Non-hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey May 2010. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation register an increase of 1.4%* in May as compared with the same month of 2009

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 6.4 million in May, 1.4% more than in the same month of 2009. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased 2.7%, and those made by travellers not resident in Spain increased 3.8%.

The average stay decreased 2.1% as compared with May 2009, standing at 4.7 nights per traveller.

During the first five months of 2010, overnight stays decreased 2.6% as compared with the same period the previous year.

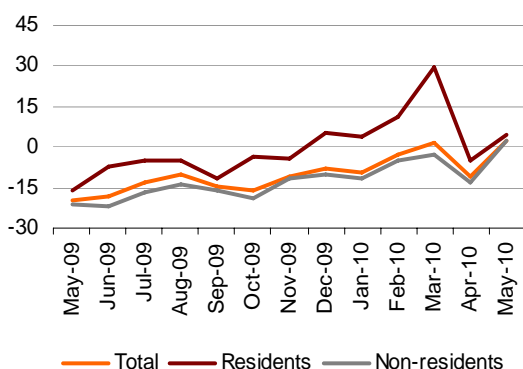

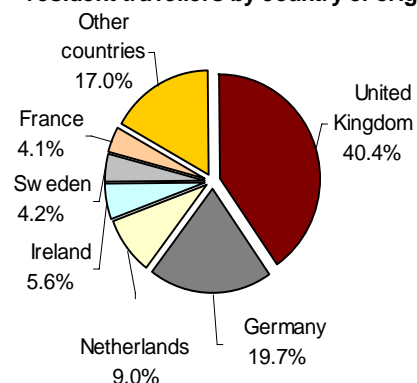
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded four million in May, representing a 2.6% increase as compared with the same month the previous year. This increase in overnight stays took place for both residents, whose interannual rate stood at 4.2%, and non-residents, with an interannual variation of 2.1%.

* Due to the update made in the directory of rural tourism accommodation in Canarias, the data published as of June 2009 (for Canarias and the national total) cannot be directly compared to those published last year. To bridge this gap in the series, linking coefficients have been created to allow users to compare data from different years. The coefficients will be published monthly on the INE website in the section dedicated to this statistical operation, in a specific section entitled linking coefficients.

Available holiday dwellings increased 1.1%, reaching 474,154 bedplaces. This month, 27.2% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 1.4% more than in May 2009. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 30.5%, with an increase of 2.6%. In turn, 40.5% of the total available holiday dwellings were occupied, for an interannual increase of 2.9%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 77.3% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.2 million of overnight stays, 5.7% less than in May the previous year. The following country of origin was Germany, with 610,659 overnight stays, 3.5% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.6 million overnight stays, 7.4% more than in May 2009. The second destination of choice was Illes Balears, with 865,898 overnight stays, 5.5% less.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Illes Balears and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. In turn, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Comunidad de Madrid showed the highest occupancy rate, with 65.9% of available holiday dwellings. It was followed by País Vasco (52.1%) and Andalucía (45.0%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with 631,862 overnight stays. Costa del Sol reached the greatest occupancy (55.3%).

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

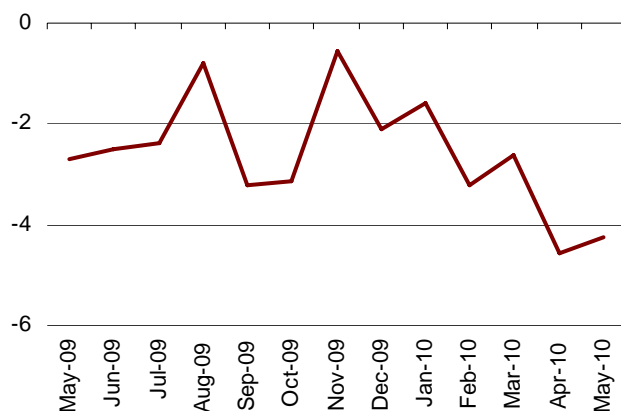
Holiday Dwelling Price Index Evolution

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index registered a 4.2% decrease in May, a rate 0.3 points higher than that recorded the previous month.

