February 2015. *Provisional data*


**The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index<sup>1</sup> stands at 0.9%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects**

**The annual rate stands at 0.4% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at 0.8% in the original series**

**Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover**

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of February and January 2015 was 0.9%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was five tenths higher than that of the previous month.


**Turnover General Index**

By economic destination of the goods, all goods recorded positive monthly rates. It is worth noting the increase of Energy (9.1%).



## Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 0.4% in February, as compared to the same month of the previous year. This rate was 1.3 points higher than that registered in January 2015.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of 0.8%, that is, 4.8 points higher than that registered in January 2015.

### General Industrial Turnover Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors analysed registered positive annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Capital goods registered the greatest increase (9.5%), whereas Energy had an annual variation of -25.3%.



**Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series**

By geographical destination of sales, in February positive rates were recorded in two out of three markets analysed. It is worth noting the increase of foreign market in the Euro Zone 5.7%.


**Industrial turnover indices: General and by market

**Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series**

As compared to February 2014, turnover increased in nine Autonomous Communities and decreased in the remaining eight. The greatest increase was registered in La Rioja (14.9%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Andalucía (-11.2%).
