Industrial Production Index. Base 2000 February 2007

The Industrial Production Index corrected for calendar effect increases 3.5% in February with respect to the same month in 2006

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) has experienced a 3.5% variation in February 2007 with respect to the same month from the previous year.

Deducting calendar effects, the interannual variation of the IPI can be estimated at 3.5%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year are 3.7% for Consumer Goods (17.6 for Durable Consumer Goods and 1.4% for Non-Durable Consumer Goods), 9.5% for Capital Goods, 4.3%% for Intermediate Goods and -6.6% for Energy.

Deducting calendar effects, these interannual rates can be estimated at 3.7% for consumer goods (17.7% for durable consumer goods and 1.4% for non-durable consumer goods), 9.5% for capital goods, 4.3% for intermediate goods and -6.6% for energy.

The average rate of IPI adjusted for calendar effects 4.1% in the two first months of 2007 is 4.1%

The average IPI rate stands at 5.4% during the first two months of 2007 in comparison wiht the same month of 2006. Adjusting calendar effects, this average rate stands at 4.1%.

The evolution of the average rate of industrial production by economic destination of the goods has been 6.0% for consumer goods (17.9% for durable consumer goods and 4.1% for non-durable consumer goods), 11.5% for capital goods, 6.1% for intermediate goods and - 4.4% for energy.

Adjusting calendar effects, these average rates for the two first months stand at 4.4% for consumer goods (15.5% for durable consumer goods and 2.5% for non-durable consumer goods), 10.1% for capital goods, 4.7% for intermediate goods and -4.8% for energy.

Activities with the greatest growth in the month of February 2007 are "Manufacture of furniture; manufacturing n.e.c. ", 22.9%, and "Manufacture of electrical machinery and material", 22.6%.

In contrast, those with the lowest growth are "Extraction of Energy products", -24.5%, and "Manufacture of office machines and IT equipment", -12.1%.
