Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
June 2015. *Provisional data*

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 1.7% in June as compared to the same month of 2014

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 10.4 million in June, that is, 1.7% more than in the same month of 2014. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 3.2% and those of non-residents did so by 0.7%.

The average stay stood at 4.8 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first quarter of 2015, overnight stays increased by 2.7% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

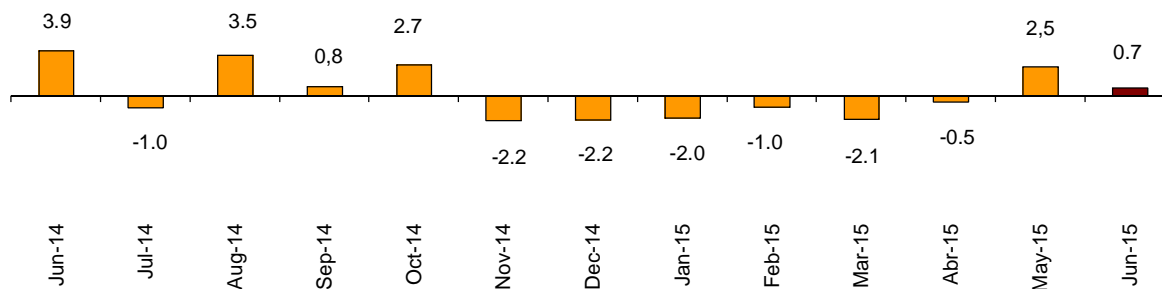
Holiday Dwellings

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 0.7% in June. Those of residents increased by 5.6% and those of non-residents decreased by 1.0%.

The average stay decreased 2.5% as compared with June 2014, and stood at 6.1 overnight stays per traveller.

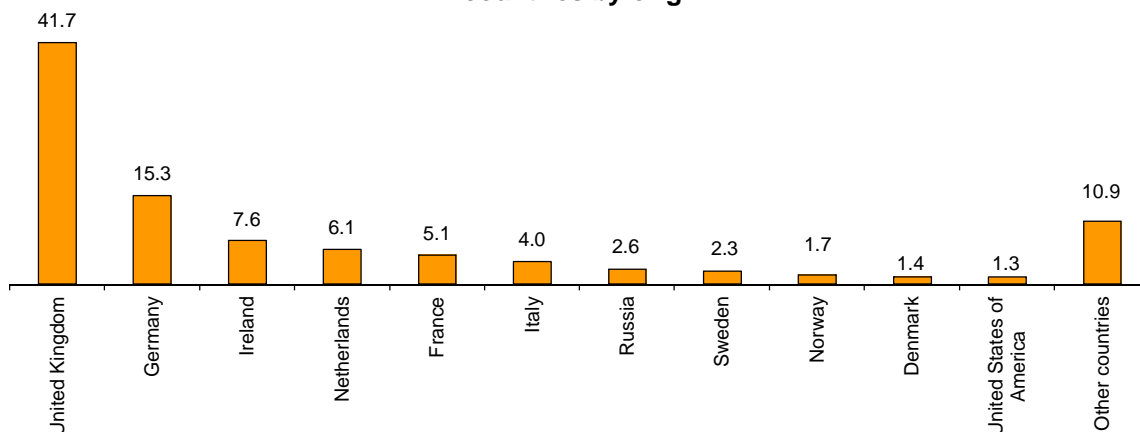
In June, 38.2% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 1.4% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 42.0%, with a decrease of 0.9%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 73.7% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with more than 1.9 million overnight stays, that is, 1.9% less than in June 2014. The following country of origin was Germany, with 715,023 overnight stays, that is, a 4.1% less.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 1.8 million overnight stays, 2.8% less than in June 2014. Comunidad de Madrid registered the highest occupancy rate, with 74.5% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with 870,050 overnight stays. The island of Lanzarote registered the highest occupancy rate, with 76.8% of the holiday dwellings offered.

