# Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR)

Fourth quarter year 2021 and year 2021.

The number of trips made by residents in Spain increases by 111.5% in the fourth quarter of 2021 and stands at 36.3 million

Total expenditure increased by 207.2% reaching 8,139 million euros

# In 2021, the number of trips increased by 40.7% while expenditure grew by 53.9%

Residents in Spain made 36.3 million trips in the fourth quarter of 2021, 111.5% more than that registered in the same period of 2020.

92.3% of the trips had the national territory as main destination, with an annual increase of 99.8%. On the other hand, trips abroad increased by 597.3%, representing 7.7% of the total.



If we analyse the trips by weeks<sup>1</sup>, an increase can be observed in all the weeks since the second quarter of 2021 compared to the year 2020. As of June and during the fourth quarter, trips begin to recover to levels close to 2019.

# Trips according to purpose, accommodation and main transport

*Leisure, recreation and holiday* trips, which were the main reason for 42.6% of the total, increased by 172.5% in the fourth quarter. Trips for *Visits to relatives or friends*, which represented 40.3% of the total, registered an annual increase of 97.0%.

In turn, trips taken for *Business and other professional reasons* and those made for *Other reasons*<sup>2</sup> increased by 35.1% and 88.5%, respectively.

The main reason for travelling within Spain during the fourth quarter was visiting relatives or friends (41.7%). On the other hand, most trips abroad were made for leisure purposes (59.8%).

In 42.8% of domestic trips, residents stayed in family or friends' dwellings. That is 6.7 million trips, 75.2% more than in the fourth quarter of 2020.

For trips abroad, market accommodation was the preferred option (74.5% of the total). This type of accommodation registered an annual increase of 775.1%.

As for the main type of transport used, own vehicles accounted for 81.2% of domestic trips, 87.7% more than in the same quarter of 2020.

In 62.8% of the trips abroad, air transport was used, with an increase of 1,028.0%.

#### Main destinations

The main destination Autonomous Communities for trips by residents in the fourth quarter of 2021 were Andalucía (with 17.2% of the total), Cataluña (12.5%) and Comunitat Valenciana (9.5%).

If domestic trips of residents are related with the population of the destination, the phenomenon of trips was more intense in Aragón (with 1,483 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>3</sup>), Castilla y León (with 1,440) and Castilla–La Mancha (1,174).



# **Autonomous Communities of origin**

Trips made by the residents in Cataluña represented 17.0% of the total in the fourth quarter. This was followed by Comunidad de Madrid (16.4%) and Andalucía (15.5%).



Removing the effect caused by each Autonomous Community's size, those travelling the most were from Aragón (1,010 trips per 1,000 inhabitants<sup>4</sup>), Castilla y León (978) and Comunidad de Navarra (948).

In turn, those who travelled the least were residents of Región de Murcia (544 trips per 1,000 inhabitants), Canarías (657) and Illes Balears (664).

#### **Travel expenses**

The total travel expenditure in the fourth quarter reached 8.139 million euros, indicating a 207.2% increase as compared with the same period of 2020.

Total expenses on domestic trips increased by 154.6% and on trips abroad by 725.6%.

The average daily expenditure was 61 euros for domestic trips and 114 euros for trips abroad.

In domestic trips, expenditure on bar and restaurants represented the largest percentage of the total expenditure (24.8%), followed by expenditure on lodging (24.7%). The former increased by 210.2% compared to the fourth quarter of 2020 and the latter by 162.9%.

On trips abroad, *expenditure on transport* represented 31.0% of the total, with an annual increase of 691.6%.



According to the main destination Autonomous Community, the highest average daily expenditures were registered in trips made to Canarias (91 euros), País Vasco (90) and Comunidad de Madrid (87).

In turn, the lowest were in Castilla-La Mancha (48 euros), Castilla y León (50) and Comunitat Valenciana (51).


# Average daily expenditure per person according to destination Fourth quarter 2021



By Autonomous Community of origin, the highest average daily expenditure was made by residents in Canarias (86 euros), Región de Murcia (79) and Cataluña (76).

In turn, the lowest values were in Galicia (57 euros), La Rioja (58) and Extremadura and Aragón (60 euros).

# Monthly data

In October there were 13.4 million trips, in November 10.9 million and in December 12.1 million. The trips taken had an average duration of 3.4 overnight stays in October, 3.0 in November and 3.3 in December.

December is the month with the lowest percentage of trips within the Autonomous Community of residence (48.6%, compared to 48.7% in October and 49.0% in November). However, it is the month with the highest percentage of trips abroad (9.3%).

Leisure, recreation and holiday trips were the main reason for the trip in October (47.7% of the total for that month) and November (40.0%). In December, the main reason was *Visits to family or friends* (47.8%). In December, the lowest level of business trips for this quarter was recorded.

