

Industrial Price Index. Base 2015

The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index fell more than two and a half points, to 40.4%

The monthly rate of industrial prices was 0.0%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

In July, the annual rate of the general Industrial Price Index (IPRI) was 40.4%, more than two and a half points below that registered in June.

Among the industrial sectors with a negative influence on the evolution of the annual rate of the General IPRI, and by the economic destination of the goods, worth noting were:

- **Energy**, whose rate decreased almost 10 points, reaching 100.6%, due to the decrease in the prices of *Oil refining* and the *Production, transport and distribution of electrical energy*; which were higher than in July 2021.


While in the opposite direction, the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains* was also of note, being higher than that registered the previous year.

- **Intermediate goods**, whose annual rate fell by nearly two and a half points, to stand at 22.1%. This evolution resulted from the increase in prices of the *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferro-alloy products* and, to a lesser extent, the *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*, compared with the increases in July of last year.

On the other hand, among the industrial sectors with a positive influence, worth noting were:

- **Non-durable consumer goods** had a variation of 11.6%. This was more than one point above that of the previous month, and was caused by the rise in the prices of *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*, which fell in the same month of the previous year.

Contribution of industrial sectors to the annual rate of the IPRI




Annual rate difference **-2.7**

The annual variation rate of the general index excluding Energy decreased by five points, to 14.8%, standing nearly 25 and a half points below that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In July, the monthly change of the overall IPRI was 0.0%.

By economic destination of the goods, the industrial sectors that presented a negative monthly effect were:

- **Intermediate goods**, with a monthly variation of 0.0% and a contribution of -0.126. This was due to a decrease in the prices of *Manufacture of basic precious and other non-ferrous metals*.
- **Energy**, whose monthly rate of -0.3% had a contribution of -0.121. Notable in this behavior was the decrease in the prices of *oil refining* and in *Electric power generation, transmission and distribution*


Also noteworthy, although in a positive direction, was the increase in the prices of *Manufacture of gas; distribution of gaseous fuels through mains*.

The industrial sectors with a positive monthly effect notably include:

- **Non-durable consumer goods**, with a monthly variation of 1.0%. This was primarily caused by an increase in the prices of the *Processing and preserving of meat and production of meat products*. This sector's contribution to the overall index was 0.227.

Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates


Compared to June, in July the annual rate of the IPRI increased in two Autonomous Communities, decreased in 14 and remained stable in the others.

The communities where the rate increased were La Rioja and Extremadura, with increases of 1.5 and 1.4 points, respectively.

On the other hand, the largest decreases were recorded in Canarias, Principado de Asturias and Illes Balears, with decreases of 11.0, 7.9 and 6.4 points, respectively.

Data Review and Update

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data of the IPRI series corresponding to the last three months, with the month of April 2022 becoming definitive. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The Industrial Price Index (IPRI) is a short-term indicator that measures the monthly evolution of the prices of industrial products manufactured and sold in the domestic market, in the first step of their commercialisation, that is to say, at ex-factory prices, excluding transport and commercialisation costs and invoiced VAT.

Type of survey: monthly continuous survey.

Base year: 2015.

Reference period of the weightings: the year preceding the current year

Population scope: industrial workplaces

Sample size: 9,000 industrial establishments and 1,500 items.

Number of observations: approximately 28,000 monthly prices.

General calculation method: Laspeyres' Chain Index.

Collection method: internet (IRIA system), e-mail, fax, telephone or postal mail.
