

Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey

April 2015. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation¹ increase 2.3% in April as compared to the same month of 2014

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 7.3 million in April, that is, 2.3% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 2.2% and those of non-residents did so by 2.3%. The average stay stood at 4.5 overnight stays per traveller.

Overnight stays increased by 1.7% in the first four-month period, as compared with the same period of the previous year.

Since Easter Week is celebrated during March and April in 2015, and in 2014 it was celebrated in April, it is desirable to analyse the **aggregated period March-April**. An increase of 2.4% is observed within this period regarding overnight stays, as compared with the same two-month period of 2014. Overnight stays for residents increased by 7.7% during this period, and those of non-residents decreased by 0.2%.


Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 0.5% in April. Those of residents decreased by 0.5% and those of non-residents did so by 0.6%. In **March-April** period, overnight stays decreased by 1.3% as compared with the same period in 2014. Those of residents increased by 4.1% whereas those of non-residents decreased by 2.5%.

In April, 32.6% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.2% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 37.3%, with a decrease of 1.8%.



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 76.1% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays, that is, 1.4% more than in April 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 505,435 overnight stays, that is, a 8.5% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 2.1 million overnight stays, 8.3% less than in April 2014. This Autonomous Community also registered the highest occupancy rate, with 72.4% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, Tenerife Island was the preferred destination, with 733,500 overnight stays. Barcelona registered the highest occupancy rate, with 80.7% of the holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in April were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.


Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 7.5% in April as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 3.8% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 13.9%. In **March-April** period overnight stays increased by 8.6%

In April, 32.5% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 3.8% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 34.9%, with a 0.5% annual increase.

39.2% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 27.6% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 14.1% more than in April 2014.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with 893.807 overnight stays, 5.8% more than in the same month of the previous year.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 65.3% of the pitches offered.


By tourist areas, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination, with 340,335 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 61.8% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Tarragona.

Rural Tourism Accommodation


Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 4.8% in April. Residents' overnight stays increased by 5.3% and those of non-residents did so by 3.1%. In **March-April** period overnight stays increased by 11.2%

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 16.5% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 4.3% increase as compared to April 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 34.4%, with a 12.4% increase.



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 144,663 overnight stays, 7.6% more than in April 2014. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 39.8% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Mallorca Island was the main destination, with 56,605 overnight stays and an occupancy rate of 41.7% of the bedplaces offered.



Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 0.6% in April. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 5.7% and those of non-resident travellers increased by 16.3%. In **March-April** period the overnight stays increased by 10.2%

In April, 26.8% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 2.8% more than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 38.0%, with a 6.8% annual decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 78,413 overnight stays, 6.4% less than in April 2014. In turn, Comunidad de Madrid reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.5% of the bedplaces offered.


Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 3.5%, as compared to April 2014. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.1%), increased by 5.5%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) decreased by 1.4% in the annual rate. The *bungalow* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for April (38.2%), decreased by 3.2% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.3% increase in April. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 58.2% of the total weight, increased by 0.8% in the annual rate.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In April, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels², holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 3.2% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 4.8%, while those of non-residents did so by 2.2%. In **March-April** period overnight stays increased by 2.9%.


The average stay decreased 1.4%, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 25.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (21.4%) and France (10.7%).

Canarias was the preferred destination, with more than seven million overnight stays (4.1% below that registered in April 2014), followed by Cataluña, with over 5.4 million overnight stays (5.2% more), and Andalucía, with over 4.9 million (2.4% more).
