Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
May 2015. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 6.8%
in May as compared to the same month of 2014**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 8 million in May, that is, 6.8% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 8.3% and those of non-residents did so by 6.1%.

The average stay stood at 4.4 overnight stays per traveller.

During the five first months of 2015, overnight stays increased by 3.0% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

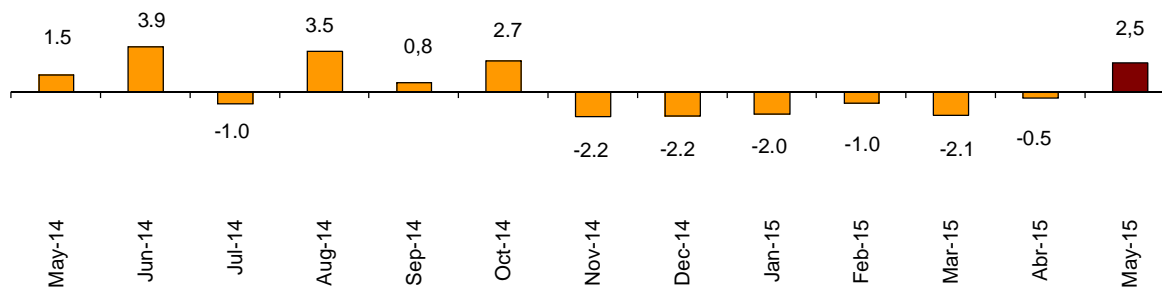
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 2.5% in May. Those of residents increased by 5.0% and those of non-residents did so by 1.9%.

The average stay decreased 4.4% as compared with May 2014, and stood at 5.5 overnight stays per traveller.

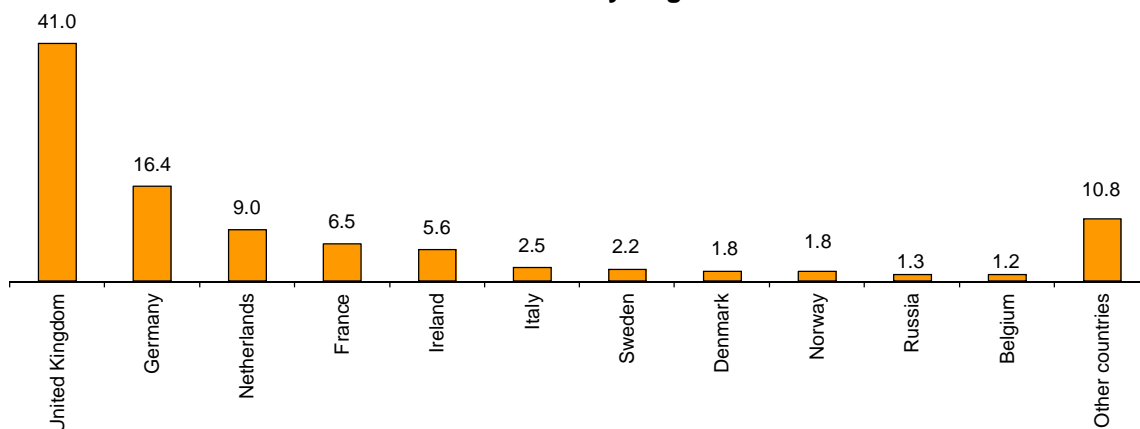
In May, 31.3% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.6% more than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 35.8%, with an increase of 4.1%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 79.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.5 million overnight stays, that is, 4.8% less than in May 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 623,675 overnight stays, that is, a 6.9% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays, 0.4% more than in May 2014. Comunidad de Madrid registered the highest occupancy rate, with 73.4% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 628,485 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote registered the highest occupancy rate, with 70.1% of the holiday dwellings offered.

