Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)
Third quarter year 2019. Provisional data

The number of trips made by residents in Spain decreased 5.4% in the third quarter of 2019 and stands at 61.1 million

Total expenditure increased by 1.9% reaching 19,297 million euros

Andalucía, Comunitat Valenciana and Cataluña are the main destinations

Residents in Spain made 61.1 million trips in the third quarter of 2019, 5.4% less than for the same period in 2018.

At 88.1%, the main travel destination was within the national territory, with 6.4% decrease compared to the third quarter of last year. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 3.2%, representing 11.9% of the total.

38.3% of trips in the third quarter corresponded to summer holidays¹. Considering also the month of June, residents made 25.5 million summer vacation trips, 1.2% more than the previous year. These trips have an average duration of 11.9 overnight stays, 1.8% less than in the same period of 2018.

During the first nine months of 2019, trips made by residents decreased by 1.7% compared with the same period for the previous year. Domestic trips decreased by 2.6%, while international trips increased by 7.0%.

¹ Summer holidays are considered to be trips of five or more nights, made between June and September, for any reason other than health, education, work or incentives.

Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips, which were the primary motivation for 61.8% of trips taken in the third quarter, fell by 2.5%. In turn, *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 29.0% of the total, registered an annual decrease of 11.7%.

Trips for *Business and other professional reasons* decreased by 7.1%, while those made for *Other reasons*² increased by 5.1%.

The main reason for trips during the third quarter was leisure, whether for domestic (60,8%) or foreign (69,9%) destinations.

During the first nine months of 2019, leisure trips increased by 0.6% and those for other reasons by 10.7%. On the contrary, trips to visit family or friends decreased by 5.6%, and business trips by 7.1%.

In 40.8% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. Almost 22.0 million trips used this type of accommodation, with an annual decrease of 15.2%.

For trips abroad, hotel accommodation was the preferred option (46.0% of trips). This type of accommodation registered an increase of 5.5% as compared with the third quarter of 2018.

During the first nine months of 2019, domestic trips made by residents staying with relatives or friends decreased by 9.0%. On the other hand, trips abroad in hotel accommodation increased by 7.5%.

² *Other reasons* include shopping tourism, travelling to the study centre, other trips for education and training, health, religious reasons, company incentive trips and all other trips for personal reasons not included in another category.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 84.0% of domestic trips, 6.7% less than in the same quarter of 2018. In 59.7% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 8.0%.

During the first nine months of 2019, domestic trips made in personal vehicles increased by 3.4% and plane trips abroad increased by 8.7%.

Main destinations

The main Autonomous Community destinations for trips by residents in third quarter of 2019 were Andalucía (with 18.0% of the total), Comunitat Valenciana (12.3%) and Cataluña (11.7%).

If we relate domestic trips by residents to the destination population, travel was more intense in Cantabria (with 2,529 trips per 1,000 inhabitants³), Castilla y León (with 2,087) and Principado de Asturias (1,611).

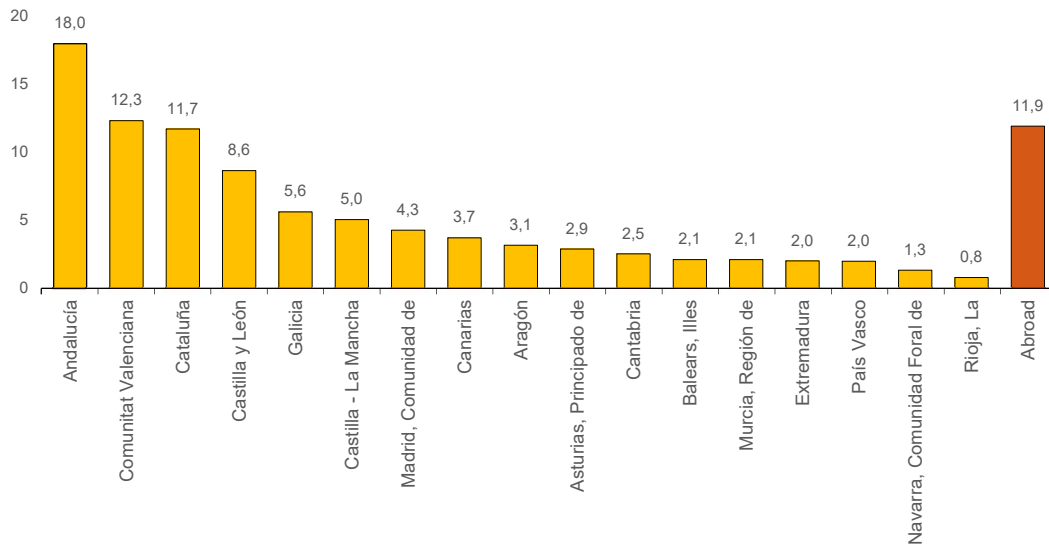

Autonomous Communities of origin

Trips made by the residents in Comunidad de Madrid represented 20.8% of the total in the third quarter. This was followed by Cataluña (16.5%) and Andalucía (15.4%).

