# Industrial Price Index. Base 2015

May 2018. Provisional data

# The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at 2.9%, more than one point above that registered in April

### The monthly rate of industrial prices is 1.1%

#### Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in May was **2.9%**, more than one point above that registered in April.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that had a positive influence on this evolution, worth noting were:

• *Energy,* with a variation rate of **8.8%**, almost four points higher than last month, due to the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*, which decreased in May 2017.


Another reason for this variation is that the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission* and distribution increased more this month than the previous year.

•Intermediate goods, whose variation rate stood at 2.6%, three tenths above that registered in April. It is worth noting in this evolution the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and of Manufacture of prepared animal feeds, which fell in May 2017.

On the other hand, the only industrial sector with a negative influence on the evolution of the annual rate of the general index was:


•Non-durable consumer goods, whose annual rate decreased seven tenths to -0.6%, the lowest since June 2014. This behaviour was due mainly to the drop in the prices of Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats and, to a lesser extent, of Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products, compared to the increase registered in 2017.

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* decreased one tenth, to **1.0%**, standing almost two points below that of the general IPRI.

#### Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In May, the monthly variation rate of the general IPRI was 1.1%.


By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that presented a positive contribution to the general index, worth noting were:

**Energy**, with a rate of **3.8%** and a contribution of **1.149**, due to the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution* and *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*.

• *Intermediate goods*, whose monthly variation of **0.2%**, was mainly a consequence of the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic chemicals*, *fertilisers and nitrogen compounds*, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*. Its contribution to the general IPRI was **0.055**.

The only industrial sector with a negative contribution to the general index was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly rate of **-0.4%** and a contribution of **-0.104**, mainly due to the decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of May.



#### Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in most Autonomous Communities. The greatest increases were observed in Canarias, País Vasco and Illes Balears, whose annual rates increased 5.0, 2.6, and 2.5 points respectively.

In turn, Extremadura and La Rioja were the only Autonomous Communities whose annual rate decreased, with declines of three and two tenths, respectively.