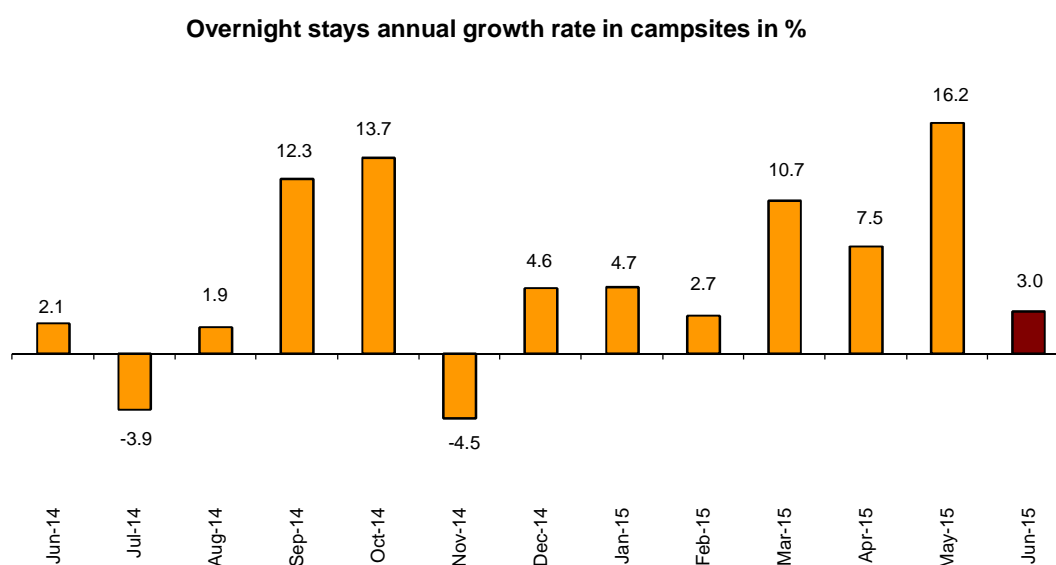
The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in June were Tías, Arona and San Bartolomé de Tirajana.

Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 3.0% in June as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 1.2% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 5.6%.

In June, 34.6% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 3.2% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 38.7%, with a 4.2% annual increase.

42.1% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. The Netherlands was the main country of origin, with 25.5% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 2.4% more than in June 2014.



Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with 1.6 million overnight stays, 5.2% less than in the same month of the previous year.

Comunidad Foral de Navarra was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 61.7% of the pitches offered.

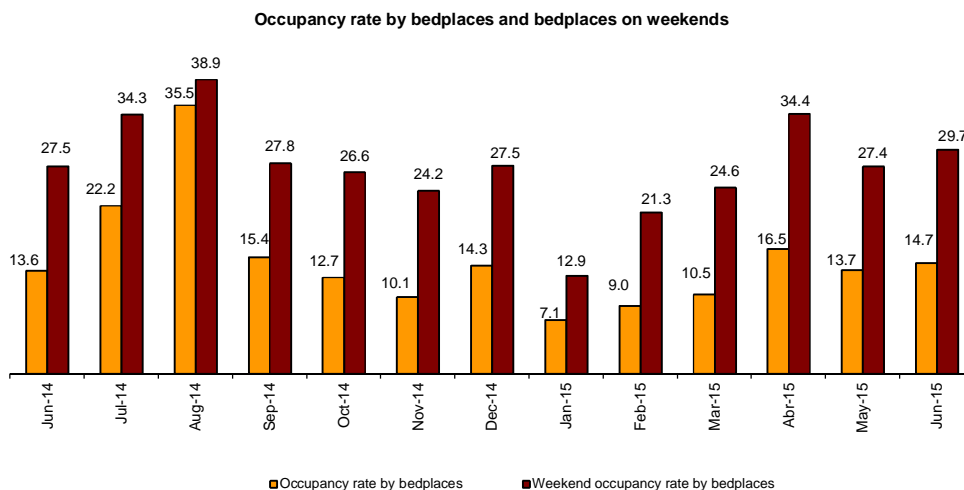
By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 715,759 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 55.2% of the pitches offered.

