Total expenditure by international tourists visiting Spain in June stood by 2,416 million, compared to 134 million same month of 2020

Average expenditure per tourist stands at 1,090 euros, 66.4% more


Total expenditure made by international tourists visiting Spain in June reached 2,416 million euros, compared to 134 million to the same month of 2020.

The average expenditure per tourist stood at 1,090 euros, with an annual increase of 66.4%. On the other hand, the average daily expenditure increased by 35.1%, up to 147 euros.


The average stay by international tourists was 7.4 days, indicating an increase of 1.4 days compared to the average June 2020.

During the first six months of 2021, the total expenditure by international tourists decreased by 51.4%, as compared with the same period of the previous year, reaching 5,765 million euros.

Sending countries

The main sending countries, in terms of level of expenditure in June were Germany (accounting for 22.9% of the total), France (12.5%) and United Kingdom (6.3%).

Expenditure by tourists from Germany stood by 554 million of euros, by those from France by 301 million and from United Kingdom 151 million.



Main destination Autonomous Communities

The main destination Autonomous Communities with the greatest weight in total tourist expenditure in June were Illes Balears (with 30.5% of the total), Cataluña (16.0%) and Andalucía (12.6%).

Total expenditure by main destination Autonomous Community Percentage



The tourist expenditure stood by 737 million of euros in Illes Balears, compared to 28 million in June 2020. The expenditure in Cataluña stood by 387 million and in Andalucía 304 million, compared to 39 and 10 million, respectively, same month last year.

The remaining main destination Autonomous Communities of tourists showed positive annual rate variations.

Expenditure items

The expenditure on activities was the most important items, representing 21.2% of the total expenditure and reached 513 million of euros, compared to 29 million same month of 2020.

The following items were expenditure on international transport (excluded on tourist package) and expenditure on accommodation (excluded on tourist package), which accounted for 18.4% and 18.0% of the total, respectively. The first increased by 2,856.0% in the annual rate and the latter by 1521.0%.

Main type of accommodation, method of organization and main reason for the trip

59.7% of total tourist expenditure in June was made by tourists staying at hotels, stood by 1,443 million of euros, compared to 62 million same month last year. On the other hand, expenditure in non-rented accommodation stood by 518 million, compared to 37 million same month last year.

Expenditure by tourists not travelling with a tourist package (which represented 82.3% of the total) stood by 1,988 million. For those who contract a tourist package, reached 428 million.

In terms of the reasons for travel, tourists visiting Spain for leisure generated 77.5% of the total expenditure (spending 1,873 million of euros).

Stopovers on trips and overnight stays by Autonomous Communities

Stopovers¹ on trips by international tourists in June reached nearly 2,5, compared to 224,242 same month last year. Of them, 27.8% were carried out in Illes Balears (with an increase of 2302.4%).

On the other hand, the total number of overnight stays by international tourists in all types of accommodation (hotels, holiday dwellings, own homes, homes of relatives or friends, rented dwelling, etc.) exceed 16.4 million, compared to 1.3 million same month last year.

Illes Balears was the Autonomous Community with the most overnight stays (4.7 million, compared to 222,272 same month last year). It was followed by Comunitat Valenciana (with nearly 2.7 million and an increase of 956.0%) and Andalucía (with 2,5 million, 2,908.9% more).

Review and update of data

Coinciding with today's publication, INE has updated the data corresponding to the month of June 2020, which become definitive.

¹ A stopover refers to each overnight stay made during the trip. A trip may have as many stopovers as intermediate destinations where the traveller has stayed at least one night.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Tourist Expenditure Survey (EGATUR) is to obtain monthly information on the tourist expenditure made by non-residents in Spain in their trips to our country.

For the preparation of EGATUR the international definitions and recommendations of the UNWTO and EUROSTAT in this field are followed.

Type of operation: continuous monthly statistics.

Population scope: this refers to non-residents in Spain who enter our country, whether or not they have stayed overnight, as well as those who pass through our country in transit.

Geographical scope: the entire national territory. The sample is collected at the main access points for non-resident travellers (road, airport, port and rail).

Reference period of the results: the month.

Sample size: The theoretical annual sample size of EGATUR exceeds 127,000 surveys, which are distributed throughout the year according to the seasonality of the flow of passengers and to the sample design, which is defined for each access road independently, setting a fraction of the sub-sampling from the FRONTUR sample.

Type of sampling: Single-stage, where the estimates of the FRONTUR survey are used as the target population to which the EGATUR data are elevated.

Collection method: The collection of information is carried out by direct interview when the traveler leaves Spain, using a multilingual electronic questionnaire. It must be taken into account that visitors are surveyed at the time of leaving the country, so the information collected may refer to a longer period than that of the reference month.
