Non-Hotel Tourist Accommodation Occupancy Survey
 July 2016. *Provisional data*

**Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation increase 7.7%
in July as compared to the same month of 2015**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) exceeded 19.8 million in July, that is, 7.7% more than in the same month of 2015. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 11.0% and those of non-residents did so by 5.1%.

The average stay stood at 5.3 overnight stays per traveller.

During the first seven months of 2016, overnight stays increased by 9.8% as compared with the same period of the previous year.

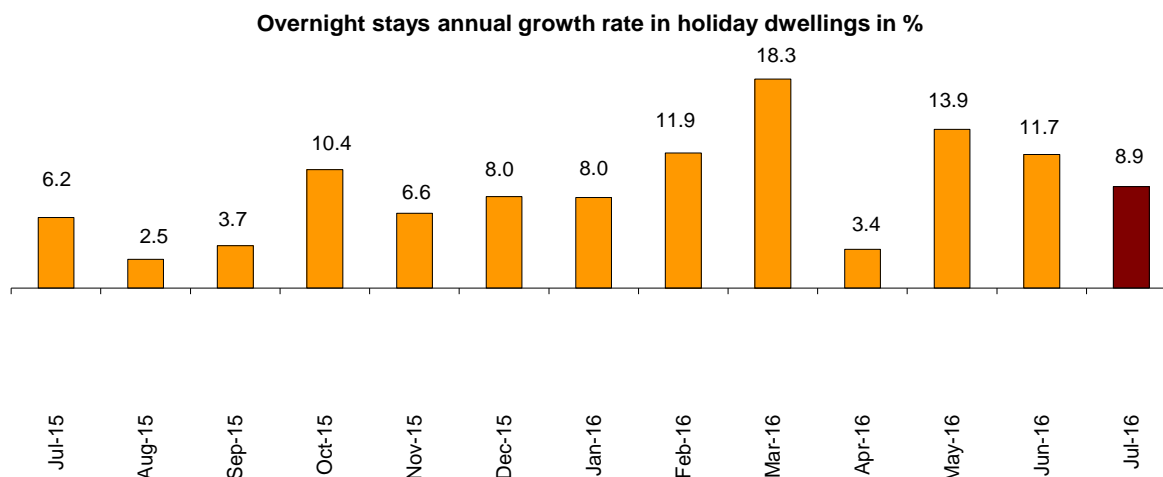

Holiday Dwellings

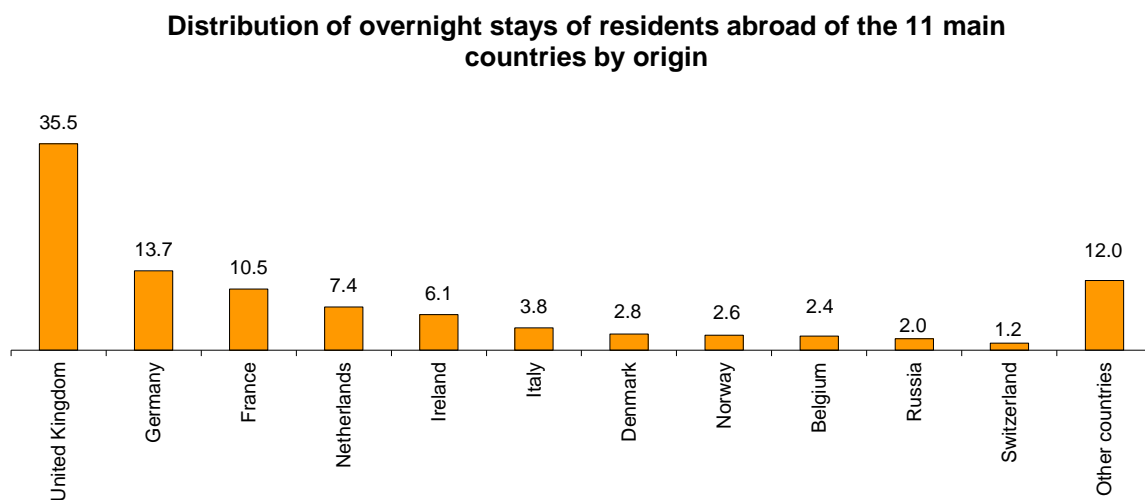
Overnight stays in holiday dwellings increased 8.9% in July. Those of residents increased by 11.5% and those of non-residents did so by 7.7%.

