Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
March 2015. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation¹ increase 2.5%
in March as compared to the same month of 2014**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 5.8 million in March, that is, 2.5% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 20.8% while those of non-residents decreased by 2.6%. The average stay stood at 5.5 overnight stays per traveller.

Overnight stays increased by 1.5% in the first quarter, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Since Easter Week is celebrated during March and April in 2015, and in 2014 it was celebrated in April, it is necessary to wait for the results of these surveys from the following month in order to analyse the two months combined.

Holiday Dwellings

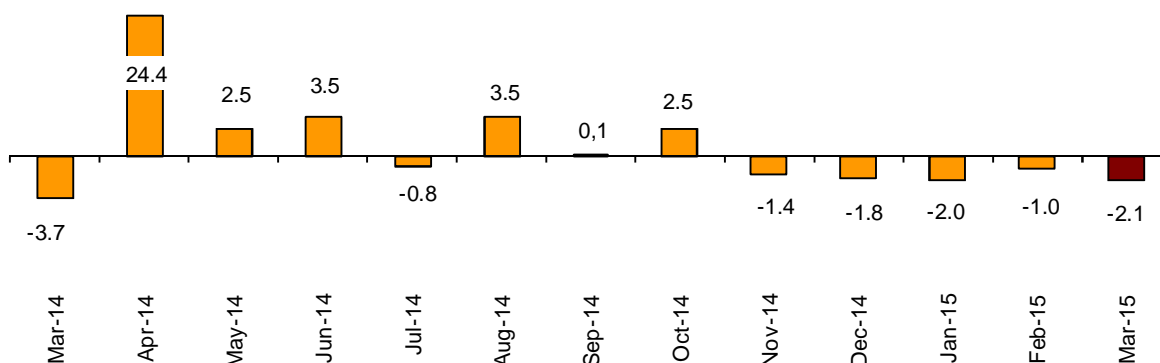
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 2.1% in March. Those of residents increased by 12.3% and those of non-residents decreased by 4.3%.

The average stay decreased by 4.6%, standing at 7.1 overnight stays per traveller.

In March, 35.4% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.9% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 38.2%, with an increase of 0.4%.

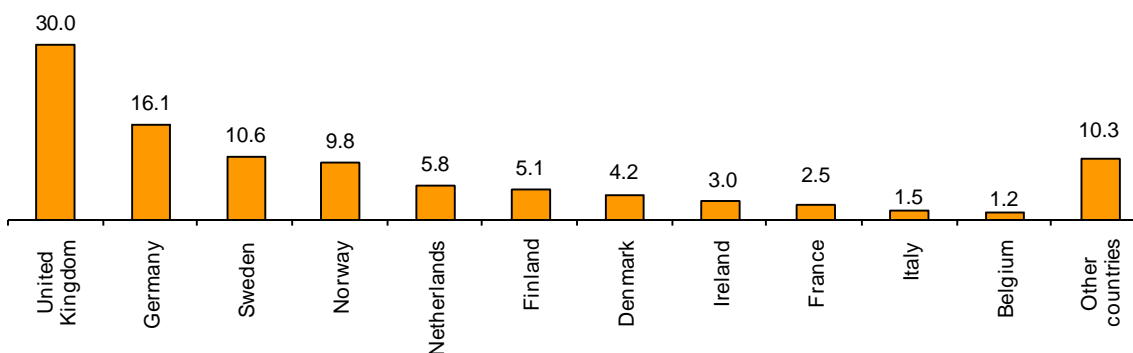

Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 84.4% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than a million overnight stays, that is, 1.4% less than in March 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 556,448 overnight stays, that is, a 6.6% decrease.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.7 million overnight stays, 6.5% less than in March 2014. This Autonomous Community also registered the highest occupancy rate, with 82.5% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, Gran Canaria island was the preferred destination, with 903,026 overnight stays. Lanzarote island registered the highest occupancy rate, with 86.2% of the holiday dwellings offered.

