# Industrial Price Index (IPRI). Base 2010



# The annual variation rate of the Industrial Price Index stands at -1.2%, more than one point and a half over that registered in February

### The monthly variation rate of industrial prices is 0.2%

### **Annual evolution of industrial prices**

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) stood at **-1.2%** in March, one point and a half over that registered in February.




By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sector that influenced the most the decrease in the annual variation of the general IPRI was:

• *Energy*, whose rate stood at **-0.7%**, six points over that of the previous month. This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of the *Production, transportation and distribution of electrical energy,* as compared with the decrease registered in 2013.

• *Capital goods,* which increased three tenths its annual variation, up to **0.0%.** This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock*, as compared with the decrease recorded last year.

### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In March, the monthly variation of the general IPRI was **0.2%**.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that recorded a monthly positive effect on the general index were:


• *Energy*, with a monthly variation of **0.8%** and an effect of **0.209**. This behaviour was due to the increase in the prices of the *Production, transportation and distribution of the electric power* and in those of the *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains.* 

Despite the increase in the monthly variation of this sector, worth noting the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of coke oven products*.

- Capital goods, with a variation of **0.3**% and an effect of **0.041**, mainly due to the increase in the prices of Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock.
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a variation of **-0.1%** and an effect of **-0.041**, mainly due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of beverages*.

In turn, the only industrial sector with a negative monthly effect on the IPRI was:

• *Intermediate goods*, with a rate of **-0.2%** and an effect of **-0.060**. Worth noting in this behaviour the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*.



A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of March.



### Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in all the Autonomous Communities, except for La Rioja (1.1%), where it remained the same.

In the rest of the Autonomous Communities, worth noting the increase in the rates of Illes Balears (5.4%), Canarias (2.5%) and Asturias (0.2%), with increases of 14.8, 10.0 and 7.1 points respectively.