The average stay decreased 6.1% as compared with July 2015, and stood at 6.5 overnight stays per traveller.

In July, 56.6% of the bedplaces available for holiday dwellings were occupied, 7.4% more than in the same month of 2015. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces stood at 58.0%, with an increase of 7.3%.



Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 68.2% of the total. The United Kingdom was the main country of origin, with 2.5 million overnight stays, that is, 8.3% more than in July 2015. The following country of origin was Germany, with 981,817 overnight stays, that is, a 4.2% more.



Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 3.0 million overnight stays, 18.0% more than in July 2015. Illes Balears registered the highest occupancy rate, with 88.0% of the holiday dwellings offered.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca was the preferred destination, with more than 1.1 million overnight stays and with an occupancy rate of 90.6% of the holiday dwellings offered.

The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays in July were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Arona and Tías.

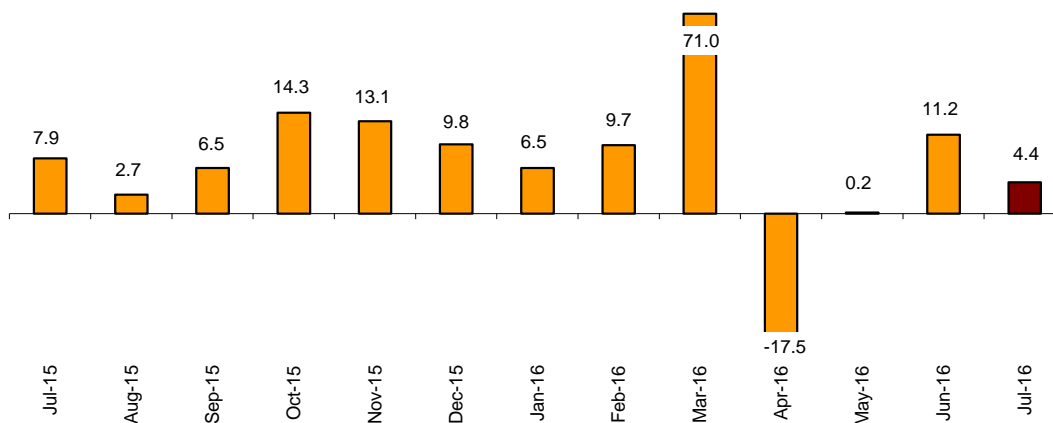
Tourist campsites

Overnight stays at tourist campsites registered an annual increase of 4.4% in July as compared to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 9.1% and those of non-resident travellers decreased by 0.9%.

In July, 46.1% of the offered pitches were occupied, that is, 3.5% more. The weekend occupancy rate by pitch reached 50.1%, with a 4.1% annual increase.

44.1% of the overnight stays at tourist campsites were by non-residents. France was the main country of origin, with 30.7% of the overnight stays by non-residents, 14.5% more than in July 2015.

Cataluña was the preferred destination regarding tourist campsites, with 3.7 million overnight stays, 0.4% less than in the same month of the previous year. La Rioja was the Autonomous Community with the highest occupancy rate on tourist campsites, with 70.5% of the pitches offered.

By tourist areas, Costa Brava was the preferred destination, with 1,9 overnight stays. Costa Blanca reached the highest occupancy rate with 66.0% of the pitches offered.