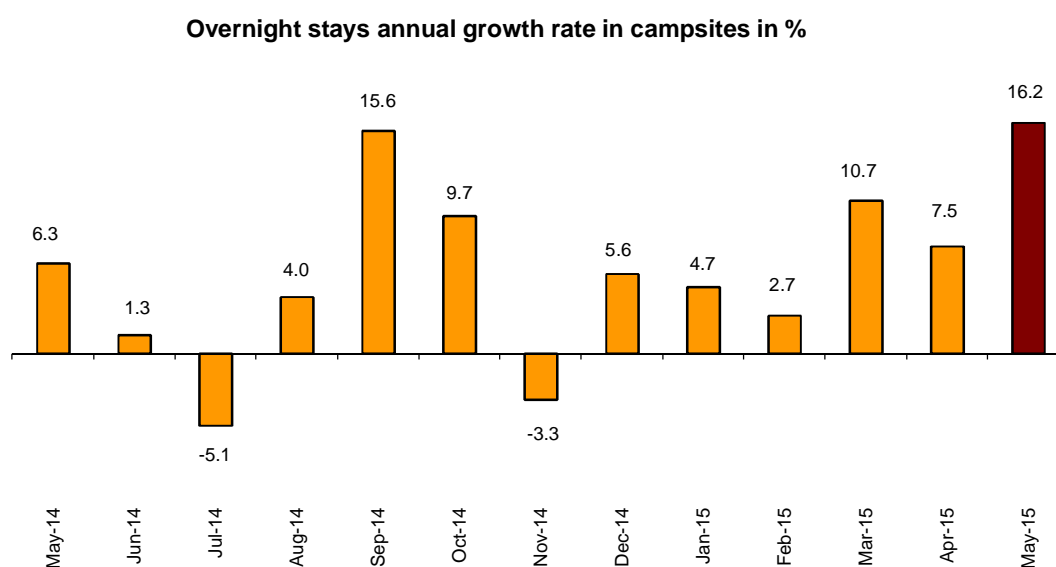
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in May were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Tías and Arona.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 16.2% in May as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 12.0% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 20.6%.

In May, 32.6% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 8.2% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 36.7%, with an 8.9% annual increase.

51.0% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 29.4% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 31.6% more than in May 2014.



Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with 1.2 million overnight stays, 19.8% more than in the same month of the previous year.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 58.3% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Daurada was the preferred destination, with 456,993 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 55.4% of the pitches offered.

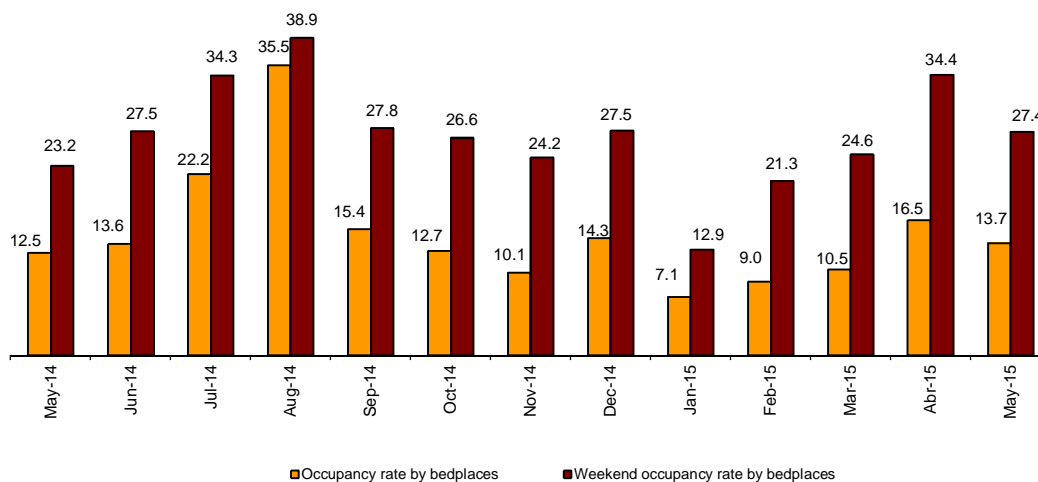
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Benidorm, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Castelló D'Empúries.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 10.6% in May. Residents' overnight stays increased by 8.9% and those of non-residents did so by 14.7%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 13.7% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 9.8% increase as compared to May 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.4%, with an 18.2% increase.