The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Mont-Roig Del Camp, Benidorm and Torroella de Montgrí.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

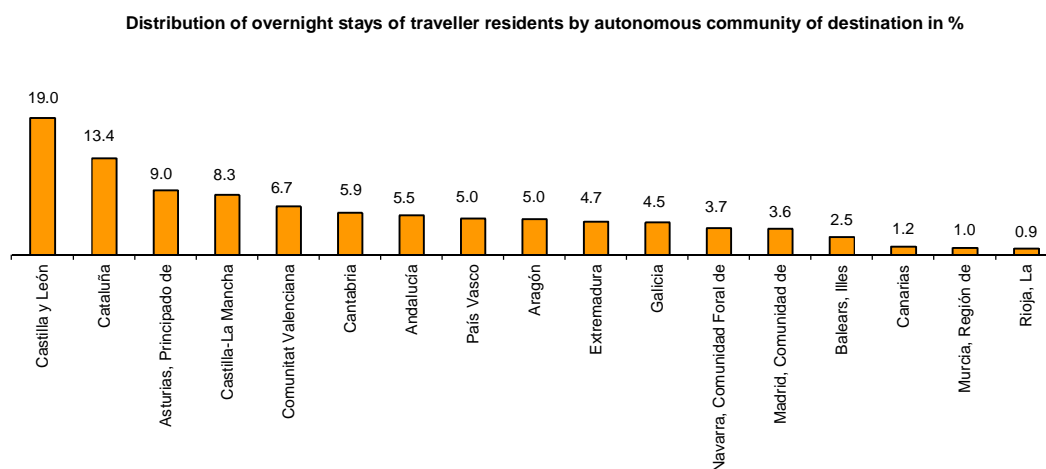
Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 7.8% in June. Residents' overnight stays increased by 7.3% and those of non-residents did so by 9.1%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 14.7% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 7.7% increase as compared to June 2014. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 29.7%, with an 8.0% increase.



By Autonomous Community, Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 113,955 overnight stays, 14.9% more than in June 2014 and reached the highest occupancy rate, with 59.0% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, Mallorca Island was the main destination, with 93,969 overnight stays. The islands of Ibiza and Formentera reached the highest occupancy rate of 61.1% of the bedplaces offered.



Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual decrease of 4.9% in June. Overnight stays by resident travellers decreased by 7.8% and those of non-resident travellers increased by 2.9%.

In June, 28.1% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 4.4% less than in the same month of 2014. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 37.8%, with a 6.1% decrease.

By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 96,229 overnight stays and reached the highest occupancy rate, with 45.1% of the bedplaces offered, 0.6% less than in June 2014.

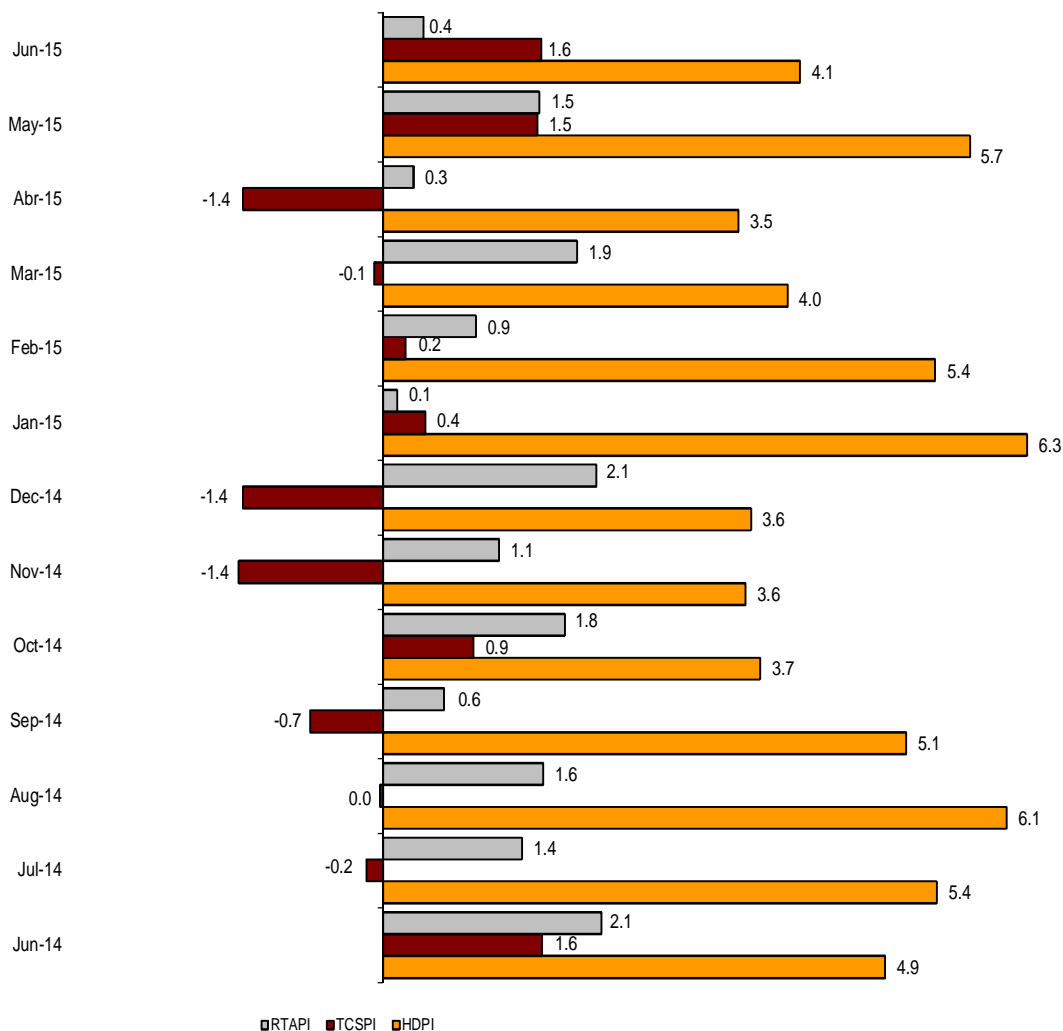
Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 4.1%, as compared to June 2014. The *tour operators and travel agencies* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (50.2%), increased by 5.6%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 1.6% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for June (40.4%), increased by 2.3% as compared with the same month of 2014.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 0.4% increase in June. The *weekend* rate, which accounted for 58.0% of the total weight, increased by 0.2% in the annual rate.

