Encuestas de ocupación en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
*Junio 2016. Datos provisionales***Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros
aumentan un 11,4% en junio respecto al mismo mes de 2015**

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros (apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) superan los 11,6 millones en junio, un 11,4% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. Las pernoctaciones de residentes aumentan un 8,3% y las de no residentes un 13,5%.

La estancia media es de 4,7 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Durante el primer semestre de 2016 las pernoctaciones aumentan un 10,7% respecto al mismo periodo del año anterior.

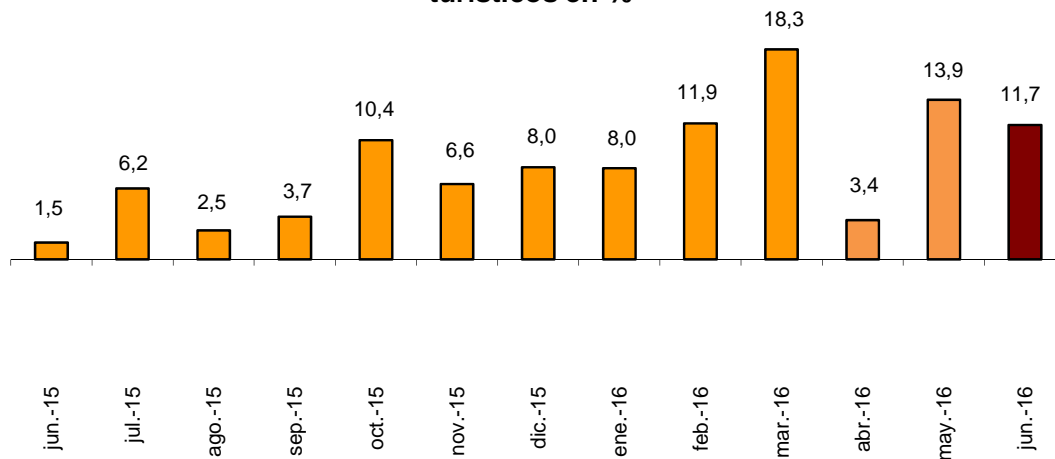
Apartamentos turísticos

Las pernoctaciones en apartamentos turísticos aumentan un 11,7% en junio. Las de residentes suben un 8,0% y las de no residentes un 13,0%.

La estancia media baja un 1,1% respecto a junio de 2015, situándose en 6,0 pernoctaciones por viajero.

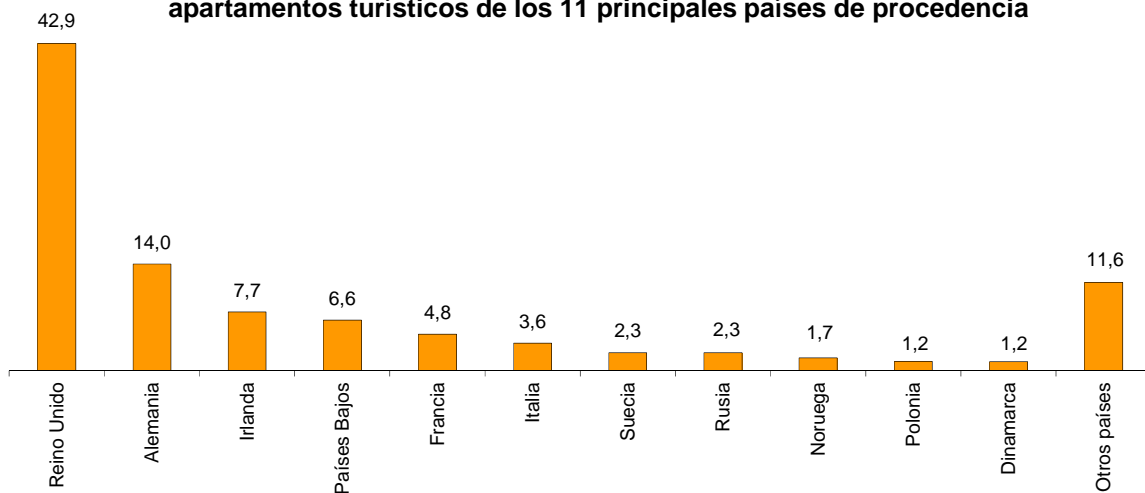
En junio se ocupan el 42,5% de las plazas ofertadas por los apartamentos turísticos, un 11,6% más que en el mismo mes de 2015. El grado de ocupación por plazas en fin de semana se sitúa en el 45,9%, con un incremento del 9,3%.

