**Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)
First quarter 2022**

**The number of trips made by residents in Spain increased 110.9%
in the first quarter of 2022 and stands at 32.1 million**

**Total expenditure increases by 211.8% and exceeds 7,045 million
euros**

**Andalucía, Cataluña and Comunitat Valenciana are the main
destinations**

Residents in Spain made 32.1 million trips in the first quarter, 110.9% more than in the same period of 2021.

The main destination of 92.8% of the trips was the national territory, with an increase of 101.9% as compared to the first quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 394.8%, representing 7.2% of the total.

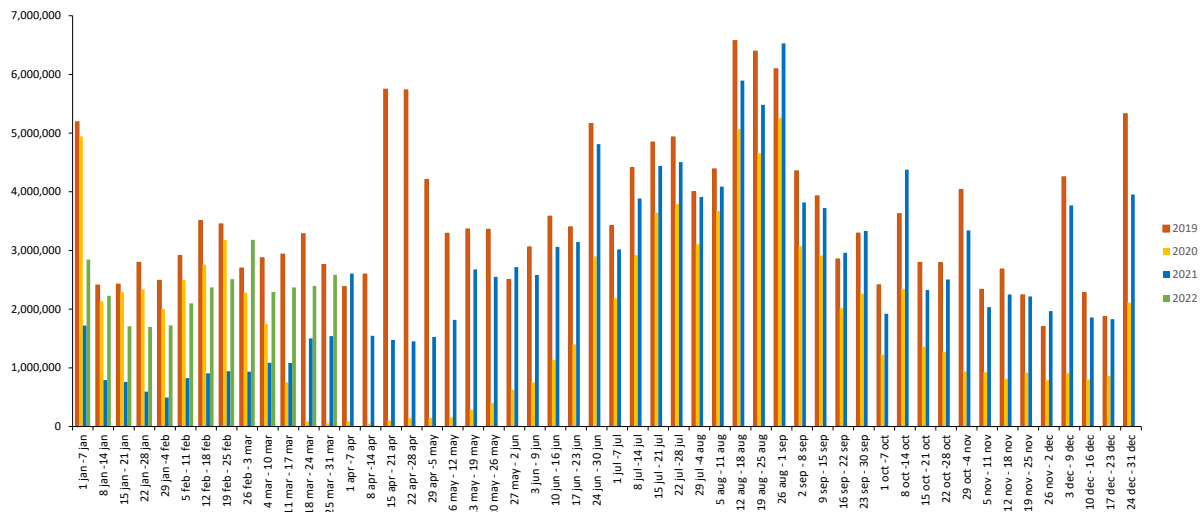

By weeks¹, an increase in trips was observed throughout the quarter compared to the previous year. Except for the first week of the year it was close to 2019 levels.

¹ In order to study trips by return date, trips to workplaces and centres of study were excluded (6.5% of the trips in the quarter) Also note that the last week of the third and fourth quarters of the graph have eight days, to complete the days in the quarter.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips, which were the main reason for 41.1% of trips made in the first quarter, increased by 228.2%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 40.0% of the total, decreased by 83.8%.

Trips taken for *Business and other professional reasons* and those made for *Other reasons*² increased by 32.9% and 65.8%, respectively.

For internal trips during the first quarter, the primary motivations were *Visits to family or friends* (40.8% of the total) and leisure (40.0%).

The primary reason for trips to a foreign destination was *Leisure, recreation and holidays*, with 55.6% of the total.

² *Other reasons* include shopping tourism, travel to places of study, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

In 44.7% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. More than 13.3 million trips used this type of accommodation, with an annual increase of 80.2%.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (52.3% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an increase of 545.1% as compared with the first quarter of 2021.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 80.9% of domestic trips, 91.3% more than in the same quarter of 2021. In 61.9% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 560.7%.

Main destinations

The main destination Autonomous Communities for trips by residents in the first quarter were Andalucía (with 16.4% of the total), Cataluña (14.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana (10.4%).

If domestic trips by residents are related to the destination, the phenomenon of travel was more intense in Castilla y León (with 1,293 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Aragón (with 1,148) and Extremadura (1,062).

³ For the calculation of this indicator, we have used both the trips of the population aged 15 and over as well as the population aged 15 and over residing in the destination (calculated as an average of the population for each of the months of the quarter).

