Passenger Transport Statistics (PT) June 2026. Provisional data

Main results

- The number of passengers using public transport increased by 2.0% in June, as compared with the same month of 2025.
- The annual rate for city transport increased by 3.1% and for inter-city transport decreased by 0.6%.

More than 506.5 million passengers used public transport in June, 2.0% more than in the same month of 2025.

The annual rate for city transport increased by 3.1% and for inter-city transport decreased by 0.6%. Within the latter, it is worth noting the 5.2% rise in the bus transport.

City transport

City transport was used by more than 314.2 million passengers in June, 3.1% more than in the same month of 2025.

Metro transport increased by 5.5% in annual rate and City transport by bus increased by 1.6% in June.

Inter-city transport

More than 146.1 million passengers used inter-city transport in June, representing a 0.6% decrease as compared with the same month of 2025.

By mode of transport, bus transport increased by 5.2%, air transport by 2.6%, maritime transport by 1.7%, whereas rail transport decreased by 8.3%.

Special and unscheduled transport

More than 46.1 million passengers used special and unscheduled transport in June, indicating an increase of 3.0% in annual rate.

The number of special transport passengers increased by 1.9%, reaching more than 24.8 million users. Within this, school transport increased by 2.1% and work transport did so by 1.5%.

Finally, unscheduled transport increased by 4.3% as compared with the same month of 2025, with more than 21.2 million passengers.

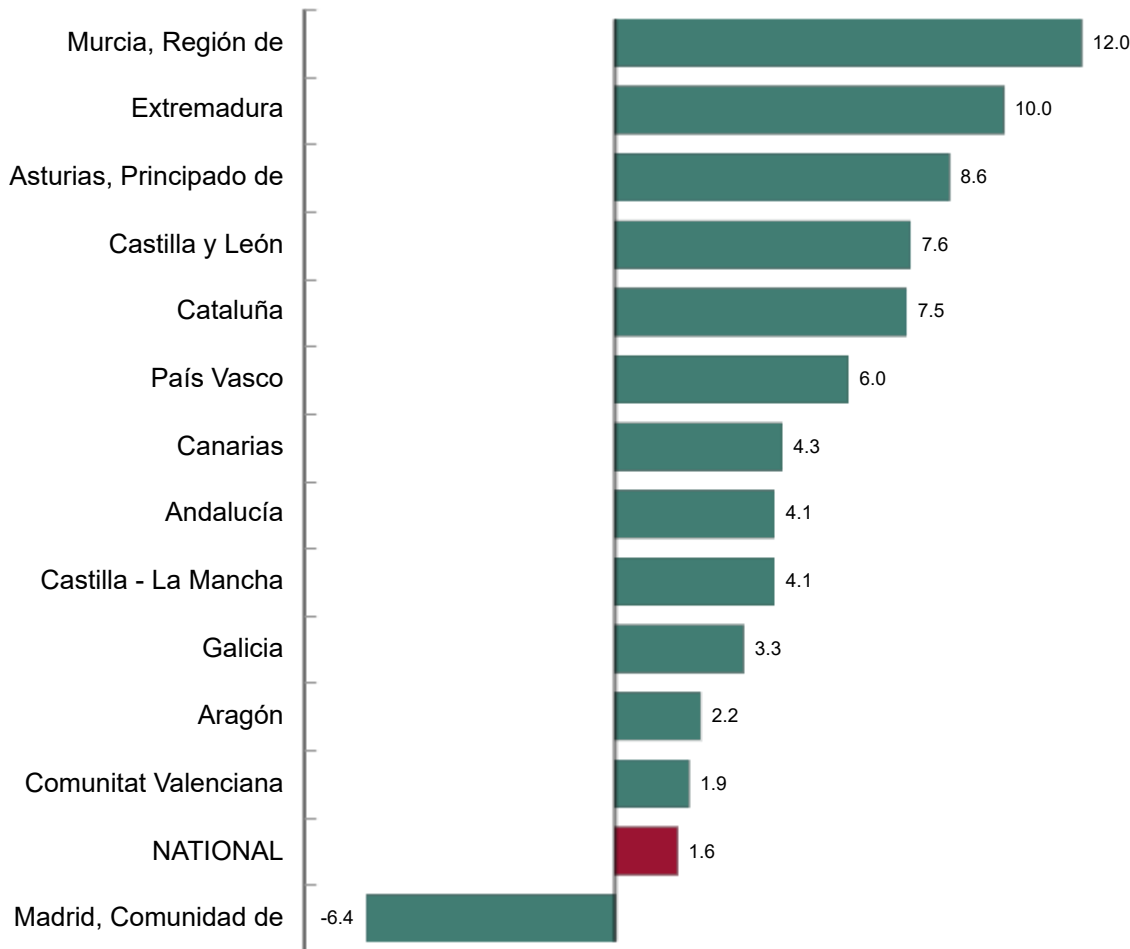
Result by Autonomous Communities

The number of bus transport passengers showed the highest increases in Región de Murcia (12.0%), Extremadura (10.0%) and Principado de Asturias (8.6%).

In turn, the largest decrease in bus transport passengers was shown in Comunidad de Madrid (-6.4%) in bus transport.

¹ In order to maintain statistical secrecy, data of Autonomous Communities of Illes Balears, Cantabria, Comunidad Foral de Navarra and La Rioja, and the Autonomous Cities of Ceuta and Melilla are not separately published.

Metro transport increased in all cities with this type of transport as compared with the same month of the previous year. Palma's metro registered the highest increase (11.5%), and Madrid's registered the lowest (3.8%).

Methodological note

The purpose of the Passenger Transport Statistics (PT) is to provide monthly information regarding the number of passengers transported by city transport (bus and metropolitan), inter-city transport (road, rail, air and sea) and special and unscheduled bus transport.

Road transport is researched through a simple survey. For rail transport, the number of passengers is calculated using the information provided by the railway operators (RENFE and other autonomous companies). The information for air transport is provided by Civil Aviation, and for sea transport, the number of passengers disembarked is compiled using information from State Ports.

Survey Type: ongoing monthly.

Population scope: companies involved in passenger transport irrespective of their main activity.

Geographical scope: the whole country

Reference period of the results: month.

Reference period of the information: month.

Sample size: Approximately 1,500 companies.

Type of sampling: stratified random sampling of companies, by Autonomous Communities, number of employees and type of transport.

Collection method: fill in a questionnaire by respondent using one of the following methods: internet (IRIA system), email, fax, telephone or post.