Las pernoctaciones de no residentes en apartamentos turísticos representan el 74,5% del total, Reino Unido es el principal mercado emisor, con 2,2 millones de pernoctaciones, un 16,3% más que en junio de 2015. El siguiente mercado emisor es Alemania, con 744.808 pernoctaciones, un 3,4% más.

Canarias es el destino preferido en apartamentos, con más de 2,2 millones de pernoctaciones, un 20,7% más que en junio de 2015. Illes Balears alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 81,7% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Por zonas turísticas, la isla de Mallorca es el destino preferido, con 910.984 pernoctaciones y una ocupación del 86,4% de los apartamentos ofertados.

Los puntos turísticos con mayor número de pernoctaciones en junio son San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona y Tías.

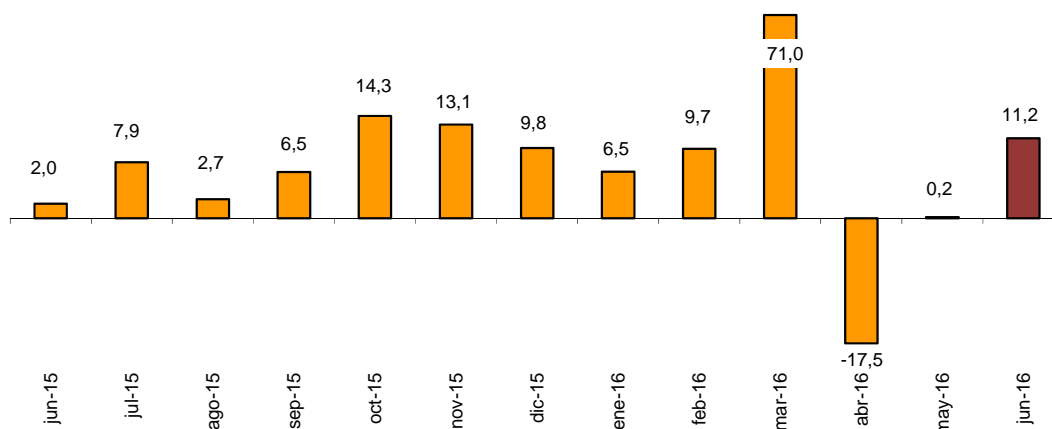
Campings

Las pernoctaciones en campings registran en junio un incremento anual del 11,2% respecto al mismo mes del año anterior. Las de residentes aumentan un 7,7% y las de no residentes un 16,0%.

Durante el mes de junio se ocupan el 36,0% de las parcelas ofertadas, un 4,7% más. El grado de ocupación por parcelas en fin de semana alcanza el 39,8%, con un aumento anual del 3,4%.

El 44,6% de las pernoctaciones en campings las realizan viajeros no residentes. Países Bajos es el principal mercado emisor, con el 24,7% de las pernoctaciones de no residentes, un 14,9% más que en junio de 2015.

Cataluña es el destino preferido en campings, con 1,8 millones de pernoctaciones, un 10,9% más que en junio de 2015. La Rioja alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 62,9% de las parcelas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Costa Brava es el destino preferido, con 819.728 pernoctaciones. Costa Blanca alcanza la mayor ocupación, del 61,5% de las parcelas ofertadas.