Trips according to Autonomous Community of residence of the travellers

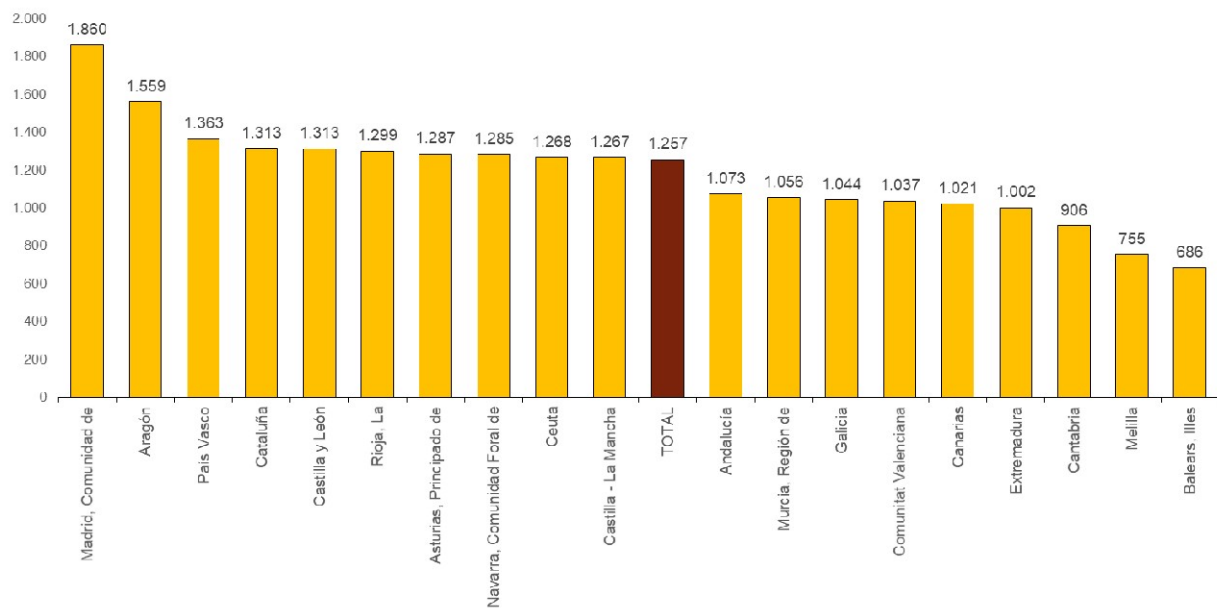

Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Comunidad de Madrid (1,860 trips per 1,000 inhabitants⁴), Aragón (1,559) and Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1,363).

In turn, those who travelled the least were residents of Illes Balears (686 trips per 1,000 inhabitants) Cantabria (906) and Extremadura (1,002).

Travel expenses

Total travel expenses in the second quarter were 19,297 million euros, representing an increase of 1.9% compared to the same period in 2018.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 2.1% and on trips abroad by 1.4%.

The average daily expenditure was 41 euros for domestic trips and 97 euros for trips abroad.

During the first nine months of 2019 the total travel expenditure of residents increased by 2.7%. The increase was 3.2% for domestic trips and 1.7% for trips abroad.

⁴ This considers the resident population aged 15 years old or over (calculated as the average of the population of each of the months of the quarter).

In domestic trips, *accommodation expenditures* represented the largest share of expenditures (27.5% of the total), followed by *bar and restaurant expenditures* (27.4%). The former increased by 2.1% compared to the third quarter of 2019 and the latter by 0.9%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 25.0% of the total, with an annual increase of 2.4%.

During the first nine months of the year, the *accommodation expenditures* for domestic trips increased by 4.7% compared with the same period in 2018. On the other hand, *expenditure on transport* for trips abroad increased by 1.2%.

