Housing Price Index (HPI). Base 2007 Third quarter 2015

The annual rate of the HPI stands at 4.5% in the third quarter of 2015


The price of housing increases 0.7% as compared with the previous quarter

Annual evolution of housing prices

The annual rate of the Housing Price Index (HPI) in the third quarter of 2015 increased one point and a half, standing at **4.5%**.

By type of housing, the annual variation of **new housing** stood at **4.3%**, six tenths lower that registered in the previous quarter.

In turn, the annual rate for second-hand housing increased 7 tenths, reaching 4.5%.




Annual evolution of the HPI

General index, new housing and second-hand housing




Quarterly Housing Price Evolution

The general HPI variation in the third quarter 2015 was 0.7%.



Evolution of the quarterly rate of the HPI in the last two years

By type of housing, new housing prices increased by **0.6%** between the second and the third quarter 2015. In turn, second-hand housing prices increased by **0.7%** in the quarterly rate.



Evolution of the quarterly rate of the HPI in the last two years by type of housing (new/second-hand)




Results by Autonomous Community. Annual variation rates

Annual rate of the HPI. Base 2007

The annual rate increased in the majority of the Autonomous Communities in the third quarter 2015. The greatest increases in this variation were registered in Principado de Asturias (3.5%) and Extremadura (3.3%), with increases of 2.6 and 2.4 points, respectively.

In turn, the biggest decreases in this variation were registered in País Vasco (nine tenths lower, reaching 1.0%) and Comunitat Valenciana (with a six tenths lower rate, reaching 2.1%).



■ 3Q 2015



Results by Autonomous Community. Quarterly variation rates

The quarterly variation of the HPI was positive in most Autonomous Communities in the third quarter 2015. The greatest increases were registered in Illes Balears (3.1%) and Principado de Asturias (1.8%).

In turn, Comunidad Foral de Navarra (-1.1%) and Aragón (-1.0%) were the Communities that registered the lowest quarterly rates.