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

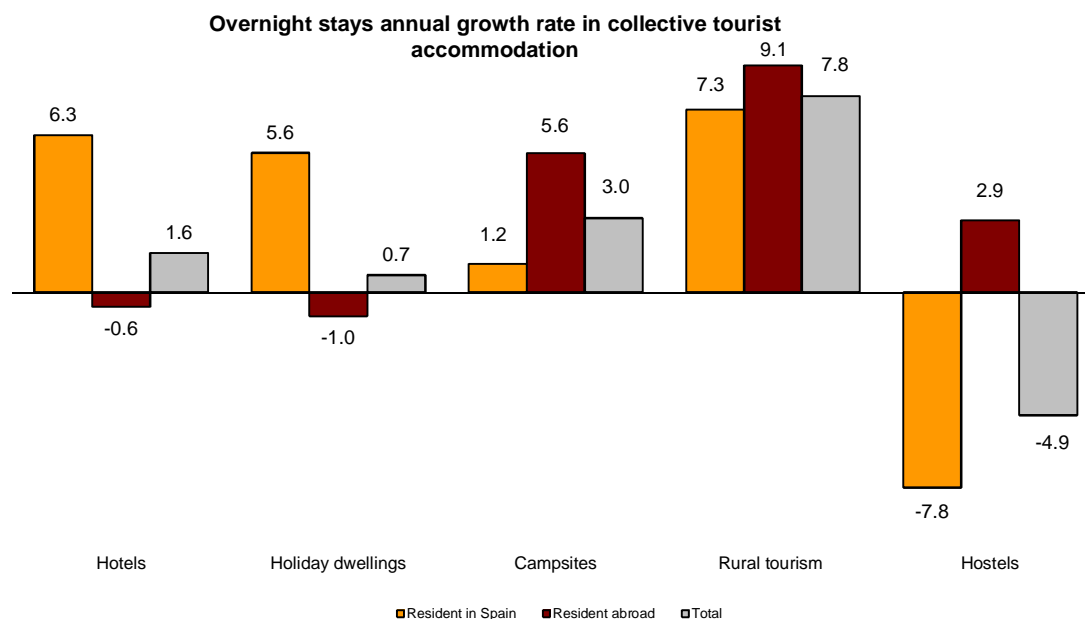
In June, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 1.6% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 5.4%, while those of non-residents decreased by 0.3%.

The average stay decreased 2.7%, standing at 3.7 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 75% accounted for hotels, and 25% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 31.1% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (22.9%) and France (7.1%).

Illes Balears was the preferred destination, with 10.2 million overnight stays (the same figure than in June 2014), followed by Cataluña, with more than eight million overnight stays (and an annual decrease of 5.2%), and Canarias, with 6.6 million (0.1% less).
