Unpaid Bills of Exchange Statistics (UBE) October 2013. Provisional data

The value of unpaid bills of exchange decreases 36.4% in October, as compared with the same month of the previous year

2.7% of the total expired bills of exchange are unpaid


In October, the number of expired bills of exchange reached 13,792 million euros, 12.5% below that registered in same month of the previous year.

With regards to returned unpaid bills of exchange, the value reached 366 million euros, representing a 36.4% decrease, as compared with the same month of 2012.

Credit materialised in bills of exchange. October 2013

The percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with expired bills of exchange reached 2.7%, three tenths over that registered in September and one point below that registered in the same month of the previous year.



In October, the total value of expired bills of exchange reached 7,195,316, that is, 7.8% less than that registered in the same month of 2012.

The average value of expired bills of exchange reached 1,917 euros, representing a 5.1% decrease in the interannual rate. In turn, the average value of unpaid bills of exchange stood at 1,503 euros, that is, 16.9% below that registered in the same month of the previous year.


Monthly rate evolution

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of data, this chart shows the variation of the unpaid and expired bills of exchange between October and September of the last five years.

This year, the monthly variation of the expired bills of exchange decreases 7.3%. In turn, the monthly variation of the unpaid bills of exchange increases 4.3%, the second lowest monthly rate of the period.





Credit expired by type of bill

In October, 64% of the value of expired bills of exchange corresponded to unpaid portfolio bills of exchange and 36% to debt collection management from clients.

Of the total value of unpaid bills of exchange, 66.5% corresponded to portfolio bills of exchange and 33.5% to bills of exchange in debt collection management.

In October, 2.8% of the total expired bills of exchange of portfolio were unpaid. Likewise, 2.5% of the total expired bills of exchange in debt collection management were unpaid.



Geographical distribution of unpaid bills of exchange

In October, the greatest annual decreases of the value of unpaid bills of exchange were registered in Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-59.8%), Castilla y León (-53.3%) and Castilla-La Mancha (-53.2%). The only Autonomous Community that registered an increase was Cantabria (6.9%).

Annual variation value of unpaid bills of exchange by Autonomous Community



Cantabria (4.2%) was the Autonomous Community that presented the highest percentage of unpaid bills of exchange as compared with the expired bills of exchange. In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.9%) registered the lowest percentage.

In October, Cataluña and Comunidad de Madrid accumulated over half of the total of unpaid bills of exchange (47.7%).
