
Retail Trade Indices. Base 2005 April 2007. Provisional data

Retail trade at constant prices grows 1.6% in April, as compared to the same month in 2006.

The general retail trade index in constant terms (that is, after eliminating the price effect) registered a 1.6% interannual increase in the month of April. Foodstuffs decreased 0.1%, whilst non-food products grew 2.7%. A breakdown of the latter by product type shows a negative annual rate of -0.3% for Personal Goods and positive rates of 1.5% in Household equipment and 3.6% in Other goods.

This month was not influenced by the calendar effect, as it had the same number of working days as the month of April 2006.




Sales in department stores present a 1.4% decrease in the interannual rate in constant terms.

The general index for department stores, which analyses the evolution of sales in premises larger than 2,500 square metres, showed a 1.4% interannual decrease at constant prices in April 2007. Foodstuffs decreased 5.1%, whilst non-food products grew 0.9%.

Annual rates for Department Stores (constant prices)

Aragón, Cantabria and Galicia are the autonomous communities where greater interannual increases in sales rates have been registered

By Autonomous Communities, the highest increase of the retail trade index in constant terms in the month of April corresponded to Aragón (4.1%), Cantabria (3.9%), Galicia (3.9%), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (3.5%) and La Rioja (3.4%)

The lowest interannual increases were registered in Cataluña (0.4%), Castilla y León (0.6%) and Andalucía (1.0%).

Indices by Autonomous Communities

Employment in the retail sector increases 1.7% in April 2007.

The employment rate index (showing the evolution of employment, both for employees and self-employed workers) yielded a 1.7% interannual growth for the whole of the retail sector, during April 2007. In department stores overall employment increased 1.2%.

Región de Murcia and La Rioja yield the greatest employment rate increases with regards to the same month from the previous year.

Based on the Autonomous Communities, the greatest interannual employment rate increases were accounted for in Región de Murcia (3.9%), La Rioja (3.0%), Extremadura (2.8%) and Galicia (2.8%).

Illes Balears was the only Autonomous Community that showed a decrease in its annual employment rate (-0,1%).
