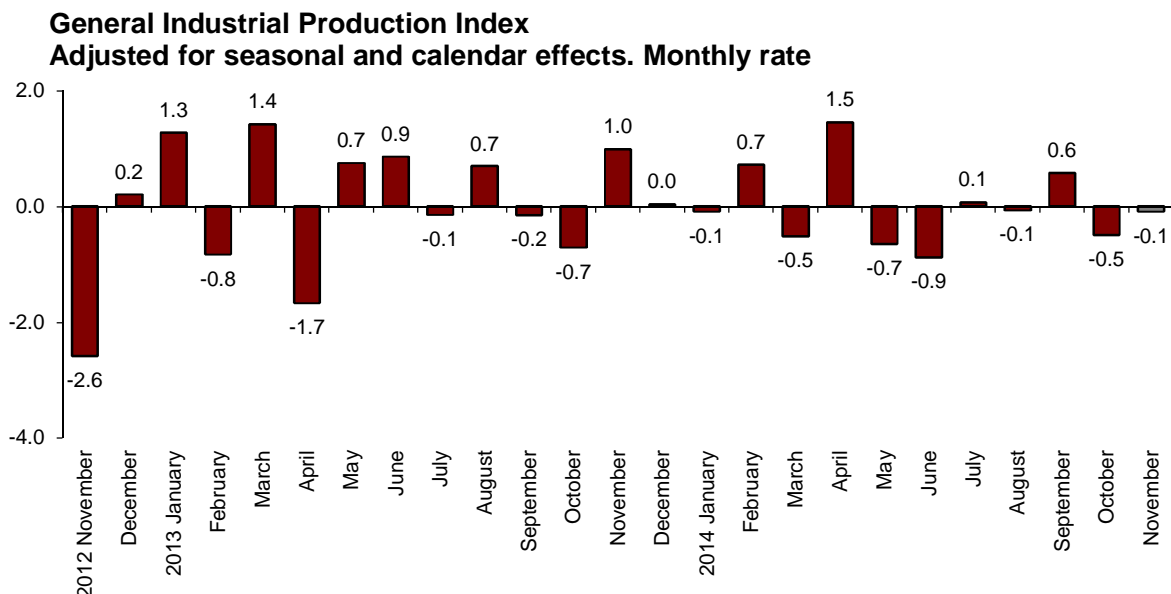
Industrial Production Index (IPI). Base 2010

The monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index stands at -0.1% , after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate of the Industrial Production Index stands at 0.0% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at -0.1% in the original series

Monthly evolution of the Industrial Production

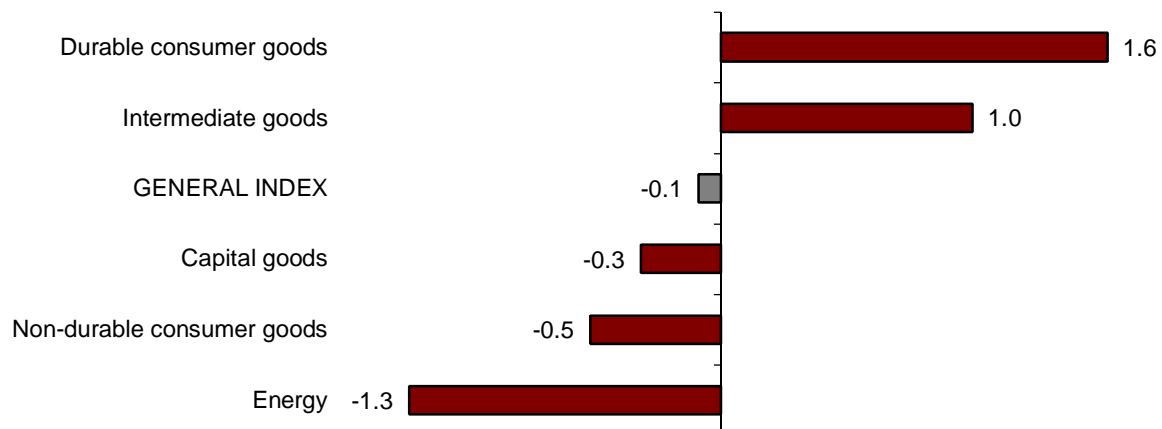
After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the monthly variation of the Industrial Production Index (IPI) between November and October stood at -0.1% . This rate was 0.4 points higher than that registered in October.



