Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
March 2014. *Provisional data*

5.6 million overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation¹ are registered in March, that is, 12.7% as compared with the same month of 2013

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 5.6 millions in March, that is, 12.7% less than in the same month of 2013. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 46.9% and those of non-residents increased 4.8%. The average stay stands at 6.2 overnights per traveller.

In the first quarter 2014, overnight stays decreased by 1.4% as compared with the same period of the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings¹

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 2.8% in March. Those of residents decreased 36.3%, whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased 5.9%. The average stay increased 13.9% standing at 7.6 overnight stays per traveller.



In March, 36.2% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.4% more than in the same month of 2013. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 38.3%, with an annual increase of 0.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 86.6% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with over a million overnight stays, 2.7% more than in March 2013. The following country of origin was Germany, with 605,913 overnight stays, 5.4% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.9 million overnight stays, 0.3% more than in March 2013. This Autonomous Community registered the highest occupancy rate with 82.8% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Gran Canaria was the preferred destination, with over a million overnight stays. Catalunya Central reached the highest occupancy rate with 87.3% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in March were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.


Campsites¹

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 29.9% in March. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 58.4%, whereas those of non-resident travellers did so by 0.1%.

During the month of March, 33.8% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, a 7.4% increase. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 35.8%, with an annual increase of 1.4%.

69.6% of the overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 33.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 6.6% more than in March 2013.

Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with 484,133 overnight stays, 7.0% more than in March 2013.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 60.9% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 258,610 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 70.0% of the pitches offered, the highest rate by tourist areas.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural Tourism Accommodation¹

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual decrease of 40.8% in March. Residents' overnight stays decreased 47.7% while those of non-residents increased 1.5%.

Regarding the rural tourism accommodation, 8.5% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, 38.8% increase as compared to March 2013. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 19.3%, with a decrease of 23.1%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 67,884 overnight stays, 50.1% less than in March 2013. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate as well, with 31.9% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Majorca was the main destination, with 26,525 overnight stays. In turn, the island of Lanzarote reached the greatest occupancy rate, with 42.2% of the bedplaces offered.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 1.0%, as compared to March 2013. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (56.5%), increased 2.5%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased 2.5% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for March (57.0%), decreased by 3.4%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.6% decrease in March. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 65.5% of the total weight, decreased 0.6%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation


Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 8.0% decrease in March, as compared with the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays of residents decreased 22.6%, whereas those of non-residents increased 2.4%.

The average stay increased 2.4% as compared to March 2013, standing at 3.5 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 23.7% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.3%) and France (5.9%).

Canarias was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 8.3 million overnight stays (that is, 3.5% more than that registered in March 2013), followed by Andalucía, with over 3.3 million overnight stays (that is, 10.7% less than that registered in the same month of the previous year) and Cataluña, with over 3 million overnight stays (14.2% less than in the same month of 2013).
