Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
Febrero 2016. *Datos provisionales*

**Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
aumentan un 11,6% en febrero respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 5,6 millones en febrero, un 11,6% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 13,8% y las de no residentes un 11,0%.

La estancia media es de 6,0 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante los dos primeros meses de 2016 las pernoctaciones aumentan un 10,0% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior

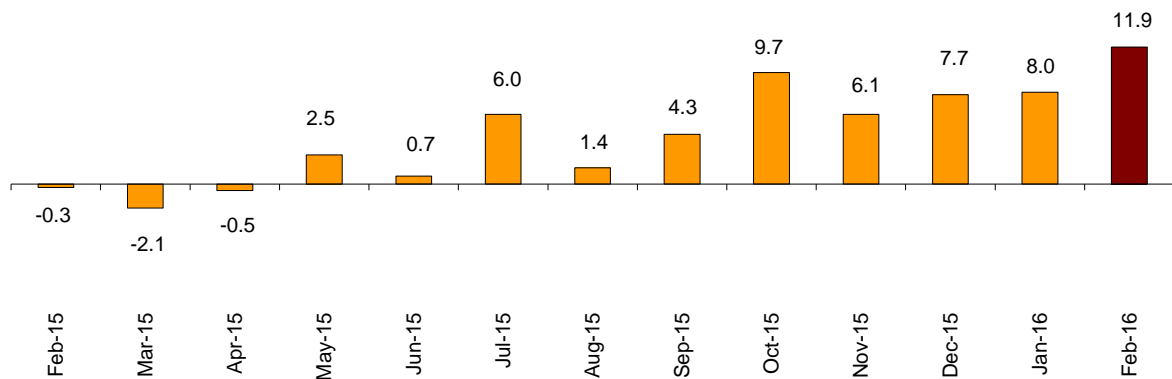
Apartamentos turísticos

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 11,9% en febrero. Las de residentes suben un 20,4% y las de no residentes un 10,5%.

La estancia media baja un 3,1% respecto a febrero de 2015, situándose en 7,1 pernoctaciones por viajero.

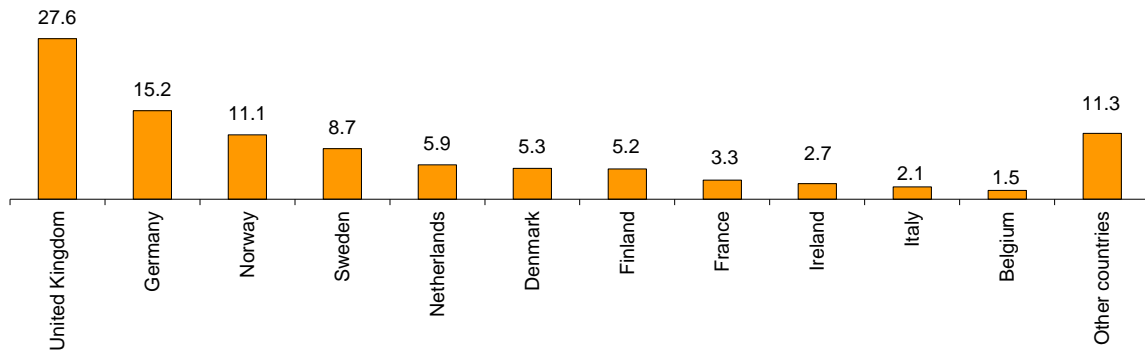
En febrero se ocupan el 38,2% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 3,7% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 41,5%, con un incremento del 5,2%.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 85,4% del total. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 966.126 pernoctaciones, un 10,4% más que en febrero de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 533.065 pernoctaciones, un 0,6% menos.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,7 millones de pernoctaciones, un 8,9% más que en febrero de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 87,3% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Gran Canaria es el destino preferido, con 969.044 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 92,3% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en febrero son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Mogán.