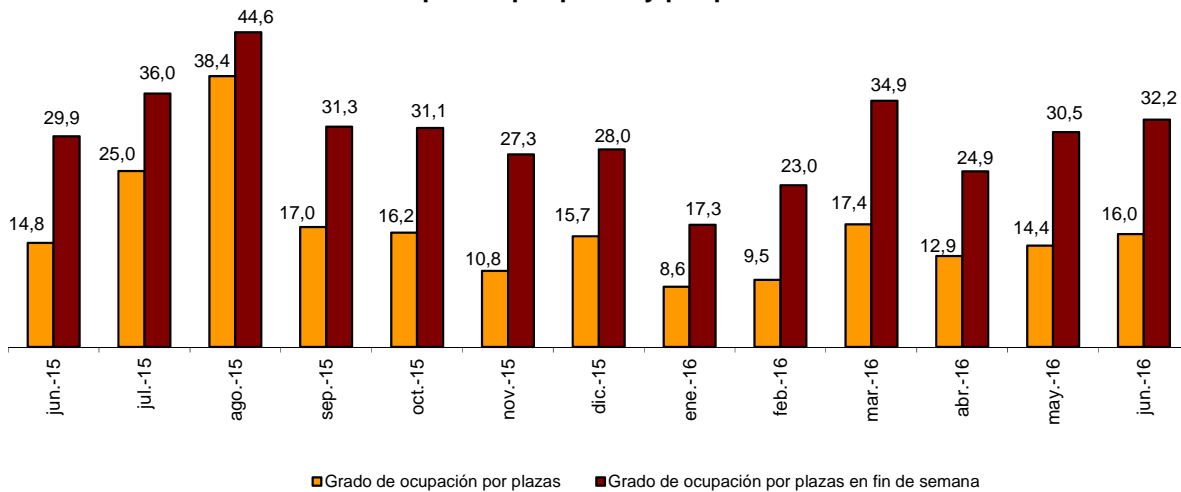
Los puntos turísticos con más pernoctaciones son Benidorm, Torroella De Montgrí y Mont-Roig Del Camp.

Alojamientos de turismo rural

Las pernoctaciones en alojamientos de turismo rural presentan un aumento anual del 10,6% en junio. Las de residentes suben un 9,6% y las de no residentes un 12,8%.

En los alojamientos de turismo rural se ocupan el 16,0% de las plazas, con un crecimiento del 8,4% respecto a junio de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana se sitúa en el 32,2%, con un incremento del 7,8%.

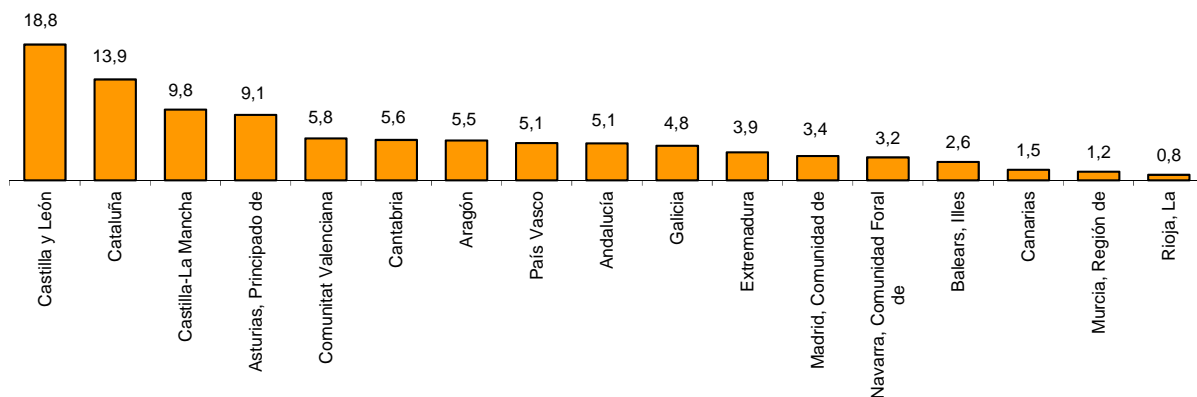
Grado de ocupación por plazas y por plazas en fin de semana



Por comunidades, Illes Balears es el destino preferido, con 125.856 pernoctaciones, un 13,2% más que en junio de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza el mayor grado de ocupación, con el 63,4% de las plazas ofertadas.

