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Retail Trade Indices. Base 2005 October 2007. Provisional data


Retail Trade at constant prices grows 3.0% in October in comparison with the same month of 2006

The General Retail Trade Index in constant terms (that is, after having corrected the price effect) recorded a 3.0% interannual growth in October. *Foodstuffs* increased 3.0%, and *Non-food products* grew 3.1%. A breakdown of the latter by type of product shows annual growth amounting to 7.1% for *Personal goods*, 2.9% in *Other goods* and *Furniture and household equipment* recorded no variation.

After eliminating the calendar effect (i.e. the difference between the number of working days in a given month in different years) the Retail Trade Index at constant prices registered a 1.3% increase

Annual rates (constant prices)


Sales in department stores present a 2.9% increase in the interannual rate in constant terms.

The General Index for department stores, which analyses the evolution of sales in premises larger than 2,500 square metres, recorded a 2.9% interannual increase at constant prices in October. *Foodstuffs* presented a variation of 1.0%, and *Non-food products* presented a variation of 4.2%.

Having corrected for calendar effect, this index saw an increase of 1.9%.

Department Store annual rates (constant prices)

Extremadura and Comunidad de Madrid are the Autonomous Communities with the greatest interannual increases in sales

By Autonomous Community, the greatest interannual increases in the Retail Trade Index at constant prices in the month of October were registered in Extremadura (6.1%), Comunidad de Madrid (5.3%), Aragón (5.0%) and Castilla-La Mancha (5.0%).

The lowest interannual increases were registered in Andalucía (0.9%) and Illes Balears (1.3%).

Indices by Autonomous Community

Employment in the retail sector increases 2.0% in October.

The Employment Index in the retail trade sector (showing the evolution of employment, for both employees and self-employed workers) yielded a 2.0% interannual growth for the whole of the retail sector, in October 2007. In department stores as a whole, employment increased 3.9%.

Región de Murcia yields the greatest employment rate increase with regard to the same month from the previous year

By Autonomous Community, the greatest interannual employment increases were accounted for in Región de Murcia (3.9%), Extremadura (3.5%), Aragón (3.4%), and Castilla y León (3.4%).

Castilla-La Mancha (0.8%) and Cataluña (0.8%) were the Autonomous Communities showing the lowest annual increases in employment.
