Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
June 2014. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increased
3.2% in June as compared with the same month of 2013**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) exceeded 9.9 millions in June, that is, 3.2% more than in the same month of 2013. Overnight stays of resident travellers increased by 4.9% while those of non-residents did so by 2.3%. The average stay stands at 5.0 overnights per traveller.

During the first half of 2014, overnight stays increased by 6.0% as compared with the same period of the previous year.



Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 3.5% in June. Those of residents decreased by 1.1%, whereas overnight stays of non-residents increased by 5.1%. The average stay increased by 1.4%, standing at 6.3 overnight stays per traveller.


Overnight stays annual growth rate in holiday dwellings in %



In June, 38.2% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 3.2% more than in the same month of 2013. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 41.9%, with an increase of 3.6%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 75.9% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, 1.6% more than in June 2013. The following country of origin was Germany, with 765,352 overnight stays, 14.4% more.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, 5.0% more than in June 2013. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate with 69.5% of the dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Majorca was the preferred destination, with 959,768 overnight stays. This island also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 80.6% of the dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in June were Arona, San Bartolomé de Tirajana and Tías.


Campsites

The overnight stays in tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 1.3% in June. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 9.5% and those of non-resident travellers decreased by 8.5%.

In June, 33.1% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, a 2.1% increase. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 37.0%, with an annual increase of 1.6%.

41.2% of the overnight stays in tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 25.0% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 18.7% less than in June 2013.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding campsites, with over 1.7 million overnight stays, 0.8% less than in June 2013.

La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on campsites, with 58.7% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination for camping, with 765,315 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate, with 52.0% of the pitches offered.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Torroella de Montgrí, Benidorm and Salou.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 10.7% in June. Residents' overnight stays increased by 8.6% while those of non-residents did so by 15.6%.

Regarding the rural tourism accommodation, 13.6% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 8.4% increase as compared to June 2013. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 27.5%, with an increase of 12.0%.


Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 101,675 overnight stays, 16.3% more than in June 2013. This Autonomous Community also reached the highest occupancy rate, with 58.1% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Majorca was the main destination, with 83,156 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the greatest occupancy rates, with 63.4% of the bedplaces offered.

Distribution of overnight stays of traveller residents by autonomous community of destination in %




Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 5.2%, as compared to June 2013. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (52.1%), increased 7.3%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased 1.2% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for June (67.6%), increased by 1.2%.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 2.0% increase in June. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 61.6% of the total weight, increased 2.3%.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodation) registered a 2.3% increase in its annual rate. Overnight stays of residents increased 4.3% and those of non-residents did so by 1.4%.


The average stay decreased 0.8% as compared to the same month of the previous year, standing at 3.8 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 76% accounted for hotels, and 24% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.

Overnight stays annual growth rate in collective tourist accommodation



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 30.6% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (23.4%) and France (6.3%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination regarding overall tourist accommodation, with more than 10.1 million overnight stays (that is, 1.7% less than that registered in June 2013), followed by Cataluña, with over 8.2 million overnight stays (that is, 0.9% more than that registered in the same month of the previous year), and Canarias, with over 6.7 million overnight stays (5.6% more than in the same month of 2013).
