Mercantile Companies Statistics (MC)

June 2024. Provisional data

Main results

- The number of mercantile companies created decreased by 6.7% in June compared to the same month in 2023.
- The number of dissolved companies decreased by 5.9% compared to the same month in 2023.

In June, 9,528 mercantile companies were incorporated, 6.7% less than in the same month of 2023. The subscribed capital for incorporation recorded an annual increase of 27.5% and the average subscribed capital (49,423 euros) increased by 36.6%.

On the other hand, 2,168 companies increased their capital, 9.0% less than in June 2023. Capital subscribed in capital increases grew by 1.3%.

The number of dissolved companies decreased by 5.9% in annual rate. 80.3% of them did so voluntarily.




Results by main economic activity principal

18.1% of the mercantile companies incorporated in June corresponded to *Trade* and 16.9% to *Real estate, financial and insurance companies*. As for the dissolved companies, 22.0% were in *Trade* and 15.7% in *Construction*.

Mercantile companies created by main economic activity. June 2024 Percentage




Mercantile companies dissolved by main economic activity. June 2024 Percentage



The economic activity with the largest subscribed capital of mercantile companies incorporated was *Real estate, financial and insurance,* with 238.59 million euros. In turn, *Information and communications* companies had the lowest capital, with 2.63 million.



Capital subscribed of mercantile companies created by main economic activity. June 2024 Thousands of euros




Results by Autonomous Community

Castilla y León (25.0%), Región de Murcia (23.8%) and Cantabria (19.0%) had the highest annual increases in the number of mercantile companies incorporated.

On the other hand, La Rioja (-35.1%), Extremadura (-28.9%) and Andalucía (-11.8%) registered the largest decreases.

Revision and updating of data

The data for 2024 are provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period next year are published. All results of this operation are available on INEbase.

Methodological note

The Mercantile Companies Statistics were created by Order of 30 April 1938. Their objective is to measure the demographics of companies, providing monthly information, at provincial and Autonomous Community level, on the companies incorporated, dissolved and those in which there have been changes in capital.

The source of information is the Central Mercantile Registry, which collects all provincial information on the registration of companies and entrepreneurs, as well as mercantile acts determined by law.

Type of survey: continuous monthly survey.

Population scope: set of companies registered in the Central Mercantile Register.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, by Autonomous Communities and provinces.

Reference period of the results: the calendar month.

Reference period of the information: the calendar month.

Collection method: official records.