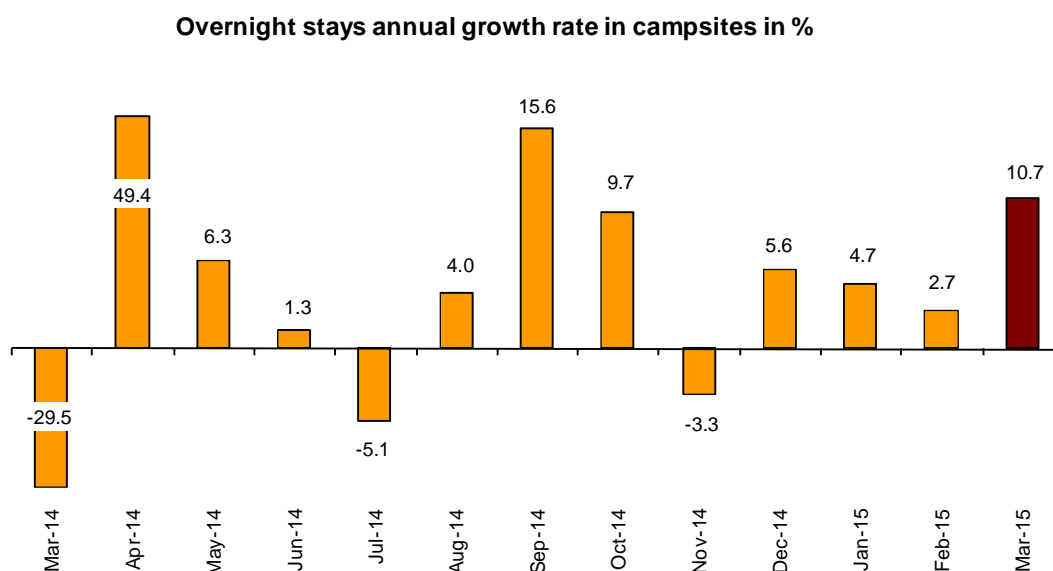
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in March were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Mogán.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 10.7% in March as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 26.7% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 3.6%.

In March, 34.2% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 0.7% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 35.4%, with a 1.3% annual decrease.

64.6% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 33.9% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 4.8% more than in March 2014.



Comunitat Valenciana was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with 511,602 overnight stays, 6.0% more than in the same month of the previous year.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 59.3% of the pitches offered.

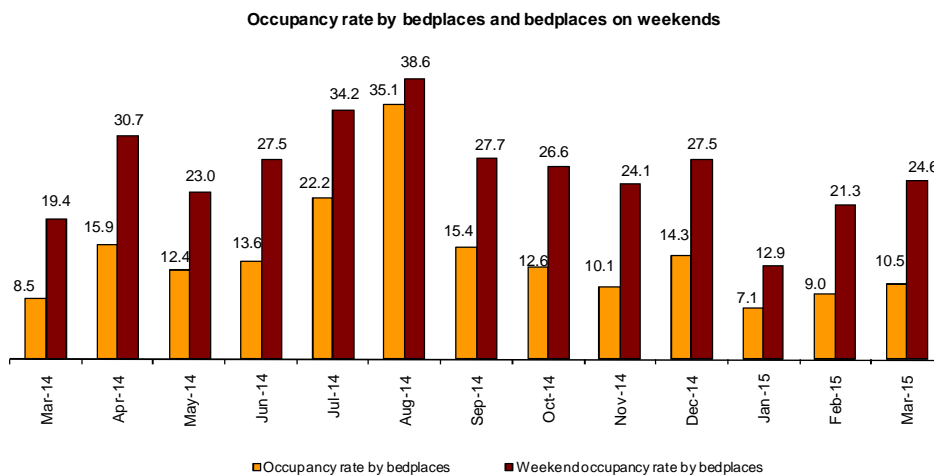
By tourist areas, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with 267,964 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 71.8% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Marbella.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

