Elections to the European Parliament the 25th May 2014

More than 2.1 million EU citizens will be able to vote in Spain

In order to vote, EU citizens must previously express their wish to exercise this right in Spain until the 30th January 2014

The Electoral Census Office has sent out a letter to 566,155 EU citizens in order to ease this paperwork

The Electoral Census Office has registered a total of 2,145,590 citizens of the European Union (EU) resident in Spain who may exercise the right to vote in Spain in the elections to the European Parliament for the 25th May 2014.

Currently, a total of 322,878 EU electors will be able to vote, as they have previously expressed their wish to exercise this right. This declaration is of permanent nature.

The rest of EU electors must previously express their wish to vote in Spain.

In order to facilitate this paperwork, the Electoral Census Office has sent a letter by regular post to 566,155 EU citizens resident in Spain, who have not received any letter from the Electoral Census Office in previous elections to the European Parliament, and who have not expressed their wish to vote in Spain since the elections to the European Parliament of the year 2009.

Procedures to express the wish to vote in Spain

The interested parties will be able to process their wish to exercise this right in various ways:

A. EU citizens who receive a letter will only have to complete and sign the formal statement included in it and send it to the corresponding Provincial Delegation of the Electoral Census Office. Furthermore, EU citizens for whom the OCE holds a Foreign National Identity Number (NIE) may express their wish to vote at the following Internet address <https://sede.ine.gob.es>.

B. EU citizens resident in Spain who are already registered and do not receive any letter can express their wish to vote in Spain in their corresponding municipal Council. Furthermore, EU citizens who hold an electronic certificate associated with their NIE of whose existence the Electoral Census Office is aware may express their wish to vote at the following Internet address <https://sede.ine.gob.es>.

C. EU citizens resident in Spain who are not registered in the municipal register should do so in their corresponding municipal Council and complete the form expressing their wish to vote in Spain.

In any of the three procedures, in order for wish to vote to be effective in the elections to the European Parliament the 25th May 2014, the form must be submitted the 30th January 2014 at the latest.

- **Residents.** The provinces that registered the greatest presence of residents are Madrid (314,343), Alicante/Alacant (272,644) and Málaga (162,887).
- **Electors.** The provinces that registered the greatest presence of electors are Alicante/Alacant (55,552), Madrid (42,571) and Málaga (30,492).
- **Letters sent.** The provinces that registered the greatest number of letters sent are Madrid (77,879), Barcelona (59,887) and Alicante/Alacant (50,026).
