**Non-hotel tourist accommodation occupancy survey
November 2007. Provisional data****Overnight stays in collective non-hotel accommodation decrease
0.2% in November, as compared to the same month in 2006**

Overnight stays in non-hotel tourist accommodation (holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism establishments) exceeded 5.2 million in November, 0.2% less than in the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased 15.3%, while non-resident overnight stays decreased 4.4%.

The average stay decreased 4%, and stood at 6.3 nights per traveller.

During the first 11 months of the year, there were almost 105 million overnight stays, a decrease of 1.0% over the same period of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased 1.4% while non-resident overnight stays decreased 2.3%.

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings decrease 5.1% in November

Overnight stays in holiday dwellings exceeded 3.9 million in November, representing a 5.1% decrease as compared to the same month of the previous year. Resident overnight stays increased by 4.9% and non-resident overnight stays decreased by 6.6%.


During the first 11 months of the year, overnight stays in holiday dwellings decreased 1.9%. Resident overnight stays increased 2.8% and non-resident overnight stays decreased by 3.3%.

Available holiday dwellings decreased 4.7%, standing at 339,340 bedplaces. In November, 39% of the total available bedplaces were occupied, 0.2% fewer than in the same month of the previous year. For its part, 61.4% out of the total number of available holiday dwellings were occupied, an increase of 1.4%.

Non-resident overnight stays in holiday dwellings represented 85.8% of the total. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin**, with over one million overnight stays, 15.2% fewer than in November of the previous year.

The next country of origin was Germany, with approximately 700,000 overnight stays and an interannual rate of -12.4%.

Canarias was the preferred holiday dwelling destination, with more than 3.1 million overnight stays, 7.4% fewer than in November 2006. Comunitat Valenciana was the second destination of choice, with over 284,270 overnight stays, a decrease of 4.6%.

Among non-residents, Canarias, Comunitat Valenciana and Andalucía were the preferred destinations. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Canarias, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Comunidad de Madrid presented the **highest occupancy rate**, with 76.7% of available holiday dwellings occupied. It was followed by Canarias (76.2%) and Illes Balears (61.6%).

By **tourist areas**, Gran Canaria was the preferred destination in this accommodation modality, with over 1.2 million overnight stays in November and an occupancy of 87.2%.


The tourist sites with the greatest number of overnight stays were San Bartolomé de Tirajana, Mogán and Tías.

Prices for holiday dwellings increased 1.2% in November


The Holiday Dwellings Price Index registered a 1.2% increase in November, a rate 0.3 points higher than that for the previous month.

The tour-operator and travel agency rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (69%), registered a 0.7% interannual rate increase.

By modalities, 2/4 bedplace holiday dwellings, whose weight was 74.1%, increased their prices by 0.4%, as compared to November 2006.



Overnight stays in tourist campsites increased 13.6%



Overnight stays in tourist campsites exceeded 804,000 in November, representing a 13.6% interannual rate increase. Overnight stays by resident travellers increased 19.2%, and by non-resident travellers 10.8%.

Tourist campsites offered over 293,500 bedplaces, 1.9% more than in the same month of 2006. 35.9% of the available lots were occupied, for a 2.9% increase in the interannual rate. The weekend occupancy level by lots reached 37.5%, that is, 2.1% higher than in November 2006.

65% of overnight stays in holiday campsites were by non-residents. **The United Kingdom was the main country of origin** with 40% of overnight stays by non-residents (19.2% higher). The following country of origin was Germany.


Comunitat Valenciana was the **preferred destination for camping**, with over 318,180 overnight stays, 3.4% higher than in November 2006. Andalucía was the second destination of choice, with over 149,800 thousand overnight stays, for an increase of 32.1%.

Among non-residents, Comunidad Valenciana, Andalucía and Región de Murcia were the preferred destinations. On the other hand, Cataluña, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana were the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers.

In November, **the highest campsite occupancy level** was registered in **La Rioja** (with 59.9% of the available lots). It was followed by Región de Murcia (52.6%) and Comunitat Valenciana (51.5%).

On a **tourist area basis**, Costa Blanca was the preferred destination for camping, with almost 201,100 overnight stays, while Costa del Garraf registered the highest occupancy level in November (66%). The **tourist destinations** with the most overnight stays were Benidorm, Cartagena and Mazarrón.

Prices of tourist campsites increased 6.2%



The Tourist Campsite Price Index interannual growth rate increased 6.2% in November. The *normal* rate, which had the greatest weight in the weight structure for this month (50.5%), increased 5.3%.


Regarding categories, second class, with a 57.6% weight in November, recorded an interannual increase of 5.3%.

Overnight stays by residents in rural tourist accommodation increased 28.8% in November, as compared to the same month of the previous year


There were almost 486,000 overnight stays in rural tourist accommodation in November, a 27.8% increase with regard to the same month of the previous year. Overnight stays by residents increased 28.8%, while non-resident stays increased 20.8%.

Rural tourist accommodation offered more than 104,670 bedplaces in November, 6.6% more than in the same month of 2006. Of these bedplaces, 15.4% were occupied, representing a 19.7% increase. The weekend occupancy level stood at 34.1%, 17.7% more than in November of the previous year.

Castilla y León was the preferred destination in rural tourism accommodation, with over 111,750 overnight stays, 31.2% more than in November 2006. Cataluña was the second destination of choice, with approximately 54,800 overnight stays (17.4% higher).

Among non-residents, Canarias was the preferred destination. For their part, the destinations with the most overnight stays by resident travellers were Castilla y León, Cataluña and Andalucía.

Canarias reached the highest level of occupancy of rural tourist accommodations in November (with 30.9% of the available bedplaces). It was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (21.8%) and Navarra (21.5%).

On a tourist area basis, Pirineo Catalán was the preferred destination, with almost 27,316 overnight stays, while Parque Nacional de Taburiente registered the highest occupancy level in November (37.5%).

Evolution of travellers and overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodation

Overnight stays in all Spanish collective tourist accommodations (hotels, holiday dwellings, campsites and rural tourism accommodations) **registered a 5.5% interannual increase in November**. Resident overnight stays grew by 9.6%, and non-resident stays by 2.7%.


The average stay decreased 2%, standing at 3.2 overnight stays per traveller.



Of the total overnight stays in collective tourist accommodation in November, 74% were accounted for at hotels, and 26% were at non-hotel tourist accommodation.

The **main countries of origin** in overall regulated tourist accommodation were the United Kingdom (with 27.9% of the total number of non-resident overnight stays), Germany (with 26.0%), and France (with 4.0%).

Canarias was the **preferred destination** regarding overall Spanish tourist accommodations, with more than 7.2 million overnight stays, 0.9% more than in November 2006. It was followed by Andalucía, with more than 2.9 million overnight stays (8.5% higher) and Comunitat Valenciana with more than 2.3 million overnight stays (2.8% higher).

The preferred destinations of non-residents were Canarias, Andalucía and Comunitat Valenciana. On the other hand, Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña were the destinations with the most overnight stays by residents.