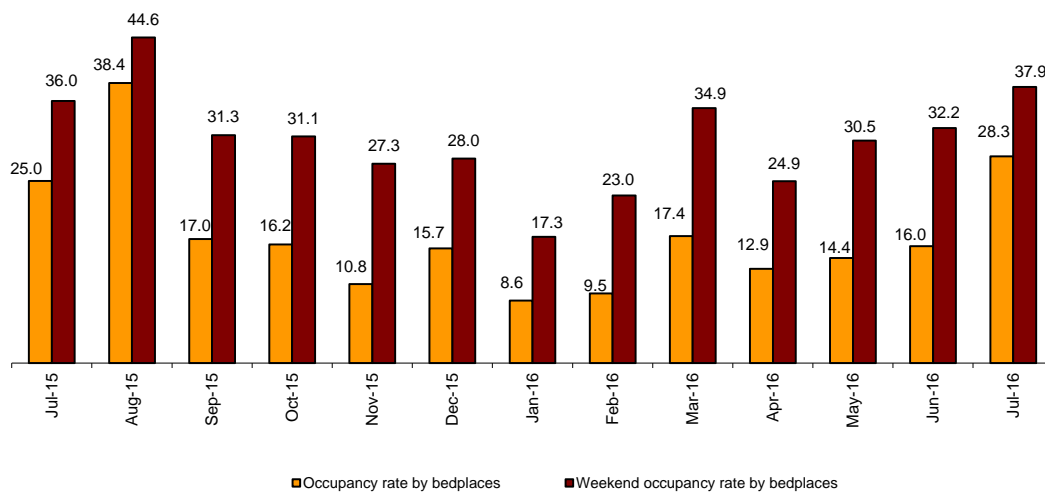
The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Torroella De Montgrí, Mont-Roig Del Camp and Sant Pere Pescador.

Rural Tourism Accommodation

Overnight stays in rural tourism accommodation presented an annual increase of 15.4% in July. Residents' overnight stays increased by 16.4% and those of non-residents increased by 13.2%.

Regarding rural tourism accommodation, 28.3% of the bedplaces were occupied, that is, a 13.4% increase as compared to July 2015. The weekend occupancy rate stood at 37.9%, with an 5.3% increase.

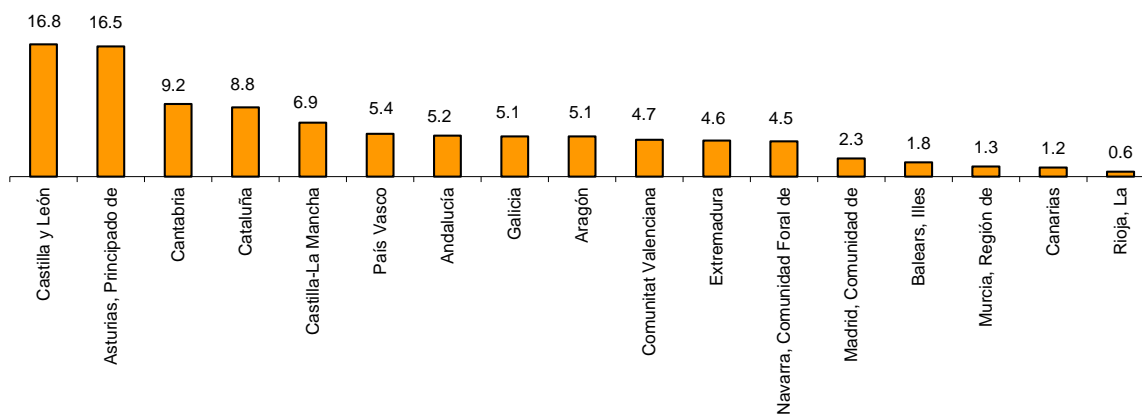
Occupancy rate by bedplaces and bedplaces on weekends



By Autonomous Community, Castilla y León was the preferred destination, with 178,495 overnight stays, 19.4% more than in July 2015. Illes Balears reached the highest occupancy rate, with 69.9% of the bedplaces offered.

By tourist area, the island of Mallorca was the main destination, with 118,512 overnight stays. The island of Menorca reached the highest occupancy rate with 75.6% of the bedplaces offered.

Youth Hostels

Overnight stays in hostels registered an annual increase of 12.7% in July. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased by 15.2% and those of non-resident travellers did so by 5.9%.