Non-market accommodation represented 65.4% of the total trips in December, compared to 60.0% in October and 58.6% in November.

#### **Excursions**

The resident population aged 15 years or older made 53.1 million excursions<sup>5</sup> in the fourth quarter of 2021, with an annual increase of 51,0%. 96.9% of excursions were made for personal reasons and 3.1% for professional reasons.

88.8% of the excursions were made within the Autonomous Community of residence, with an annual increase of 40.8%.

10.0% of excursions were to another Autonomous Community and 1.2% to foreign countries. The number of excursions to another autonomous community increased by 245.4%.

# Results for the whole of year 2021

Spanish residents made 142.9 million trips for the whole year 2021, 40.7% more than in 2020. Overnight stays for those trips exceeded 626.1 million, with a decrease of 26.9%. In turn, the total associated expenditure rose by 53.9%, to 32,521 million euros.

95.0% of trips had Spain as main destination and 5.0% abroad. Domestic trips accounted for 89.0% of overnight stays and 83.4% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 49 euros.

In turn, trips abroad accounted for 11.0% of overnight stays and 16.6% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 79 euros.

The main reason for the trip was leisure (48.4% of the total) and visits to relatives or friends (36.6%).

Leisure trips accounted for 58.1% of the total expenditure, with an average daily expenditure of 57 euros. The highest average daily expenditure was registered in business trips (89 euros).

Residents chose non-market accommodation in 62.8% of the total number of trips. Those trips, which accounted for 63.9% of overnight stays, registered the lowest average daily expenditure (29 euros). The highest average daily expenditure (124 euros) was registered on trips with hotel accommodation.

In domestic trips, expenditure on lodgings represented the largest share of the total (25.1%), followed by expenditure on bars and restaurants (20.7%) and in other expenses (24.1%).

In trips abroad, the items with the greatest weight on the total were expenditure on transport (30.6%), expenditure on accommodation (21.7%) and expenditure on bar or restaurants (18.3%).

By quarter, the highest average daily expenditure was recorded in the fourth quarter, for both domestic trips (61 euros) and for those taken abroad (114 euros).

On the other hand, the lowest average daily expenditures were registered during the first quarter (43 euros for domestic trips and 51 euros for those made abroad).

Andalucía was the destination of 18.2% of all trips made in the year 2021, followed by Cataluña (14.4%) and Comunitat Valenciana (11.7%).

The least visited destinations were La Rioja (0.9% of the total), Comunidad Foral de Navarra (1.4%) and Región de Murcia (1.9%).

The highest average daily expenditures in 2021 were registered in trips to Canarias (73 euros), Illes Balears (69) and Comunidad de Madrid (66).

In turn, the lowest average values were for Región de Murcia (35 euros), Castilla y León (37) and La Rioja and Castilla–La Mancha (both with 40).



Residents in Cataluña accounted for the highest percentage of trips in 2021 (17.6% of the total), followed by residents in Comunidad de Madrid (16.7%) and Andalucía (15.8%).

The highest average daily expenditure corresponded to residents in Canarias (64 euros per day), Cantabria (60) and Cataluña and Castilla-La Mancha (56, in both cases).

In turn, the lowest were registered average daily expenditures were registered in Región de Murcia (43 euros), Comunitat Valenciana (46) and País Vasco (48).

# **Data Review and Update**

The data published today is final and is not subject to further revision. All results are available on INEBase.

# Methodological note

The main objective of the Residents Travel Survey (ETR/FAMILITUR) is to provide information on the trips and excursions carried out each month by the population resident in Spain, both within the country and abroad, and their main characteristics (duration, expenditure, reason, accommodation, etc.).

In addition, the survey provides annual information on the percentage of the population travelling for personal reasons and investigates the reasons given by those who do not travel.

**Type of operation**: quarterly continuous survey.

**Population scope:** Resident population aged 15 and over in family dwellings (indirect information regarding trips taken by children under 15 is also provided).

**Geographical scope**: the entire national territory.

**Reference period of the results:** month, quarter, year (depending on the variable and the degree of disaggregation).

**Sample size:** the effective monthly sample is around 8,200 persons, who provide information on the trips completed in the two months prior to the interview. Thus, the results of a reference month are obtained from around 16,400 questionnaires.

**Type of sampling:** stratified two-stage random sampling. The framework is the set of main dwellings that have collaborated in the Continuous Household Survey (CHS). In each stratum of the CHS, the first stage units are the main family dwellings and the second stage units are the persons aged 15 and over residing in these dwellings. A variable defining the household's propensity to travel is used as a stratification criterion.

The selected persons collaborate three times in alternate months over six months, leave the sample one semester, and are interviewed another three times during the following semester.

**Collection method:** computer-assisted telephone or personal interviews, online questionnaire (since 2018).
