

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index stands at -1.0%, after adjusting the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 1.3% in the seasonally and calendar adjusted series and at 4.2% in the original series


Monthly evolution of the Industry Turnover

The monthly variation of the General Industry Turnover Index (ITI) between the months of September and August 2014 was -1.0%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was 1.8 points lower than that of the previous month.



By economic destination of the goods, four out of five sectors registered negative monthly rates. Durable consumer goods registered the greatest decrease (–5.7%), followed by Capital goods (–2.0%). The only sector that registered an increase was Energy (2.4%).



Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover indices

The General Industrial Turnover Index (ITI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 1.3% in September, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was one tenth higher than that registered in August 2014.

The original series of the ITI registered an annual variation of 4.2%, that is, 5.5 points higher than that registered in August 2014.



By economic destination of the goods, three out of five sectors analysed registered negative annual rates, after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects. Among them, worth noting was the decrease of Durable consumer goods (–3.3%).

Annual evolution of the Industrial Turnover Indices by market. Original series

By geographical destination of sales, two out of three markets analysed registered positive annual rates in September. Worth noting was the increase in the domestic market (7.0%) and the decrease in the foreign market non euro zone (–7.8%).


Industrial turnover indices: General and by market Annual rate



Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates of the Industrial Turnover. Original series

In September, turnover increased in 11 Autonomous Communities and decreased in six. The greatest increase was registered in Región de Murcia (29.0%) and the greatest decrease was registered in Canarias (–26.1%).
