Mercantile Companies Statistics (MC)

October 2024. Provisional data

Main results

- The number of mercantile companies created increased by 28.8% in October compared with the same month in 2023.
- The number of dissolved companies increased by 14.3% year-on-year.

In October, 10,679 mercantile companies were incorporated, 28.8% more than in the same month in 2023. The subscribed capital for their creation recorded an annual increase of 16.6%, while the average subscribed capital (36,620 euros) decreased by 9.5%.

In addition, 2,437 companies increased their capital, 14.6% more than in October 2023. The subscribed capital in these increases rose by 22.4%.

The number of dissolved companies grew by 14.3% year-on-year. 75.9% of them did so voluntarily.




Results by main economic activity

Of the mercantile companies incorporated in October, 17.2% were engaged in *Trade* and 16.1% were *Property, financial and insurance* companies. As for dissolved companies, 18.4% were engaged in *Trade* and 15.3% in *Construction*.

Mercantile companies dissolved by main economic activity. October 2024 Percentage




The economic activity with the largest subscribed capital of mercantile companies incorporated was *Real estate, financial and insurance,* with 161.91 million euros. In turn, *Information and communications* companies had the lowest capital, with 4.70 million.




Results by Autonomous Community

Comunidad Foral de Navarra (144.4%), La Rioja (133.3%) and Aragón (59.2%) recorded the highest annual growth in the number of mercantile companies created in October.

On the other hand, Canarias (7.9%), Illes Balears (10.0%) and Castilla y León (13.7%) recorded the biggest decreases.

Data revision and updating

The data for 2024 are provisional and will be reviewed when the data for the same period next year are published. All results of this operation are available on INEbase.

Methodological note

The Mercantile Companies Statistics were created by Order of 30 April 1938. Their objective is to measure the demographics of companies, providing monthly information, at provincial and Autonomous Community level, on the companies incorporated, dissolved and those in which there have been changes in capital.

The source of information is the Central Mercantile Registry, which collects all provincial information on the registration of companies and entrepreneurs, as well as mercantile acts determined by law.

Type of survey: continuous monthly survey.

Population scope: set of companies registered in the Central Mercantile Register.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory, by Autonomous Communities and provinces.

Reference period of the results: the calendar month.

Reference period of the information: the calendar month.

Collection method: official records.