Durable consumer goods (1.6%) and Intermediate goods (1.0%) registered positive monthly variation rates.

In turn, Energy (-1.3%) and Non-durable consumer goods (-0.5%) registered the greatest negative variation rates.

A more detailed analysis showed the activities that registered the highest and lowest monthly rates in the month of November.

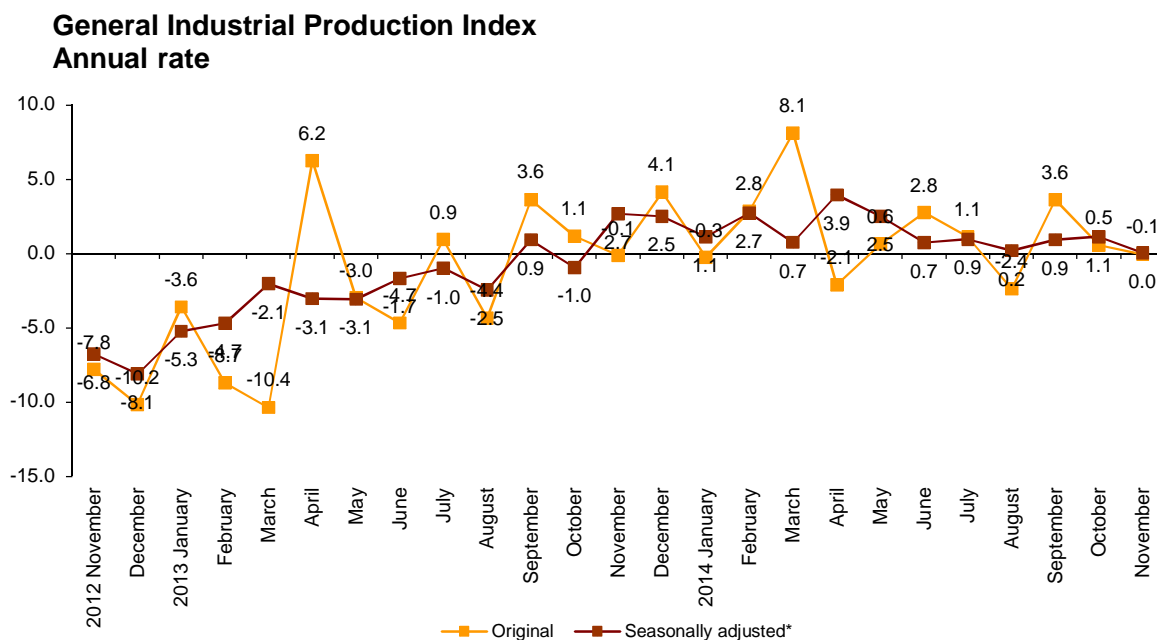

Annual evolution of the Industrial Production

After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, the Industrial Production Index (IPI) registered a variation of 0.0% in November, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.1 points higher than that registered in October.

The original series of the Industrial Production Index recorded an annual variation of -0.1%. This rate was 0.6 points lower than that of October.



After adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects, Intermediate goods (4.5%), Durable consumer goods (3.6%) and Non-durable consumer goods (0.2%) registered positive annual rates.

In contrast, Energy (-4.4%) and Capital goods (-2.3%) recorded negative rates.

