#### Industrial Production Index. Base 2000 September 2007

## The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects increases 0.6% in September as compared to the same month in 2006

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a –1.3% decrease in September 2007 in comparison with the same month the previous year. After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual variation of the IPI was estimated at 0.6%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year were -2.9% for consumer goods (-2.1% for durable consumer goods and -3.0% for non-durable consumer goods), 2.6% for capital goods, -2.7% for intermediate goods and 0.8% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at -0.4% for consumer goods (1.4% for durable consumer goods and -0.6% for non-durable consumer goods), 4.8% for capital goods, -0.6% for intermediate goods and 1.5% for energy.

## The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects increases 2.6% in the first nine months of 2007

The average IPI rate stood at 2.7% during the first nine months of 2007 in comparison with the same period in 2006. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at 2.6%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was 2.7% for consumer goods (8.8% for durable consumer goods and 1.7% for non-durable consumer goods), 6.8% for capital goods, 2.0% for intermediate goods and -1.0% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first nine months stood at 2.6% for consumer goods (8.6% for durable consumer goods and 1.6% for non-durable consumer goods), 6.8% for capital goods, 1.8% for intermediate goods and -1.0% for energy.

Activities with the greatest average growth in the January-September 2007 period were *Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c.*, 11.8%, and *Manufacture of furniture; manufacturing n.e.c.*, 11.0%.

In contrast, those with the least growth were Manufacture of office machinery and computers, -12.4%, and Tanning and dressing of leather; manufacture of luggage, handbags, saddlery, harness and footwear, -8.3%.
