Hotel Tourism Short-Term Trends (HOS/HPI/IPHS)

August 2016. Provisional data

Overnight stays in hotel establishments register an increase of 3.8% in August, as compared to the same month of 2015


Hotels invoice an average of 100.2 euros per occupied room, which means an annual increase of 5.2%

In August, a total of 46.4 million overnight stays were registered in hotel establishments, 3.8% more than in the same month of 2015. Overnight stays by residents in Spain decreased by 0.3% and those of non-residents increased so by 6.3%.

The average stay remains unchanged compared to August 2015, standing at 3.8 nights per quest.


In the aggregated period of July and August, overnight stays increased 5.4% as compared with the same period of 2015. Those of residents increased 2.4% and that of non-residents 7.2%.

During the first eight months of 2016, overnight stays increased 7.8%, as compared to the same period of the previous year.




Main destinations

In August, Andalucía, Cataluña, Comunitat Valenciana, and Galicia were the main destinations of guests resident in Spain, with annual variation rates for overnight stays of – 4.7%, 2.3%, –0.8% and 5.8%, respectively.




The main destination chosen by non-residents was Illes Balears, with 34.6% of the total amount of overnight stays. In this Autonomous Community, overnight stays by non-residents increased 3.0% as compared to August 2015. The following destinations of non-residents were Cataluña (21.4% of the total and an increase of 4.3% in overnight stays) and Canarias (19.8% of the total and an increase of 10.7% in overnight stays).

Distribution of overnight stays of guests resident abroad in %




Hotel Occupancy

In August, 78.0% of the available bedplaces were occupied, indicating an annual increase of 2.2%. The weekend occupancy rate by bedplaces increased by 4.2%, standing at 80.4%.

By tourist areas, the island of Mallorca registered the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (93.0%), and the island of Ibiza-Formentera, the highest weekend occupancy rate (93.7%). The Costa del Sol recorded the highest number of overnight stays, with more than 2.5 million.


The tourist sites with the highest number of overnight stays were Barcelona, Calvià and Madrid. Muro reached the highest occupancy rate by bedplaces (98.8%) and Llucmajor the greatest weekend occupancy rate (98.2%).

Overnight stays according to the country of origin of the guests

Guests from the United Kingdom and Germany concentrated 27.2% and 21.1%, respectively, of the total of overnight stays in hotel establishments by non-residents in August. The British market increased by 9.4%, and the German one did so by 1.4%.

Overnight stays of guests from France, Italy and the Netherlands (the following countries of origin) registered annual rates of 0.6%, 1.6% and 20.4%, respectively.

Hotel Prices

The annual rate of the Hotel Prices Index (HPI) stood at 6.9% in August, that is, 0.6 points less than that of the previous month and 1.9 points above than that registered in the previous year.

Hotel Prices Index. Annual variation rate

Illes Balears, Cataluña, Andalucía and Canarias were the Autonomous Communities that carried the greatest weight of the total load of the HPI in the month of August (they represented 76.5% of the total). Hotel prices increased by 9.1% in the annual rate in Canarias, 8.9% in Illes Balears and 5.4% in Cataluña and in Andalucía.

By hotel category, increase in hotel prices were registered in all of them. In three-golden-star establishments (9.0%), in four -golden-star establishments (7.0%), in one-golden-star establishments (6.0%), in five-golden-star establishments (5.5%), in three-silver-star and in two-silver-star establishments (5.5% in both cases), in one-silver-star establishments (3.6%) and in two-golden-star establishments (1.2%).


Indicators on the Profitability of the Hotel Sector

The daily average invoicing per occupied room (ADR) in August was 100.2 euros, which represented an increase of 5.2% as compared to the same month of 2015.


In turn, the daily average revenue per available room (RevPAR), which is conditioned by the occupancy registered in hotel establishments, reached 79.6 euros, with an increase of 8.9%.

By category, the average invoicing was 213.3 euros for five-star hotels, 111.5 euros for four-star hotels and 88.2 euros for three-star hotels. Income per available room for the same categories were 167.8, 96.2 and 74.0 euros, respectively.