Por zonas turísticas, la Isla de Mallorca es el principal destino, con 103.159 pernoctaciones. Las islas de Ibiza y Formentera alcanzan la mayor ocupación, del 65,1% de las plazas ofertadas.

Albergues

Las pernoctaciones en albergues registran en junio un aumento anual del 8,4%. Las de residentes suben un 13,4%, mientras que las de no residentes bajan un 3,7%.

Se ocupan el 31,8% de las plazas, un 13,6% más que en junio de 2015. El grado de ocupación en fin de semana alcanza el 37,7%, con un aumento del 0,4%.

Por comunidades, Cataluña es el destino preferido, con 95.766 pernoctaciones, un 0,4% menos que en junio de 2015. Esta comunidad también alcanza la mayor ocupación, con el 47,1% de las plazas ofertadas.

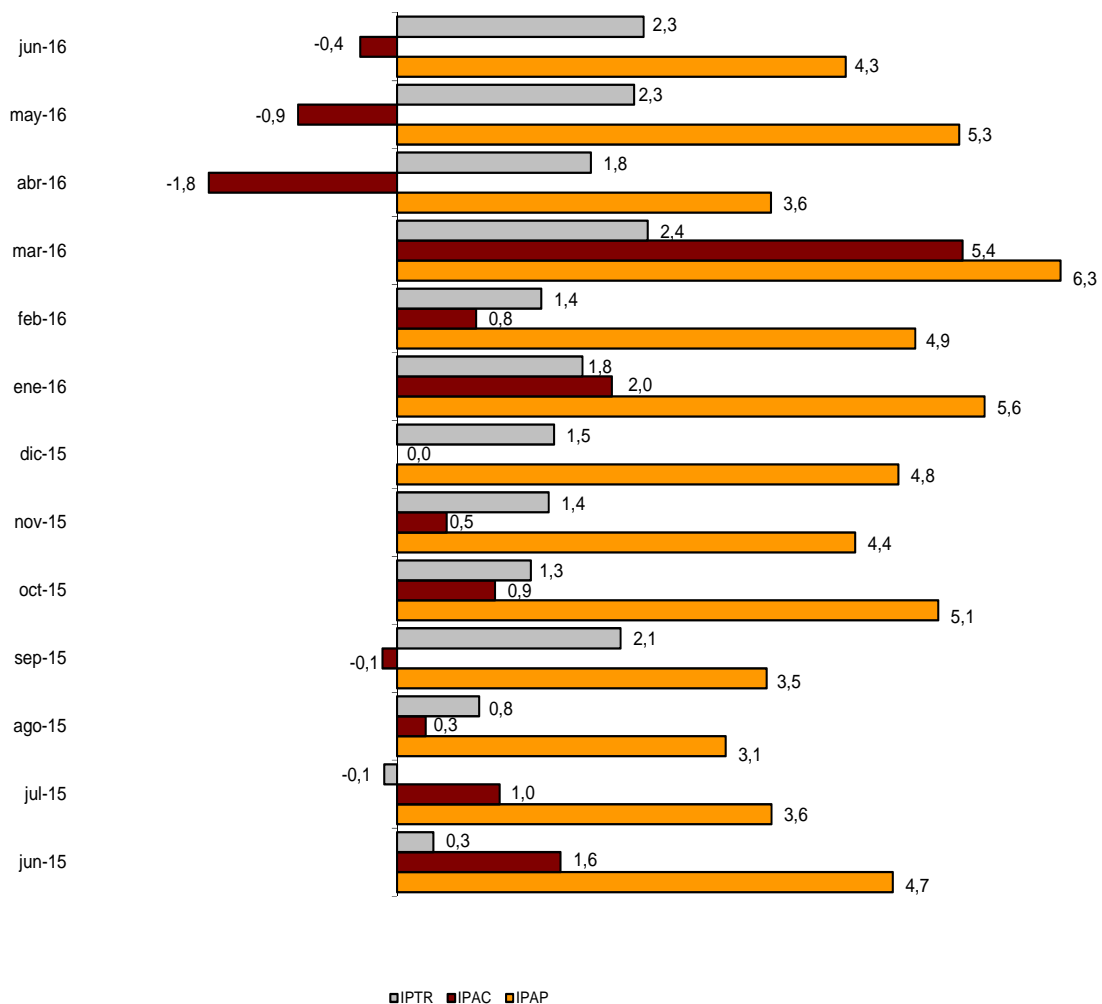
Índices de precios

El Índice de Precios de Apartamentos Turísticos (IPAP) aumenta un 4,3% respecto a junio de 2015. La tarifa *tour-operadores y agencias de viajes*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones este mes (48,8%), sube un 3,6%.

