Industrial Production Index. Base 2000 October 2007

The Industrial Production Index adjusted for calendar effects increases 2.6% in October as compared to the same month in 2006

The General Industrial Production Index (IPI) experienced a 4.7% increase in October 2007 in comparison with the same month the previous year. After adjusting for calendar effects, the interannual variation of the IPI was estimated at 2.6%.

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year were 3.4% for consumer goods (5.4% for durable consumer goods and 3.0% for non-durable consumer goods), 9.7% for capital goods, 3.5% for intermediate goods and 4.1% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these interannual rates were estimated at 0.6% for consumer goods (1.6% for durable consumer goods and 0.4% for non-durable consumer goods), 7.4% for capital goods, 1.2% for intermediate goods and 3.4% for energy.

The average rate of the IPI adjusted for calendar effects increases 2.6% in the first ten months of 2007

The average IPI rate stood at 2.9% during the first ten months of 2007 in comparison with the same period in 2006. After adjusting for calendar effects, this average rate stood at 2.6%.

The evolution of the average industrial production rate by economic destination of the goods was 2.8% for consumer goods (8.2% for durable consumer goods and 2.0% for non-durable consumer goods), 7.2% for capital goods, 2.1% for intermediate goods and -0.5% for energy.

After adjusting for calendar effects, these average rates for the first ten months stood at 2.4% for consumer goods (7.6% for durable consumer goods and 1.6% for non-durable consumer goods), 6.9% for capital goods, 1.8% for intermediate goods and -0.6% for energy.

Activities with the greatest average growth in the January-October 2007 period were *Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c.*, 11.5%, and *Manufacture of furniture; manufacturing n.e.c.*, 10.1%.

In contrast, those with the least growth were *Manufacture of office machinery and computers*, -12.1%, and *Tanning and dressing of leather; manufacture of luggage, handbags, saddlery, harness and footwear*, -8.0%.
