September 2007

**The General Industrial Price Index increases 0.3% in September
with respect to the previous month**

In September, the General Industrial Price Index registered a 0.3% increase with respect to the month of August 2007. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Food and beverage products industry* (1.4%) and *Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (1.0%). In contrast, among the activities that recorded a decrease with respect to the previous month, the activity with the greatest effect was *Metallurgy* (-1.1%).

Considering the classification by economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the previous month were 0.5% for consumer goods (0.6% for non-durable consumer goods and no variation for durable consumer goods), 0.2% for capital goods, 0.2% for intermediate goods and 0.5% for energy.

The interannual rate of the General Index increases 3.4%

The General Industrial Price Index registered an increase of 3.4% in September 2007 with respect to the same month from the previous year. The activities that most influenced this variation were *Food and beverage products industry* (5.9%) and *Manufacture of metal products, except machinery and equipment* (5.9%).

By economic destination of the goods, the variation rates with respect to the same month from the previous year were 3.2% for consumer goods (2.9% for durable consumer goods and 3.2% for non-durable consumer goods), 3.2% for capital goods, 5.3% for intermediate goods and 0.8% for energy.
