





Bankruptcy Proceedings Statistics Third quarter of 2007. *Provisional data*

The number of debtors processed reaches 210 and the interannual rate increases by 25%

70.5% of companies declared bankrupt are from Industry, Construction and Trade

During the third quarter of 2007 the number of debtors processed reached 210, indicating a 25% increase as compared with the same quarter of the previous year. By type of bankruptcy, 193 were voluntary and 17 necessary, which implies an interannual increase of 33.1% and a 26.1% decrease, respectively. Considering the type of process, abbreviated processes increased 33.3% and ordinary processes increased 16.1%.

Of the 210 debtors processed in the third quarter, 190 were companies (physical persons with business activity and corporations). Most companies declared bankrupt were Private Limited Companies (74.2%).

Number of companies declared bankrupt by legal nature and business volume interval**






Most companies declared bankrupt (61.6%) were within the lowest business volume interval, less than two million euros, mainly Private Limited Companies (84.6%).

Most companies declared bankrupt in the third quarter of 2007 did not belong to any business group (83.2%). On the other hand, 16.3% of companies declared bankrupt belonged to a Spanish group and only 0.5% to a group under foreign control.

Companies declared bankrupt by economic activity and number of employees

31.6% of the companies declared bankrupt carried out their activities mainly in Industry, 20% in Construction and 18.9% in Trade.