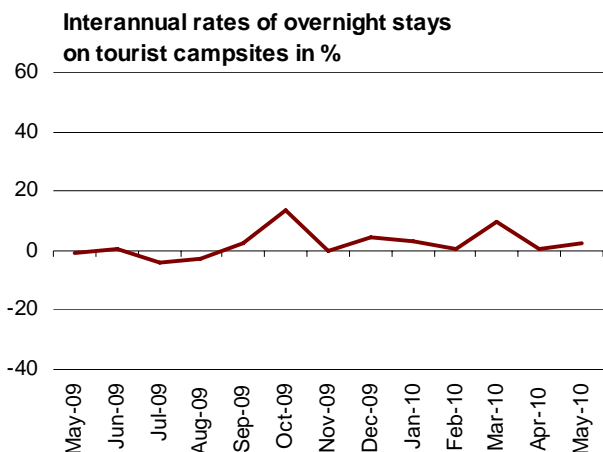
The rate for *tour-operators and travel agencies*, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (54.4%), decreased 4.9% in the interannual rate.

By modality, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weighting was 60.5%, decreased their prices 4.2%.

Holiday Campsites



Tourist campsites exceeded 1.9 million overnight stays in May, representing an interannual increase of 2.8%. Overnight stays of resident travellers decreased 3.7%, while those of non-resident travellers increased 10.1%.

Tourist campsites offered 599,271 bedplaces, 0.5% more than in May 2009. 28.4% of the available lots were occupied, 5.7% less. The weekend occupancy rate by lot reached 32.1%, that is, 5.6% less than in May 2009.

50.3% of overnight stays on tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 28.7% of overnight stays by non-residents (27.3% more than in May 2009). The following country of origin was The United Kingdom.

Cataluña was the preferred destination for camping, with 949,692 overnight stays, for a 4.3% increase more in the interannual rate. Comunitat Valenciana was the second choice of destination, with 130,905 overnight stays, indicating an increase of 18.4%.

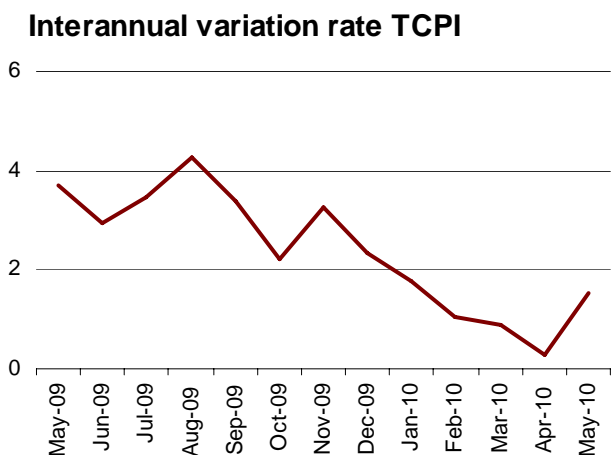
The preferred destinations for both resident travellers and non-residents were Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía.

La Rioja reached the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites in May, with 55.9% of the available lots occupied. It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (45.8%) and Comunitat Valenciana (44.0%).

By tourist area, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 407,876 overnight stays. Costa Maresme reached the highest occupancy (56.1%).

The tourist destinations with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Salou and Castelló d'Empúries.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index experienced interannual growth of 1.6% in May. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (59.7%), presented an increase of 0.1%.

