Industrial Price Index. Base 2010 August 2017. Provisional data

The annual variation of the Industrial Price Index stood at 3.2%, two tenths above that registered in July

The monthly rate of industrial prices is -0.1%

Annual evolution of industrial prices

The annual rate of the General Industrial Price Index (IPRI) in the month of August is **3.2%**, two tenths higher than in July.

By economic destination of goods, all industrial sectors have a positive influence on this increase. They stand out among them:


•Intermediate goods, which increased four tenths of its variation to 2.9%. This evolution is due to the rise in the prices of the production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals, which fell in August last year.

Also influences, albeit to a lesser extent, that the prices of *Manufacture of basic iron, steel and ferroalloys products* decrease this month less than in 2016.

• *Energy*, whose annual variation stands at **6.0**%, three tenths above that of the previous month. This behavior is a consequence of the rise in the prices of the *Oil Refining*, compared to the decrease registered in August 2016.


It should also be noted, although in the opposite direction, the fall in the prices of *Production, transportation and distribution of electricity*, higher than the previous year.

The annual rate of change of the **general index without** *Energy* increases by one tenth to **2.1%**, which is more than one point below that of the general IPRI.

Monthly evolution of industrial prices

In August the monthly rate of variation of the general IPRI is -0.1%.


By economic destination of the goods, among the industrial sectors with the greatest negative monthly impact, it stands out:

• *Energy*, which puts its rate at **-0.4%**, as a result of the lower prices of *Production*, transportation and distribution of electricity. Its impact on the overall IPRI is **-0.099**.

It should be noted, albeit in a positive sense, the rise in oil refinery prices.

For its part, the sector with the greatest positive impact was:

•Intermediate goods, which presents a variation of **0.1%** and a repercussion of **0.033**. This evolution is mainly due to the increase in the prices of the production of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals.



In a more detailed analysis, one can observe the activities that have most affected the monthly rate of the IPRI in the month of August.



Results by Autonomous Communities. Annual variation rates

The annual rate of IPRI increases in nine Autonomous Communities and decreases in the remaining eight. The highest increases are observed in Canarias and Galicia, whose rates increase by 1.0 points in each one. And in País Vasco y Andalucía, with an increase of 0.8 points.

In turn, Illes Balears, Comunitat Valenciana y Principado de Asturias were the Autonomous Communities where their annual rate decreases, with decreases of 0.8, 0.6 and 0.5 points, respectively.
