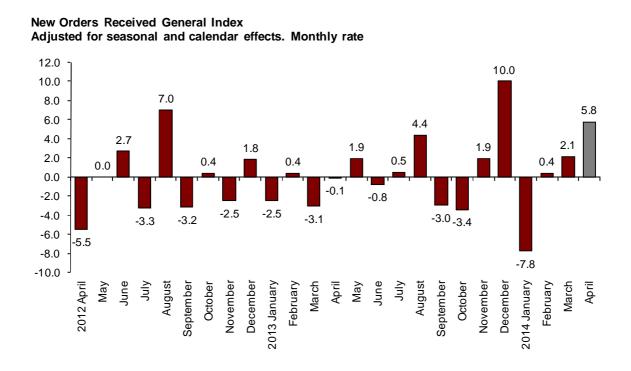
Industrial New Orders Received Indices (INORI). Base 2010 April 2014. *Provisional data*

The monthly variation of the General Industrial New Orders Received Index stands at 5.8% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects

The annual rate stands at 11.4% in the series adjusted for the seasonal and calendar effects and at 6.9% in the original series

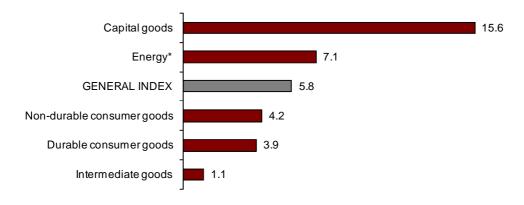
Monthly evolution of New Orders Received

The monthly variation of the Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI) between April and March 2014 stood at 5.8%, after adjusting for the seasonal and calendar effects. This rate was more than three points and a half higher than that registered in March.



By economic destination of the goods, all the sectors analysed recorded an increase in their orders received, as compared with the previous month. Worth noting was Capital goods, which increased 15.6%.

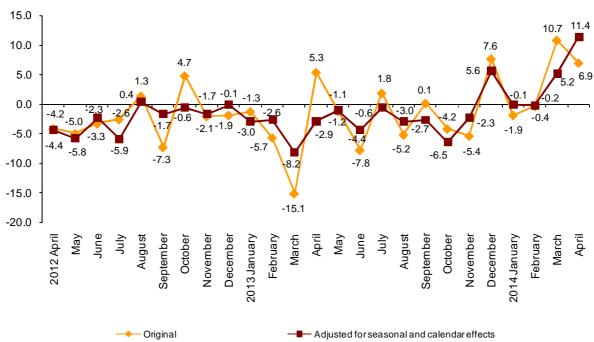

Annual evolution of the New Orders Received

The Industrial New Orders Received Index (INORI), after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, registered a variation of 11.4% in April, as compared with the same month of the previous year. This rate was more than six points higher than that registered in March.

The original series of the INORI registered an annual variation of 6.9%, that is, 3.8 points lower than that registered in the previous month.

Industry New Orders Received General Index Annual rates



By economic destination of the goods, all the sectors analysed recorded positive annual rates after adjusting for seasonal and calendar effects, in particular Capital goods, with an increase of 42.5%.

Annual evolution of New Orders Received by destination market. Original series

New orders received increased in the euro zone and in the domestic market, as compared with April 2013. In turn, they registered a decrease in the non euro zone.

Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rate of the New Orders Received. Original series

In April, seven Autonomous Communities registered increases in their New Orders Received whereas the remaining 10 recorded decreases. The greatest increase was registered in Principado de Asturias (361.4%) and the greatest drop was recorded in Canarias (-30.1%).