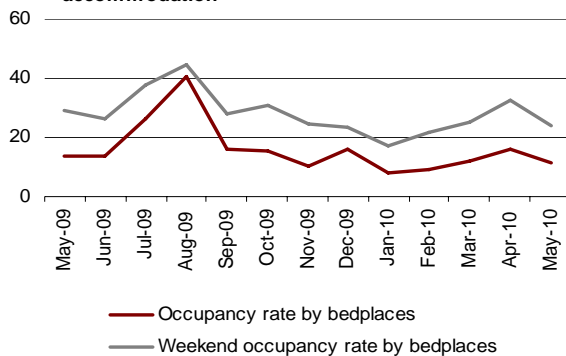
Regarding category, *luxury and first class*, with a weighting of 52.3% this month, registered an interannual increase of 0.4%.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

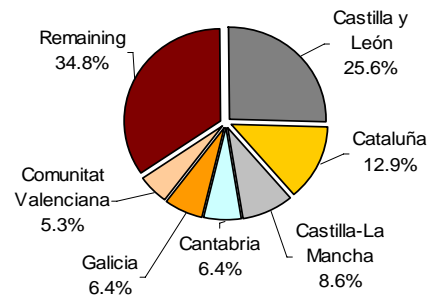
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation reached 482,336 in May, indicating an interannual decrease of 11.4%*. Resident overnight stays decreased 14.6%, and non-resident overnight stays increased 0.1%.

Rural tourism accommodation offered 133,668 bedplaces, 3.4% more than in May 2009. 11.6% of these bedplaces were occupied, representing a 14.2% decrease. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 24.0%, that is, 17.4% less in the interannual rate.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with 100,825 overnight stays, 10.3% less than in May 2009. It was followed by Illes Balears, with 58,925 overnight stays, 12.5% more.

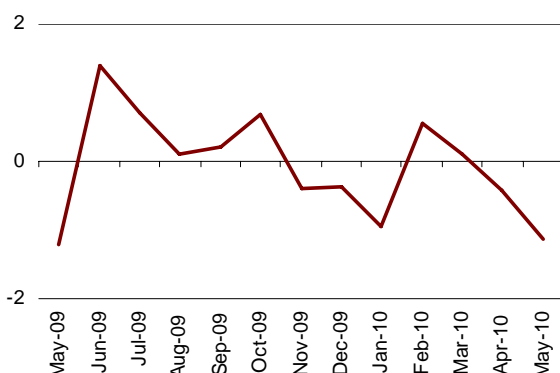
Among non-residents, Illes Balears was the preferred destinations. In turn, the destinations with most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Cantabria.

Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate in rural tourism accommodation, with 42.3% of available bedplaces. It was followed by País Vasco (18.1%) and La Rioja (15.2%).

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 51,265 overnight stays in May. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy (43.4%).

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index experienced an interannual decrease of 1.1% in May.

The *weekend* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (63.1%), fell 1.3%. By rent modality, *complete use*, with a weighting of 56.7%, recorded an interannual decrease of 0.7% in May.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

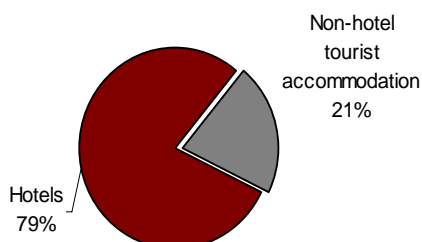
Overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered an **interannual decrease of 4.8%* in May**. Overnight stays by residents increased 3.5%, and non-resident stays 5.6%.

The average stay decreased 0.6% in May, standing at 3.3 nights per traveller. Travellers and overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation were:

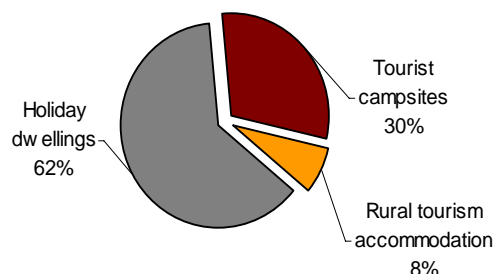

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in May, 79% were accounted for at hotels and 21% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.5% of the total number of non-residents overnight stays), Germany (26.5%), and France (7.5%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 6.3 million overnight stays (4.6% more than in May 2009). It was followed by Cataluña, with more than 5.6 million overnight stays (6.3% more), and Canarias, with more than 5 million overnight stays (6.5% more).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Illes Balears, Canarias and Cataluña. In turn, Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
