Services Sector Price Index (SSPI). Base 2021

Second Quarter 2026. Provisional data

Main results

- The annual variation of the Services Sector Price Index increased by three tenths in the second quarter of 2026, to 2.9%.
- The quarterly rate of services prices was 3.2%.

The annual rate of the general Services Sector Price Indices (SSPI) was 2.9% in the second quarter, three tenths above the figure recorded in the first quarter.

Annual evolution of the IPS

Among the activities that had a positive impact on the evolution of the annual rate of the general SSPI were the following:

- **Travel agency and tour operator activities, booking services and related activities**, with an annual variation of 8.2%, 5.5 points above the previous quarterly rate, due to prices in this activity increasing more than they did in the second quarter of 2025.
- **Accommodation services**, whose annual variation increased by 0.8 points to 4.7%, as prices in this activity had increased more than in the same quarter of the previous year.

On the other hand, among activities with a negative influence were:

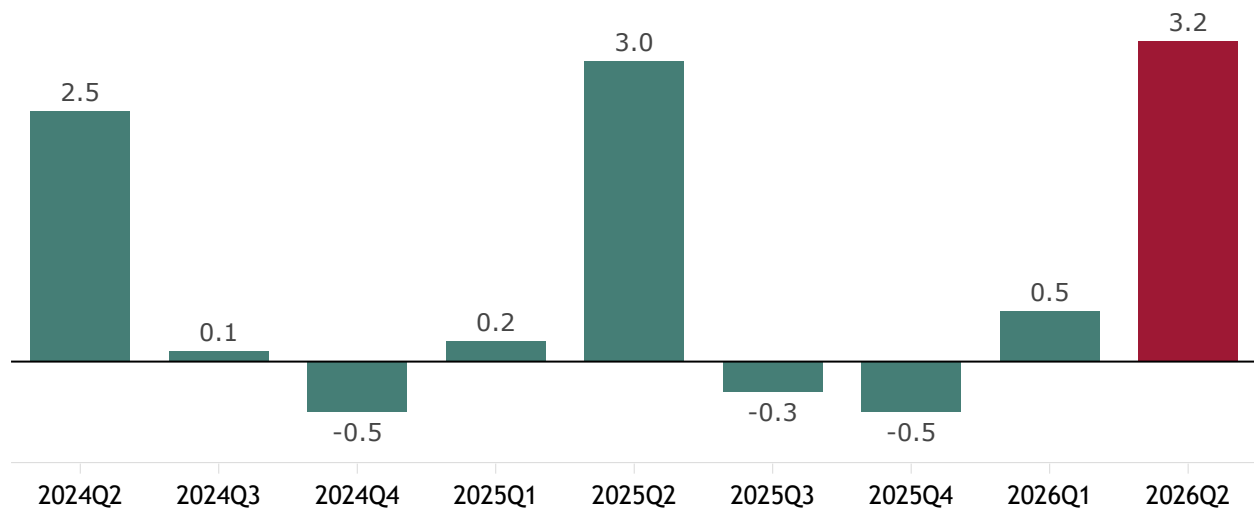
- **Air transport**, with an annual variation of 0.5%, 3.4 points below the figure of the first quarter, due to the prices of this activity increased less than in the second quarter of 2025.
- **Telecommunications**, which decreased its rate by 1.1 points, reaching 1.3%, due to the drop in the prices of this activity, which had increased in the second quarter of last year.

Quarterly evolution of the prices of services

The quarterly variation in the general SSPI was 3.2% in the second quarter of 2026. This rate was 2.7 points higher than that of the previous quarter.

Data revisions and updates

The INE has updated today the IPS data for the last four quarters, making the data for the second quarter of 2025 final. All the results of this operation are available at [INEBase](#).

In accordance with the [Commission's Delegated Regulation \(EU\) 2023/137](#), the INE has begun to work on incorporating the new National Classification of Economic Activities CNAE-2025 in all its statistical operations.

In the case of the SSPI, the first publication of results with CNAE-2025 will take place in June 2028.

Methodological note

The Services Sector Price Indices (SSPI), which are published on a quarterly basis, aim to measure the evolution of the prices of services provided by companies operating in the services sector in Spain, from the supply side (producer's point of view). The prices considered for the calculation are those of services provided to both companies and private consumers.

The activities that form part of the SSPI calculation, in Base 2021, are those included in Sections H, I, J, L, M (except M701, M72 and M75) and N of the CNAE, as specified in the Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197.

Type of survey: quarterly continuous survey.

Base year: 2021.

Reference period of the weightings: the year preceding the current year.

Population scope: services companies.

Sample size: around 1,400 companies and 151 products.

Number of observations: approximately 8,400 quarterly prices.

General calculation method: Laspeyres' Chain Index.

Collection method: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or postal mail.