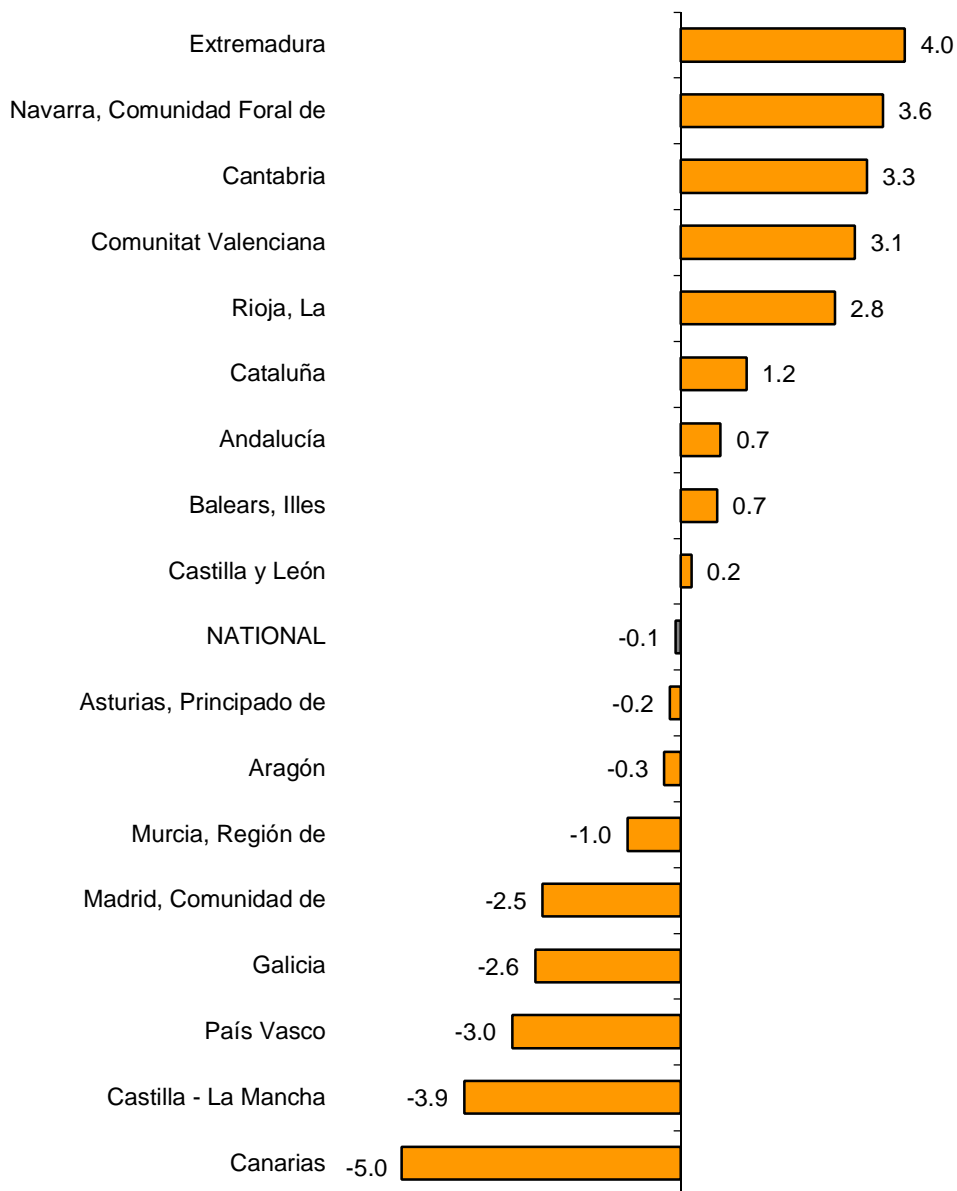

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Production. Original series

The annual rates of the original series of the Industrial Production increased in nine Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were registered in Extremadura (4.0%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (3.6%), and Cantabria (3.3%).

In turn, the greatest decreases were registered in Canarias (-5.0%), Castilla-La Mancha (-3.9%) and País Vasco (-3.0%).
