Industrial Price Index. Base 2010 February 2017. *Provisional data*

The annual Industrial Price Index stands at 7.3%, three tenths below than that of January

The monthly variation of industrial prices stands at -1.3%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate for the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in February was **7.3%**, two tenths below than that registered in January.


By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors of most negative influence in this fall were:

• *Energy*, whose annual variation rate stood at **22.9%**, falling by more than three and a half points below than that of January. This evolution is the result of the decrease in the prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electric power*, which fell this month more than they did in 2016.

On the other hand, worth noting amongst the industrial sectors with a positive influence were:


- Intermediate goods, with a rate of 4.0%, more than one point over the previous month and the highest since November 2011. This behaviour was mostly due to the increase of prices in Manufacture of basic chemicals, fertilisers and nitrogen compounds, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms, as compared with the decrease registered last year.
- **Non-durable consumer goods**, whose annual variation rate increased six tenths, up to **2.1%**. Of particular note in this behaviour was the rise in prices of the *Manufacture of vegetable* and animal oils and fats, which had dropped in 2016.

Contribution of the industrial sectors in the annual rate of the IPRI



The annual variation rate of the **general index excluding** *Energy* increased seven tenths to **2.5%**, thereby decreasing its difference with respect to that of the general IPRI, standing at 4.8 points below it.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices


In February, the monthly variation rate of the general IPRI was -1.3%.

By economic destination of the goods, the only industrial sector with a negative monthly contribution was:

• *Energy*, with a rate of **-6.5%** and a contribution of **-1.667**. This evolution is the result of the decrease in the prices of the *Production, transport and distribution of electric power*, and to a lesser degree, in *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

In turn, amongst the sectors that presented a positive effect on the general index, the most relevant was:

- *Intermediate goods*, which registered a variation rate of **0.7%**. Of particular note in this behaviour was the rise in prices of the *Manufacture of basic chemical products, nitrogenous compounds, fertilisers, plastics and synthetic rubber in primary forms*. Its contribution to the general IPRI was **0.213**.
- **Non-lasting consumer goods**, with a rate of **0.3%** and a repercussion of **0.093** due mainly to the rise in the price of the *Manufacture of vegetable and animal oils and fats*.



A more detailed analysis showed the activities that most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of February.


Results by Autonomous Community. Annual changes

The annual rate of the IPRI decreased in 10 Autonomous Communities. The greatest decreases were recorded in Illes Balears and Canarias, whose annual rates decreased 5.8 and 3.9 points respectively.

In turn, Andalucía and Castilla-La Mancha registered the largest increases in annual rate, with one point and seven tenths, respectively.