In July, 52.0% of the offered bedplaces were occupied, that is, 12.6% more than in the same month of 2015. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces reached 51.9%, with a 1.1% increase.

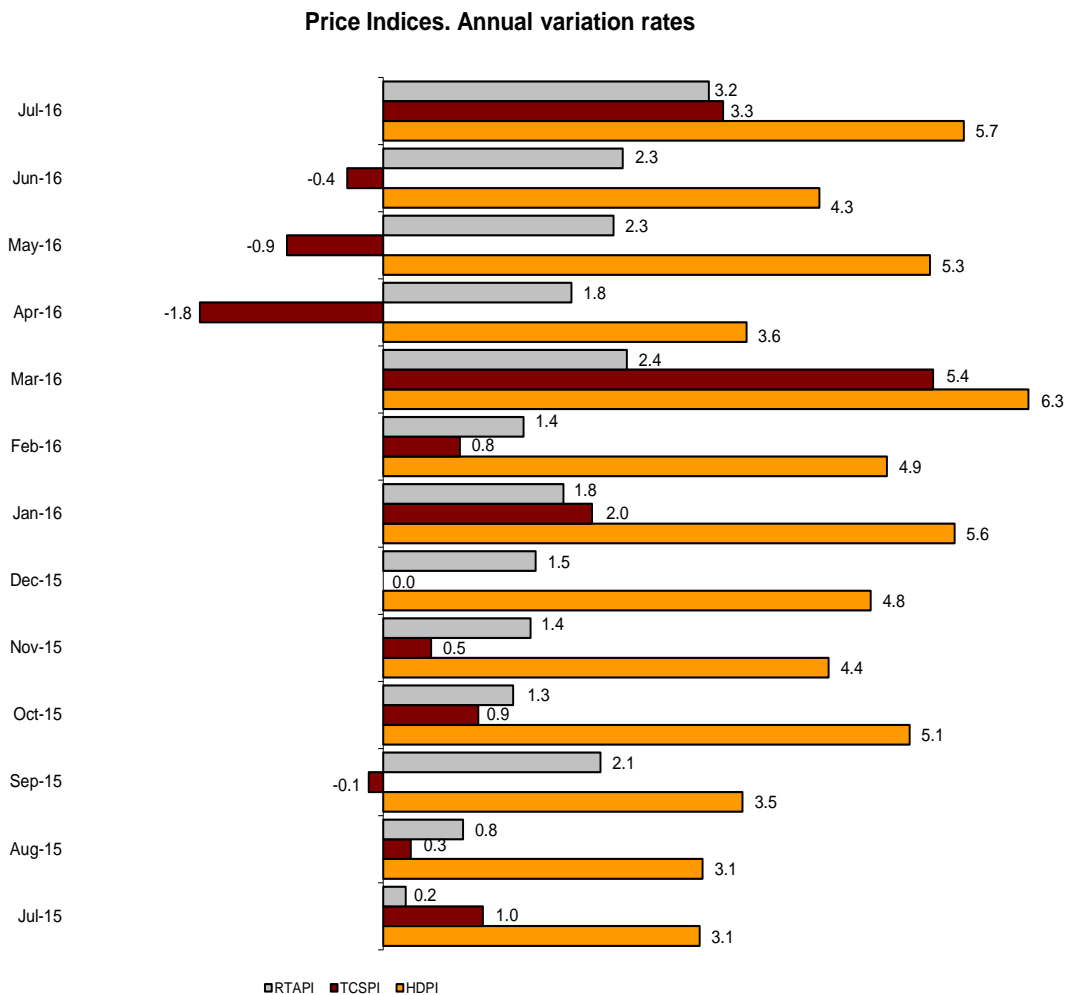
By Autonomous Community, Cataluña was the preferred destination, with 145,324 overnight stays, 5.9% more than in July 2015. País Vasco reached the highest occupancy rate, with 72.5% of the bedplaces offered.