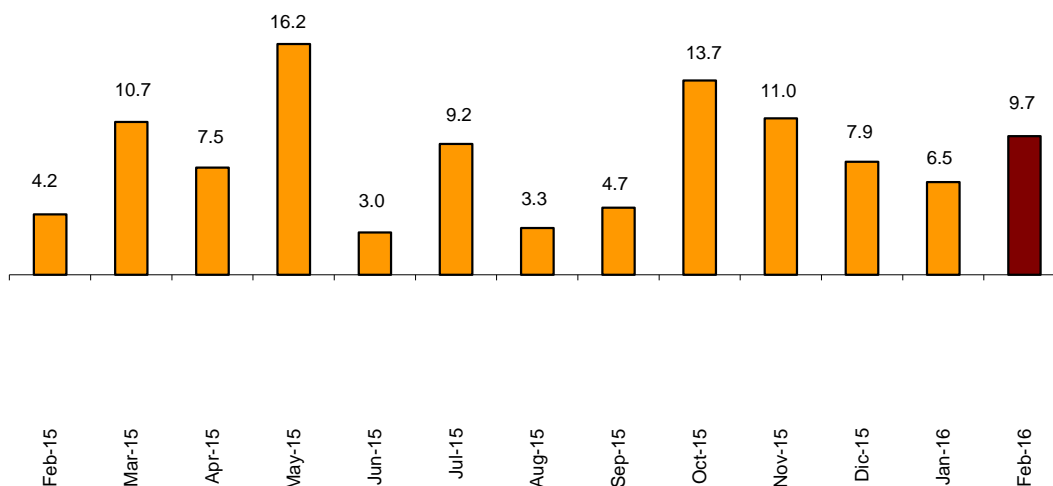
Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en febrero un incremento anual del 9,7% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 4,4% y las de no residentes un 11,2%.

Durante el mes de febrero se ocupan el 37,4% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 0,7% más. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 39,2%, con un aumento anual del 1,1%.

El 78,9% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con el 35,9% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 17,6% más que en febrero de 2015.

Comunitat Valenciana es el destino preferido en campings, con 555.259 pernoctaciones, un 13,7% más que en febrero de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, el 60,8% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Blanca es el destino preferido, con 309.233 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 82,4% de las parcelas ofertadas.

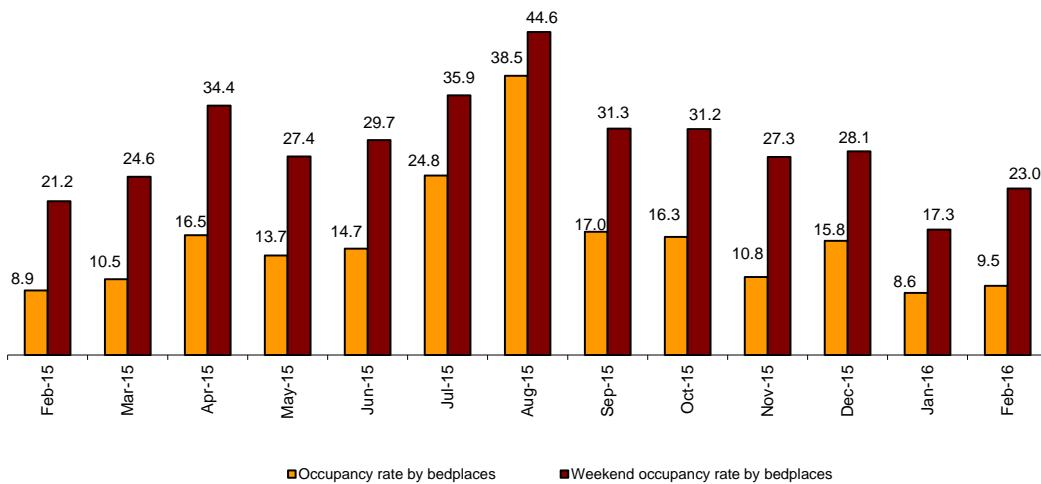
Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Cartagena y Marbella.

Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 14,7% en febrero. Las de residentes suben un 11,4% y las de no residentes un 27,9%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 9,5% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 7,0% respecto a febrero de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 23,0%, con un incremento del 8,2%.

