Industrial Price Index. Base 2015 June 2018. Provisional data

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The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stands at 4.1%, more than one point above that registered in May

The monthly rate of industrial prices is 1.0%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in the month of June was **4.1%**, more than one point above that registered in May.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors with the greatest positive influence in this increase were:

- *Energy,* with a rate of **12.1%**, almost three points higher than last month, due to the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution,* higher than the previous year, and to the stability of the prices of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products,* compared to the decrease registered in June 2017.
- Intermediate goods, whose variation increased seven tenths to 3.3%. It is worth noting in this evolution the increase in the prices of Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and of Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals, which fell in June of the previous year.

In turn, the only group with a negative contribution that stands out was:


• Capital goods, whose rate was 0.8%, one tenth less than in May, due to the fact that prices of Manufacture of structural metal products and Manufacture of railway locomotives and rolling stock have increased less this month than in 2017.

The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* increased two tenths, to **1.2%**, standing almost three points below that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In June, the monthly variation of the overall IPRI was 1.0%.

By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors that presented a positive contribution to the general index, worth noting were:


• *Energy*, with a rate of **2.7%** and a contribution of **0.861**, due to the increase in the prices of *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*.

Another reason for this variation—though to a lesser extent—was the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains* and of *Manufacture of refined petroleum products*.

• *Intermediate goods*, whose monthly variation of **0.4%**, was mainly a consequence of the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of basic chemicals*, *fertilisers and nitrogen compounds*, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms and of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*. Its contribution to the general IPRI was **0.125**.

In turn, amongst the sectors that presented a negative effect on the general index, the most relevant was:

• **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly rate of 0.0%, which contributed **-0.012**. Of particular note in this evolution was the decrease in the prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.



A more detailed analysis shows the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of June.


Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of the IPRI increased in 15 Autonomous Communities and remained stable in the other two.

The greatest increases were observed in Andalucía, Canarias and Galicia, whose annual rates increased by 2.8, 2.6 and 1.6 points respectively.