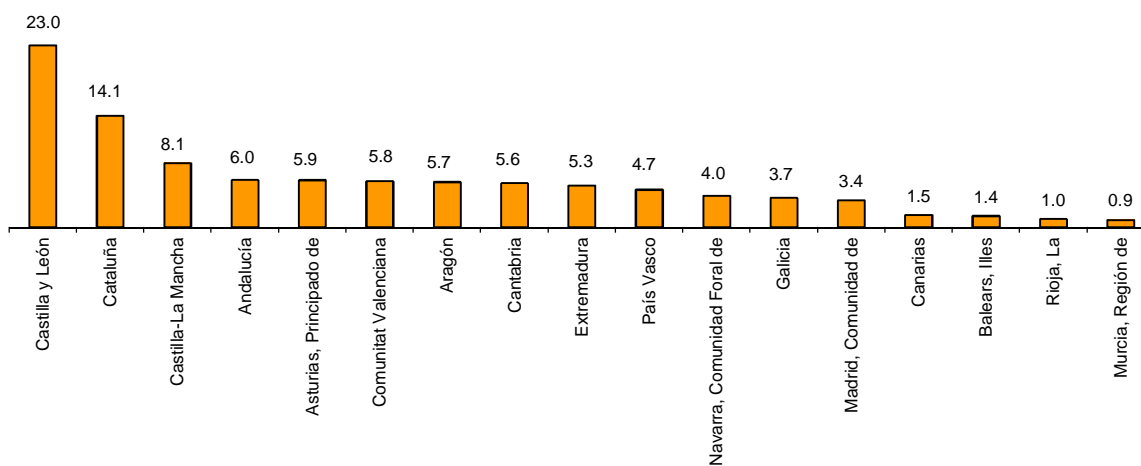
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 111,595 overnight stays, 2.2% more than in May 2014. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 49.3% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Mallorca Island was the main destination, with 77,537 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy rate of 50.3% of the bedplaces offered.

Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 0.8% in May. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 1.0% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 0.3%.

In May, 25.4% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 0.2% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 30.8%, with a 6.7% decrease.

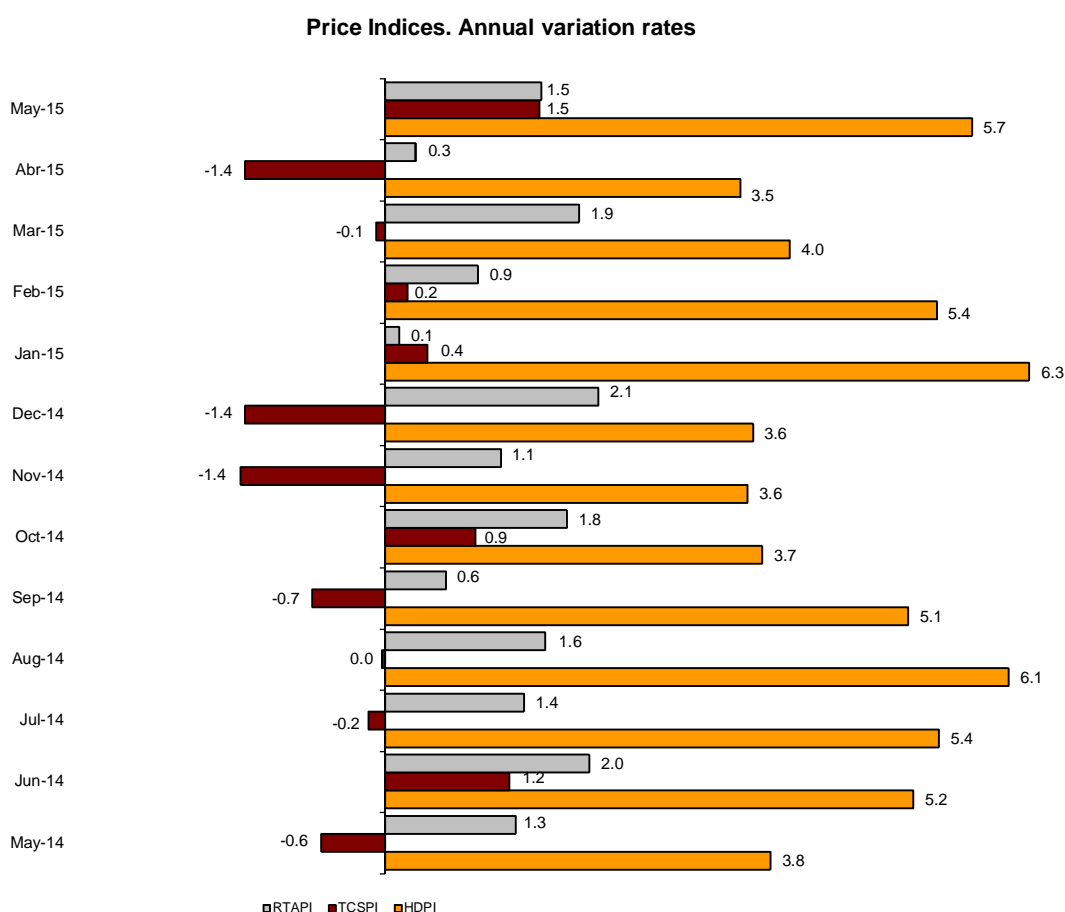
By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 90,258 overnight stays, 1.7% less than in May 2014, and reached the highest occupancy rate, with 42.1% of the bedplaces offered.

Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 5.7%, as compared to May 2014. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (48.9%), increased by 6.2%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.5% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for May (38.7%), increased by 1.5% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 1.5% increase in May. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 64.7% of the total weight, increased by 1.9% in the annual rate.



Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In May, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 5.4% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 4.3%, while those of non-residents did so by 5.9%.

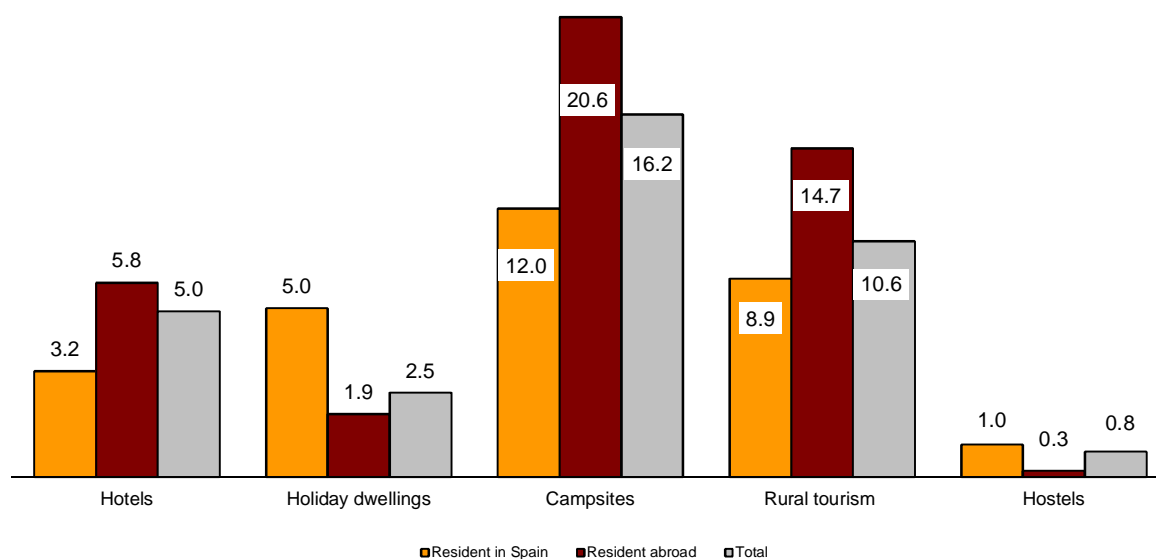
The average stay decreased 1.7%, standing at 3.3 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 78% accounted for hotels, and 22% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 28.5% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.6%) and France (10.4%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 7.1 million overnight stays (3.1% more than in May 2014), followed by Cataluña, with 6.6 million overnight stays (and an annual increase of 7.8%), and Canarias, with over 6.4 million (3.0% more).