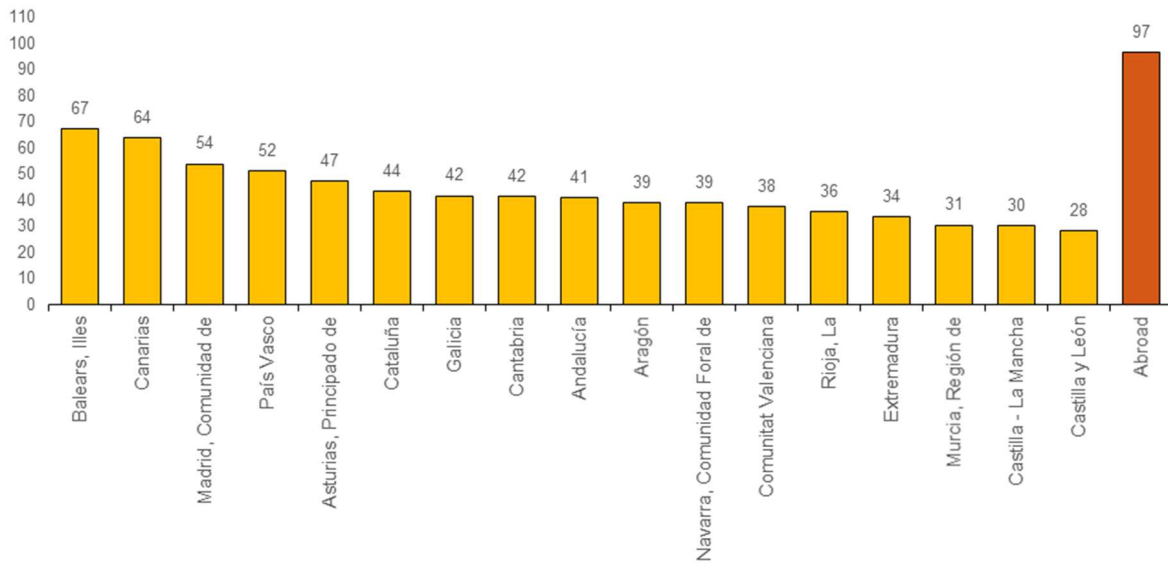

According to the main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Illes Balears (67 euros), Canarias (64) and Comunidad de Madrid (54).

In turn, the lowest values were found in Castilla y León (28 euros), La Rioja (30) and Murcia (31).

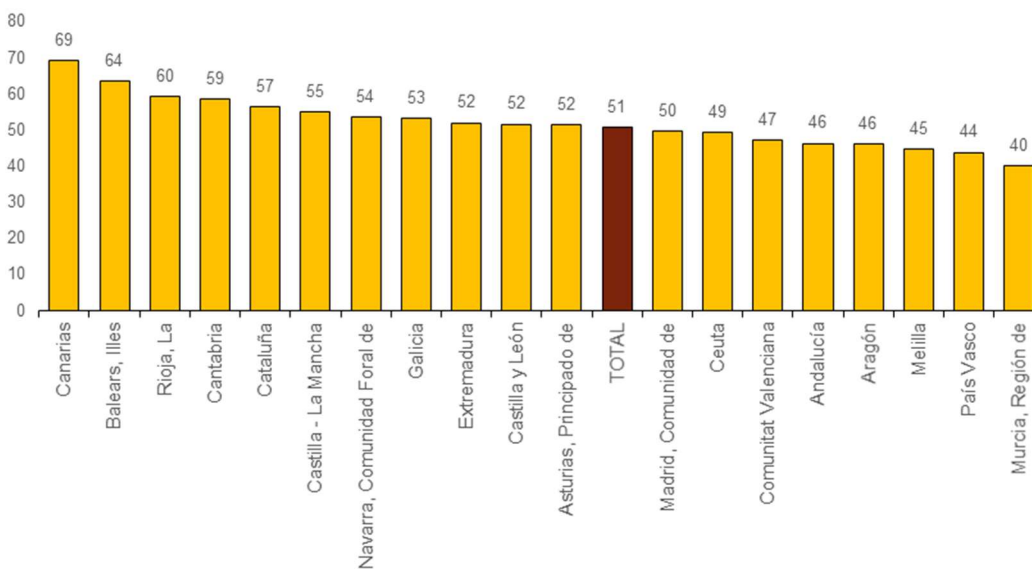
Average daily expenditure per person according to destination



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (69 euros), Balears Illes Canarias (64) and La Rioja (60).

In turn, the lowest were registered in Región de Murcia (40 euros), País Vasco (44) and Aragón (46).

Monthly data

In July, 19.8 million trips were made, in August 25.0 million and in September 16.3 million. Trips made in August had the longest average duration (7,5 overnight stays).

August was the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (37.5%). This was due both to the higher percentage of trips to other Autonomous Community (48.7% of the total) and abroad (13.8%).

Leisure was the main reason for travelling every month, representing 66.1% of trips. Trips for professional reasons reached their minimum in August (3.2% of the total).

September was the most important month for non-market (24.9%) and hotel (24.9%) accommodations. The rest of the market accommodations had the highest registry in August (23.0%).

Excursions

The resident population aged 15 years or older took 71.3 million excursions⁵ in the third quarter of 2019, with an annual decrease of 9,5%. 97.5% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 2.5% for professional reasons.

88.5% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual decrease of 9.8%.

10.3% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.1% to foreign countries. The number of excursions decreased by 5.5% in the former and by 13.5% in those with destinations abroad.

⁵ An excursion is considered to be any visit without overnight stay outside the usual environment of the person. These exclude those which are part of the routine of the individual, as well as those made from second homes, from a cruise or any accommodation other than the usual.

Data review and updates

Coinciding with today's publication, the INE has updated the data from the Resident Tourism Survey for the third quarter of 2018, which are now definitive. The results are available at INEBase.

Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

Type of operation: quarterly continuous survey.

Population scope: Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

Geographical scope: the entire national territory.

Reference period of the results: month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

Sample size: the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

Type of sampling: stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

Collection method: computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