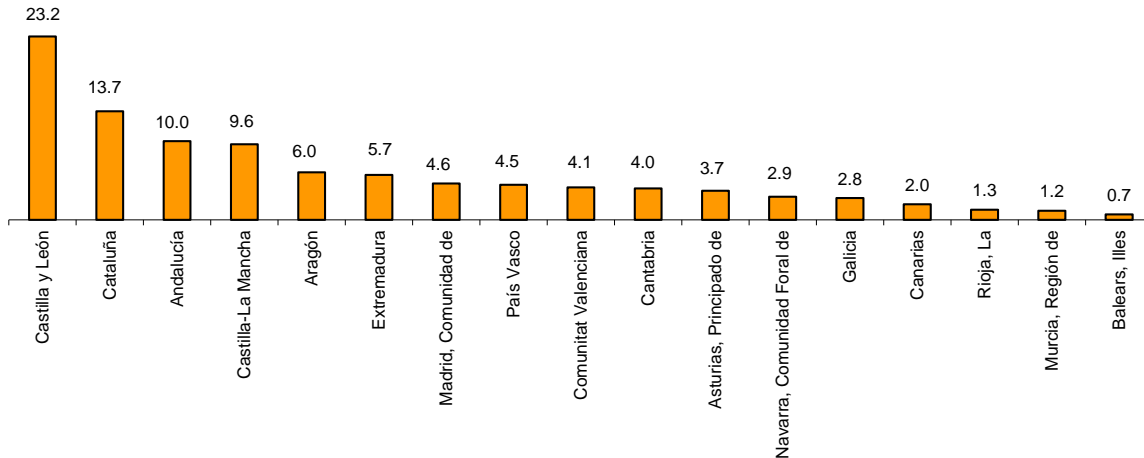
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



Por comunidades, Castilla y León es el destino preferido, con 69.854 pernoctaciones, un 7,1% más que en febrero de 2015. Canarias alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 40,1% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, Pirineus es el principal destino, con 20.484 pernoctaciones. La isla de Lanzarote alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 51,1% de las plazas ofertadas.

Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en febrero un aumento anual del 8,6%. Las de residentes suben un 4,1% y las de no residentes un 17,5%.

Se ocupan el 19,5% de las plazas, un 13,0% más que en febrero de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 31,7%, con un aumento del 27,9%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 49.227 pernoctaciones, un 21,2% más que en febrero de 2015. Comunidad de Madrid alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 34,9% de las plazas ofertadas.

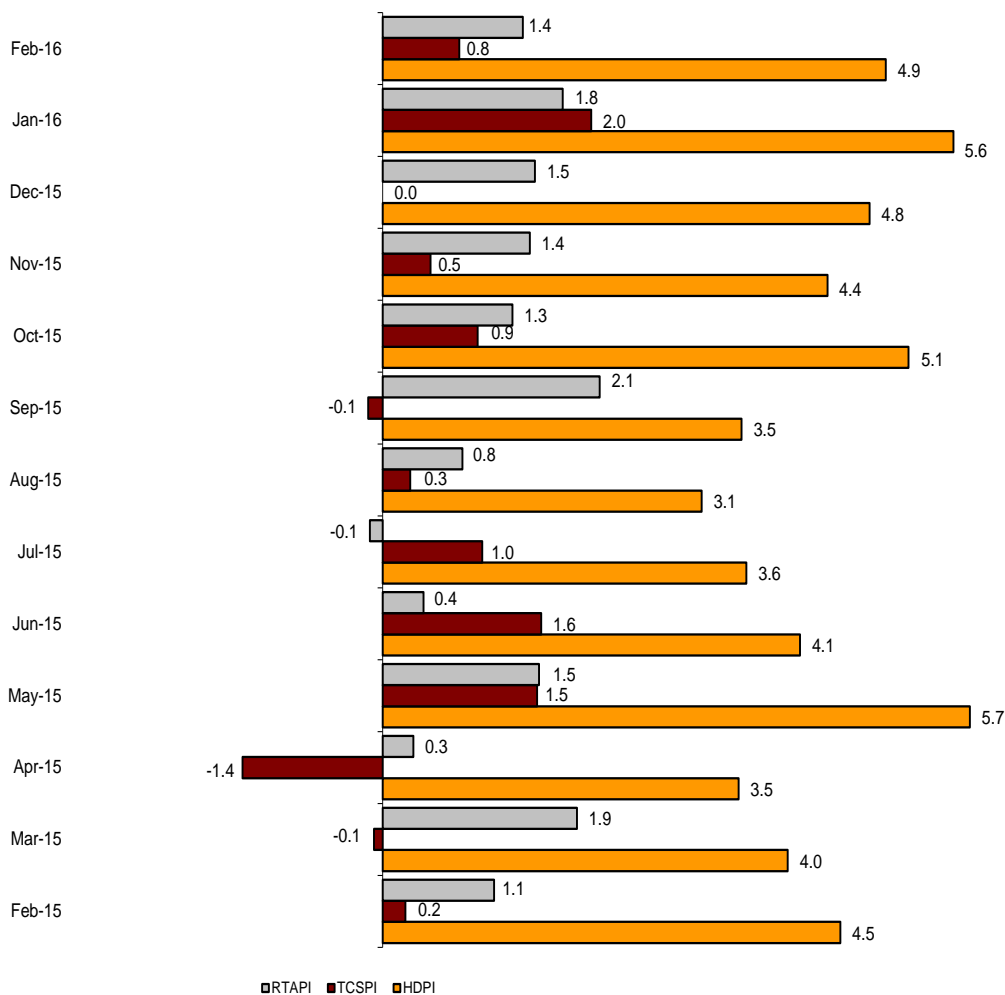
Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 4,9% respecto a febrero de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (59,3%), sube un 4,7%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) se incrementa un 0,8% en tasa anual. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en febrero (37,7%), sube un 2,0% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 1,4% en febrero. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 74,0% del peso total, sube un 1,5% en tasa anual.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