El Índice de Precios de Campings (IPAC) desciende un 0,4% en tasa anual. La tarifa *bungalow*, que tiene el mayor peso en la estructura de ponderaciones en junio (38,9%), baja un 1,1% respecto al mismo mes de 2015.

El Índice de Precios de Alojamientos de Turismo Rural (IPTR) registra un aumento del 2,3% en junio. La tarifa *fin de semana*, que supone el 55,5% del peso total, sube un 2,4% en tasa anual.

Evolución de los viajeros y las pernoctaciones en todos los alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles

Las pernoctaciones en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos colectivos españoles (hoteles¹, apartamentos, campings, alojamientos de turismo rural y albergues) aumentan un 9,5% en junio en tasa anual. Las de residentes suben un 3,3% y las de no residentes un 12,8%.

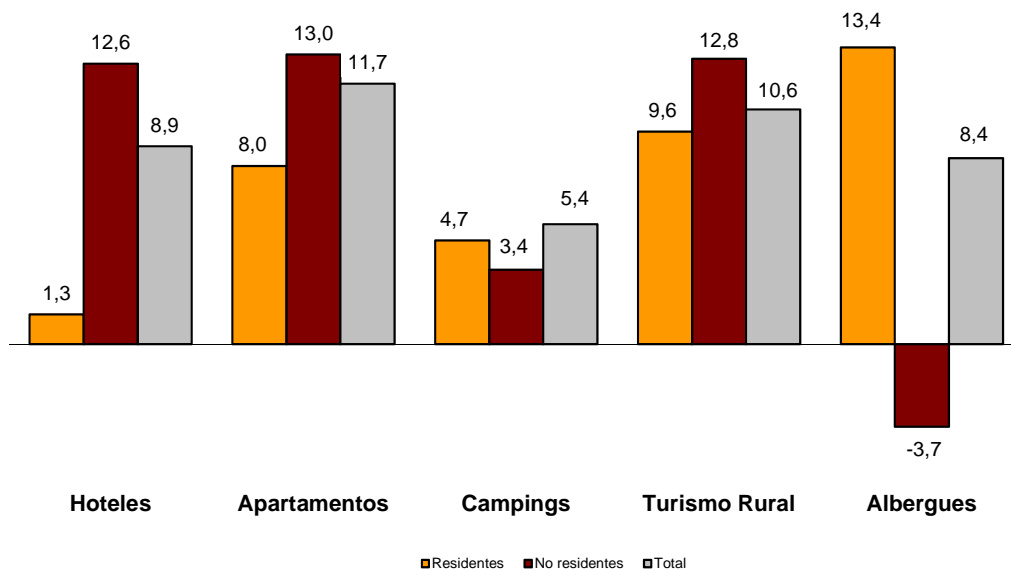
La estancia media sube un 2,0%, situándose en 3,7 pernoctaciones por viajero.

Del total de pernoctaciones realizadas en alojamientos turísticos colectivos, un 75% corresponde a hoteles y un 25% a alojamientos turísticos extrahoteleros.

Los principales mercados emisores en el conjunto de alojamientos turísticos reglados son el británico (con el 32,2% del total de pernoctaciones de no residentes), el alemán (21,6%) y el francés (7,0%).

Illes Balears es el destino preferido, con más de 11 millones de pernoctaciones (un 8,7% más que en junio de 2015). Le siguen Cataluña, con más de 8,7 millones (y un aumento anual del 9,5%) y Canarias, con 7,8 millones (y un incremento del 16,7%).
