Statistics on Transfer of Property Rights (STPR)

May 2015. *Provisional data*


In May, the number of property transfers registered is 137,412 properties, that is, 0.1% more than in the same month of 2014

The merchanting of registered dwellings increases by 6.0%, as compared with May of the previous year

The number of property transfers **recorded in the land registries (from public deeds previously registered)** was 137,412 in May, that is, 0.1% more than in the same month of 2014.

Regarding the merchanting of registered properties, the number of transfers was 62,655, with a 2.8% annual increase.

¹ "Other titles" includes land consolidation, horizontal divisions, joint ventures or mixtures of several titles transmission, transmissions without title of acquisition, non recourse debt, foreclosures and court awards.

Merchanting recorded in the land registries

82.7% of the registered merchanting in May corresponded to urban properties and 17.3% to rustic properties. Among the urban properties, 56.8% were merchanting of dwellings.

In May, the number of merchanting of rustic properties decreased by 2.1% in the annual rate, and that of urban properties increased by 3.9%. Within the latter, merchanting of dwellings recorded an annual increase of 6.0%.



Evolution of the monthly rate

In order to contribute to the analysis and interpretation of the data, the following chart shows the variation in the number of merchanting of dwellings between the months of April and May of the last five years. In 2015, the monthly rate was 8.1%.

Registered merchanting on dwellings, by protection system and status

89.8% of transfers of dwellings by merchanting in May were free housing, and 10.2% were protected housing.

In annual terms, the number of transfers of free dwellings by merchanting increased by 5.6%, and that of protected dwellings did so by 9.7%.


21.5% of the dwellings transferred by merchanting in May were new, and 78.5% were used.

The number of transactions on new dwellings decreased by 40.4% as compared to May 2014. In turn, the number of used dwellings increased by 34.7%.

Results by Autonomous Community

In May 2015, the total number of property transfers recorded in the land registries per 100,000 inhabitants² reached its highest value in the Autonomous Community of La Rioja (767), Castilla y León (711) and Aragón (561).

La Rioja (26.2%), Galicia (14.5%) and País Vasco (9.7%) registered the greatest annual variations.

In turn, the Autonomous Communities that registered the lowest annual rates were Castilla-La Mancha (-12.5%) and Aragón (-10.3%).


Regarding the merchanting on registered dwellings, the Autonomous Community with the highest number of transfers per 100,000 inhabitants² were Comunitat Valenciana (116) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (98).

²This data was calculated from the provisional data of the Population Figures on 1 January 2015. Only the population aged 18 to 84 years old was considered.

The Autonomous Communities showing the greatest annual variation rates in the merchanting of dwellings in May were Comunidad Foral de Navarra (32.9%), País Vasco (19.3%), and Galicia (18.5%).

In turn, Canarias (-14.0%), Castilla-La Mancha (-10.9%) and Extremadura (-3.2%) registered the most negative annual rates.