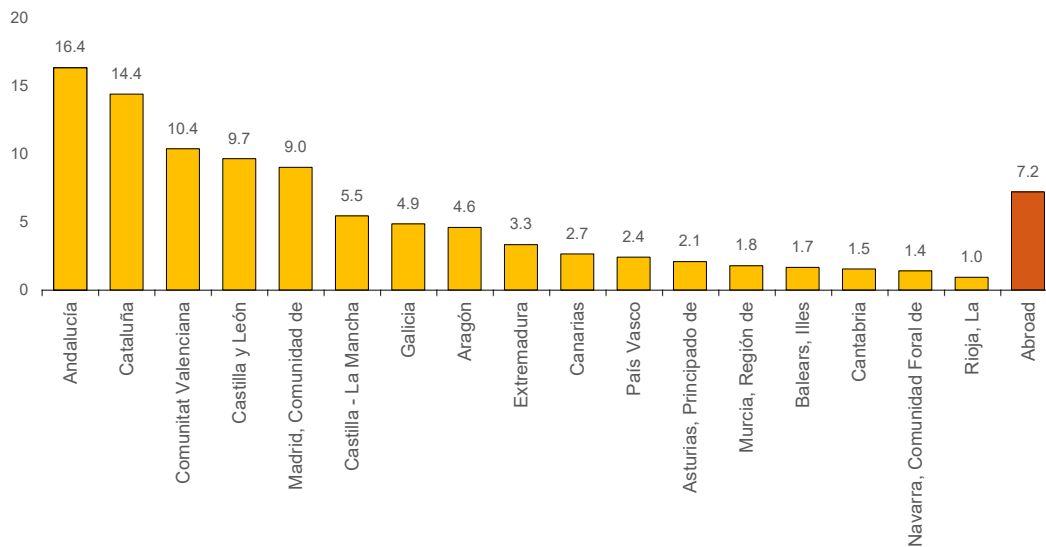

Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 18.2% of the total in the first quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (17.6%) and Andalucía (15.4%).

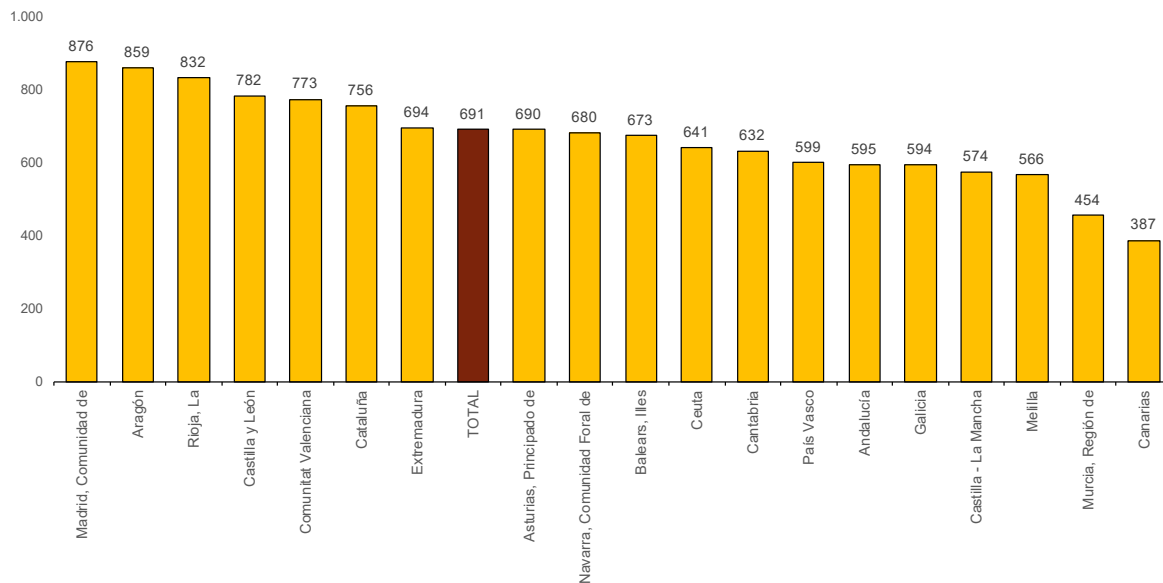

Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Comunidad de Madrid (876 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Aragón (859) and La Rioja (832).

In turn, Canarias (387 trips per one thousand inhabitants), Región de Murcia (454) and Región de Murcia (574) were the Autonomous Communities with the lowest ratio of trips by inhabitants.

Travel expenses

The total travel expenditure in the first quarter reached 7,045 million euros, indicating an 211.8% increase as compared with the same period of 2021.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 170.8% and on trips abroad by 437.0%.

The average daily expenditure was 62 euros for domestic trips and 101 euros for trips abroad.

For domestic trips, *expenditure in bars and restaurants*, which represented the highest percentage of total expenditure (25.3%), decreased by 238.4% as compared with the first quarter of 2021.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 35.9% of the total, with an annual increase of 400.9%.