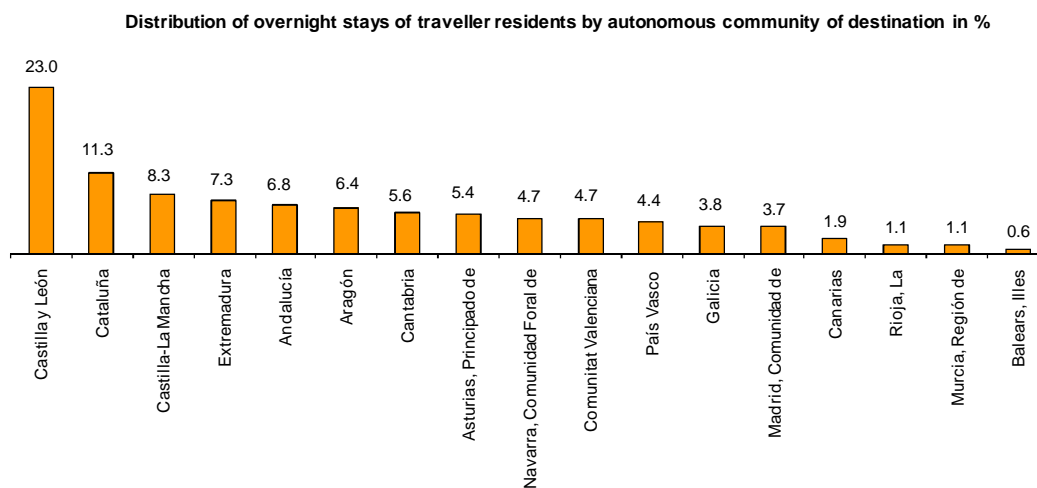
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 23.4% in March. Residents' overnight stays increased by 29.6% and those of non-residents did so by 4.5%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 10.5% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 22.4% increase as compared to March 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.6%, with a 26.9% increase.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 82,715 overnight stays, 21.0% more than in the same month of the previous year. Canarias reached the highest occupancy rate, with 33.0% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Mallorca Island was the main destination, with 28,559 overnight stays. Parque Nacional del Teide reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.6% of the bedplaces offered.



Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 24.0% in March. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 25.8% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 20.5%.

In March, 23.6% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 17.4% more than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 31.5%, with a 5.3% annual decrease.

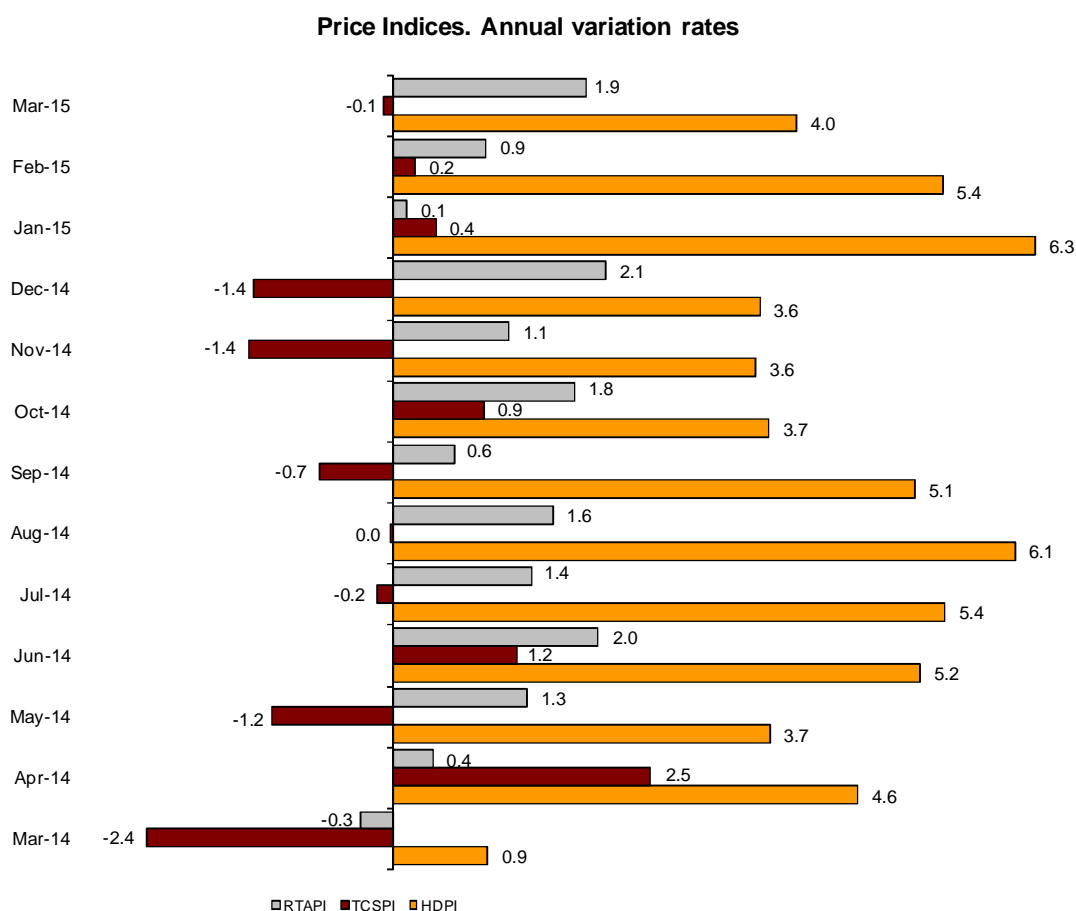
By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 65,376 overnight stays, 8.0% more than in March 2014. In turn, Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 35.1% of the bedplaces offered.

Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 4.0%, as compared to March 2014. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (58.8%), increased by 4.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 0.1% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for February (43.9%), decreased by 1.1% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 1.9% increase in March. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 72.0% of the total weight, increased by 2.7% in the annual rate.



Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

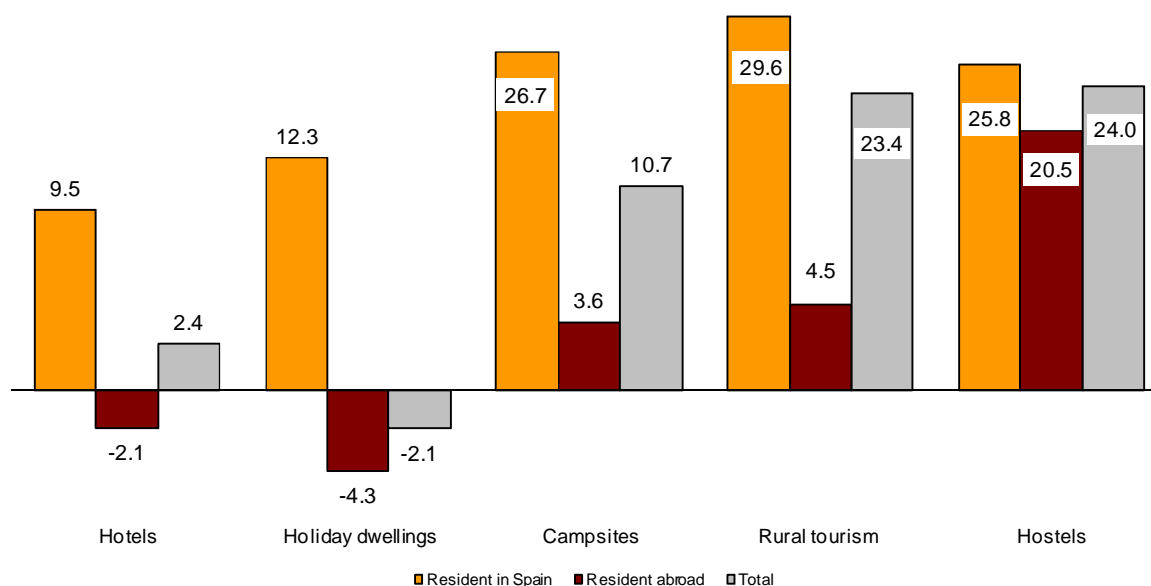
In March, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 2.5% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 11.2%, while those of non-residents decreased by 2.2%. The average stay decreased 4.1%, standing at 3.4 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 24.8% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.5%) and France (5.8%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with more than eight million overnight stays (8.6% below that registered in March 2014), followed by Andalucía, with over 3.7 million overnight stays (11.1% more), and Cataluña, with over 3.2 million (6.1% more).