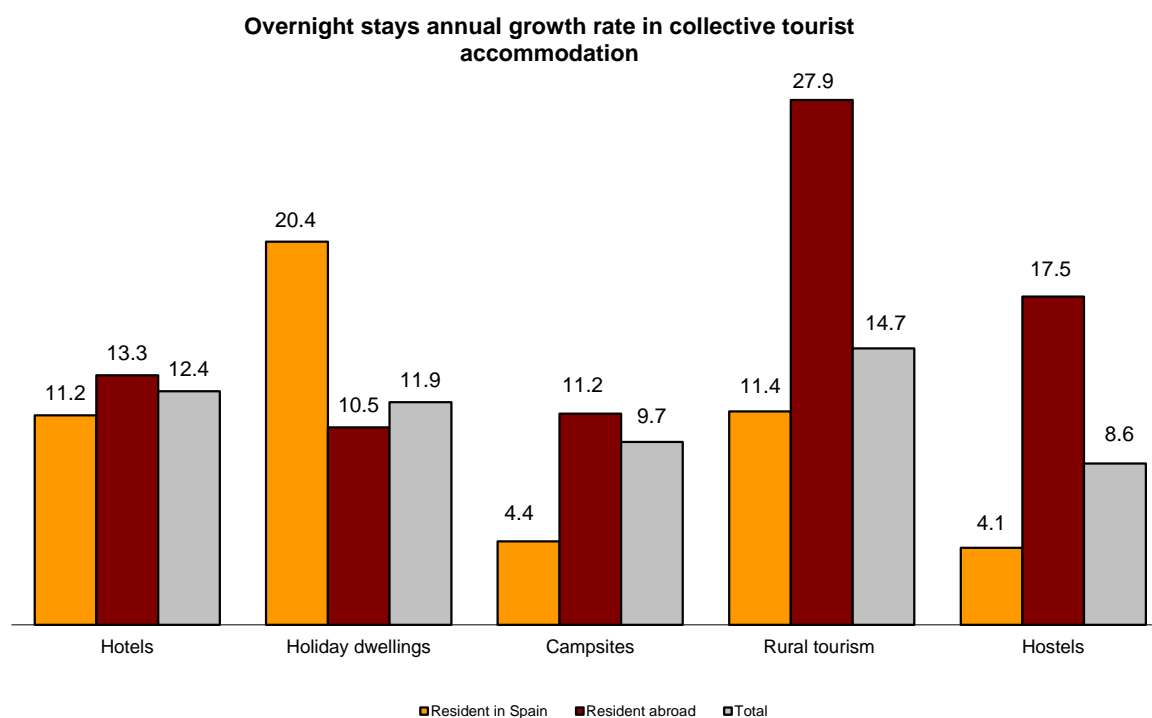
Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles¹, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 12,2% en febrero en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 11,6% y las de no residentes un 12,6%.

La estancia media baja un 0,6%, situándose en 3,4 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 74% corresponde a hoteles y un 26% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.



Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 25,4% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (19,4%) y el francés (6,5%).

Canarias es el destino preferido, con 8,2 millones de pernoctaciones (un 9,2% más que en febrero de 2015). Le siguen Andalucía, con más de 3,3 millones (y un aumento anual del 13,6%) y Cataluña, con 2,6 millones (y un incremento del 15,4%).