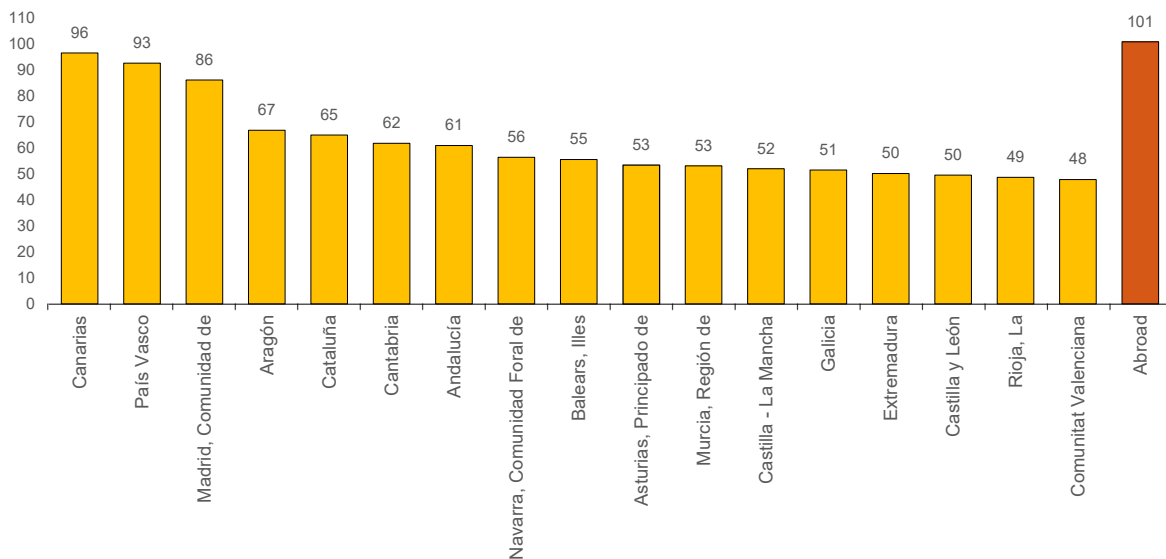

By main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Canarias (96 euros), País Vasco (93) and Comunidad de Madrid (86).

In turn, the lowest values were found in Comunitat Valenciana (48 euros), La Rioja (49) and Castilla y León and Extremadura (50).

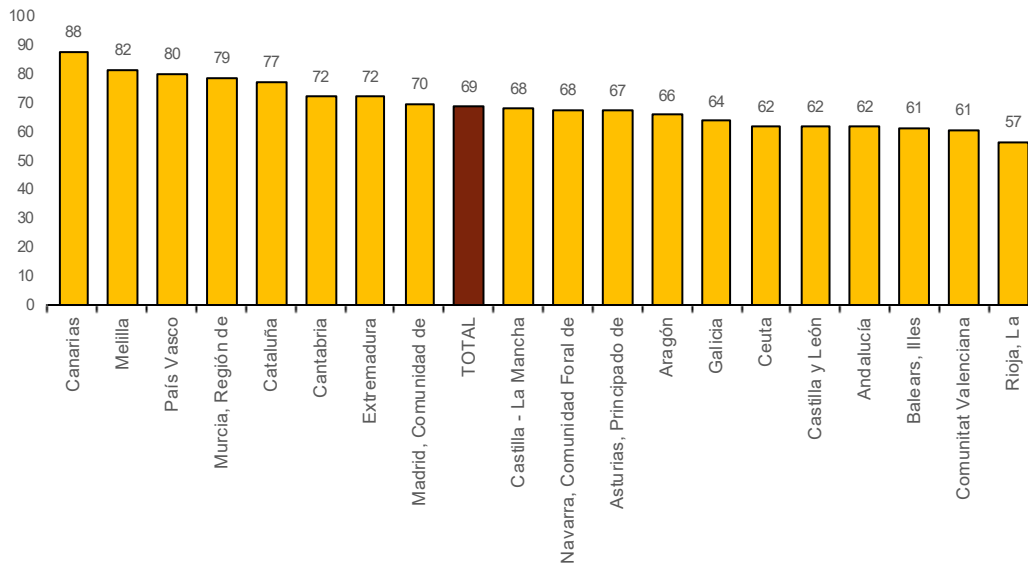
Average daily expenditure per person according to destination First quarter of 2022



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (88 euros), País Vasco (80) and Región de Murcia (79).

In turn, the lowest were found in La Rioja (57 euros), Comunitat Valenciana and Illes Balears (61 in both regions).

Monthly data

In January, 10.6 million trips were made, in February 10.9 million and in March 10.7 million. The trips made in January had an average duration of 3.9 overnight stays, exceeding the duration of trips in February and March, which were 2.6 and 3.1 nights, respectively.

January was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (51.4% compared to 54.5% in February). This was due to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Community (41.7% of the total).

Leisure was the main reason to travel in February and March (with 42.2% and 43.3% of the total, respectively), and *Visits to family or friends* in January (45.7%). Trips for professional reasons reached a peak in February and March (12.5% of the total).

January was the most important month for non-market accommodation (69.9%). Hotel accommodation recorded its greatest weight in March (27.6%) and other market accommodation in February (12.9%).

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 51.5 million excursions⁵ in the first quarter, with an annual increase of 41.4%. 96.3% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 3.7% for professional reasons.

89.4% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual growth of 30.0%.

9.6% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.0% to foreign countries. The number of excursions increased by 396.3% in the former.

Data Review and Update

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

⁵ An excursion is considered any visit without an overnight stay outside the person's usual environment. Trips that are part of someone's normal routine are excluded, as are those made from second homes, from a cruise ship, or from any other accommodation other than the usual one.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified three-stage random sampling is used. The framework is the MDG Georeferenced Address Framework. The first stage units are the census sections, the second stage units are the dwellings, and a person aged 15 or over has been selected within each dwelling. The stratification criterion in the first stage was the size of the municipality to which the section belongs. In both cases, a variable is used as a substratification criterion to define the household's propensity to travel.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