Price Indices

The Holiday Dwelling Price Index (HDPI) increased 5.7%, as compared to July 2015. The *normal* rate, which carried the greatest weight in the weighting structure for this month (47.8%), increased by 5.1%.

The Tourist Campsite Price Index (TCPI) increased by 3.3% in the annual rate. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weighting structure for July (47.1%), increased by 4.6% as compared with the same month of 2015.

The Rural Tourism Accommodation Price Index (RTAPI) registered a 3.2% increase in July. The *normal* rate, which accounted for 55.8% of the total weight, increased by 3.3% in the annual rate.



Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

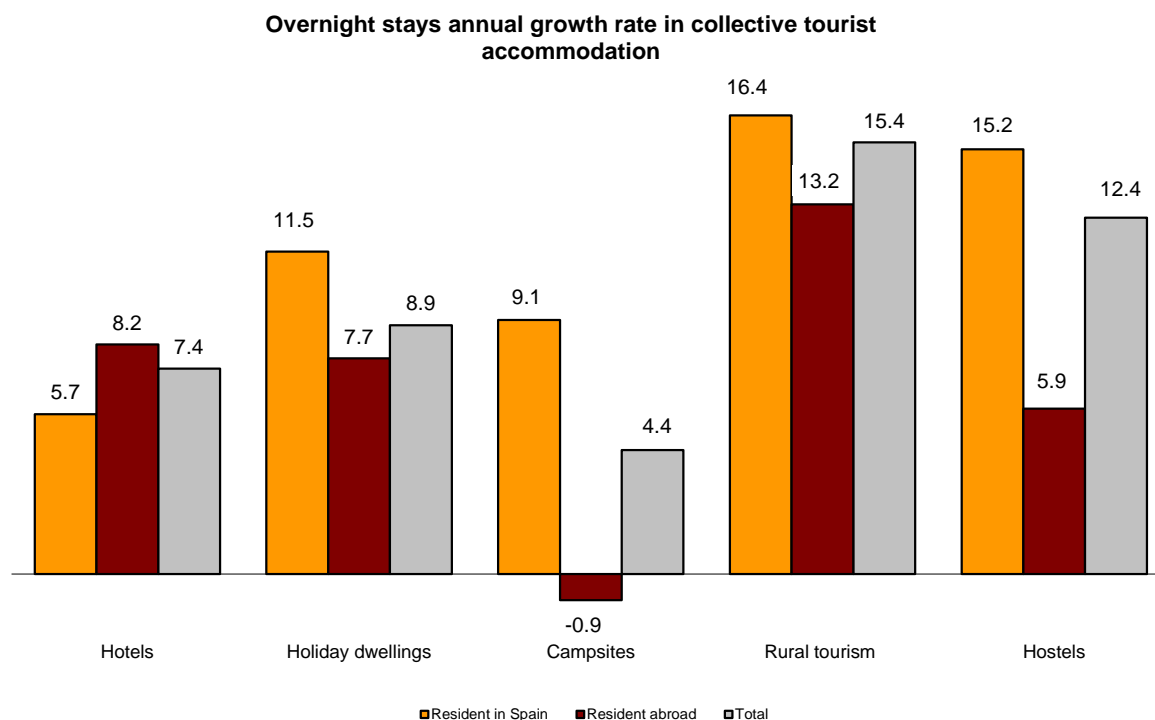
In July, overnight stays in Spanish collective tourist accommodation (hotels¹, holiday dwellings, tourist campsites, rural tourism accommodation and youth hostels) registered a 7.5% increase in the annual rate. Overnight stays by residents increased by 7.7% and those of non-residents did so by 7.3%.

The average stay decreased 2.6%, standing at 4.1 overnight stays per traveller.

Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation, 68% accounted for hotels, and 32% did so for non-hotel tourist accommodation.



The main countries of origin in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 27.2% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (18.4%) and France (10.5%).

Cataluña was the preferred destination, with over 13,5 million overnight stays (4.6% more than in July 2015), followed by Illes Balears, with over 12.7 million overnight stays (and an annual increase of 2.6%), and Canarias, with 9.7 million (12.9% more).
